1. Songwriters have different ways of getting to that final completed song. It has to start somewhere. Those crazy, yet down to earth guys, Deadeye Dick have it all worked out for them. Caleb Guillotte and Mark Miller from the band at #22 told us how it happens...:

DEAD EYE DICK ACTUALITY: (:40) - "WHAT NORMALLY HAPPENS IS, ONE OF US WILL PRESENT A SONG WITH THE IDEAS PRETTY WELL CONSTRUCTED. AND THEN ONCE THE OTHER TWO GET A HOLD OF IT'S UNDOUBTEDLY CHANGED AT ANY POINT YA KNOW, THERE'S EITHER MORE OF A GROOVE OR MORE POP OR MORE THIS OR THAT PUT INTO IT AND EVERYONE KINDA PUTS THERE AUTOGRAPH ON THE SONG, WHICH IS THE BEST THING ABOUT THE BAND, IS WE ALL THREE HAVE DIFFERENT FEELINGS MUSICALLY ENOUGH BUT ONCE THEY COME TOGETHER IT REALLY MESHES WELL/ YEA, IF I CAME IN WITH A SONG I WOULD NEVER DREAM OF TELLING BILLY AND MARK WHAT TO PLAY BECAUSE THOSE GUYS PLAY THERE INSTRUMENTS MUCH BETTER THAN I COULD EVER IMAGINE, SO I JUST PLAY THE CHORDS OR SOMETHING AND SING ALONG AND SAY HEY WHAT CAN YOU DO WITH THIS? IF YA LIKE IT YOU KNOW , AND THEY DO THE SAME THING".

2. What makes one group get together and go nowhere while another shoots right to the top? Like this group at #17. Surely the hottest group of the past year. Jonas "Joker" Berggren told us how Ace Of Base came to be...:

ACE OF BASE ACTUALITY: (:36) - "ME AND MY SISTER PLAYED FOR SOME YEARS, MANY YEARS, ACTUALLY 8 YEARS, AND THE SAME DAY THAT THE ROLLING STONES PLAYED IN GOTHENBURG, WE WERE SUPPOSED TO PLAY IN THE CENTRAL OF GOTHENBURG, AT ANOTHER PLACE. A LOT OF PEOPLE WERE EXPECTED TO COME THERE AND SEE OUR CONCERT AND ME AND ULF HAD BEEN WORKING TOGETHER BEFORE, WE HAD THE SAME REHEARSAL ROOM, AND WE ASKED ULF IF HE'D WANT TO JOIN US ON THE STAGE, AND HE REALLY LIKES THAT, AND HE DID THAT BECAUSE OF THE OTHER PERSON IN THE BAND WHO DIDN'T DARE TO GO TO THE STAGE. SO, AND ULF REALLY LIKES TO BE ON THE STAGE, SO IT WAS A GOOD INJECTION TO US."

3. Ray Pena, who sings the lead on the 4 P.M. song told us why they did "SUKIYAKI":

4 P.M. ACTUALITY: (:17) - "WELL THE SONG WAS SUBMITTED TO US BY THE LABEL THAT WE SIGNED TO, AND WHEN THE IDEA CAME OF DOING THE SONG WE ABSOLUTELY LOVED THE IDEA. WE GREW UP LISTENING TO THAT SONG AND I KNEW ALL THE WORDS AND THE LYRICS FOR THAT SONG, AND IT REALLY CAME EASY IN THE STUDIO FOR THAT SONG, WHEN WE RECORDED IT."
