ACC YEAR-END TOP 50 CHART

You mov notice that American Country Countdown's Top Hits of 2000 has some notable differences from the list published in Billboard Magazine and here's why: Billboard's list is an accurate reflection of the most-played songs during the twelve month survey period from November 26th, 1999 through November 25th, 2000. The problem is that the vast majority of our listeners don't understand why many big hits rank relatively low in the Billboard year-end survey. The explanation is simple: records whose popularity spans two survey periods have their total credited airplay divided. For example, "The Little Girl" by John Michael Montgomery was a major hit, spending three weeks at #1. But, because it was popular at the end of the survey period, it only ends up at #44 for the year on the Billboard list. There are similar "inequities" with other #1 songs, including "Best Of Intentions" by Travis Tritt which finishes at #40 with Billboard and "When I Said I Do" by Clint Black which comes in at #45. American Country Countdown attempts to give each hit full credit for its chart popularity, thus presenting a year-end survey we believe makes more sense to the average listener.

Please don't misunderstand. All of us at ACC place the highest value on our ongoing association with Billboard and understand that their year-end tabulation is an accurate accounting of airplay within the 52-week survey period. But we feel the strict cutoff dates make for a chart that isn't the most "radio-friendly."

We hope this clears up any questions about the difference in the two charts. As always, our purpose is to produce a show that entertains your listeners and we hope this year's top 50 countdown will do just that.
