- 1) "DIONNE & STEVIE, GLADYS & ELTON" (:24)  
Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, four super-talents moved into the top spot on the Official Billboard Survey: Dionne Warwick, Steve Wonder, Gladys Knight, and Elton John hit number One with their song "THAT'S WHAT FRIENDS ARE FOR." And there doesn't appear to be a strong challenger in sight for that top spot. So how long with Dionne & Friends stay at Number One. Join me for all the chart activity, on American Top-40.
- 2) BRUCE CLOSES IN ON THE TOP TEN (:23)  
This is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40, Bruce Springsteen moved from Number Thirteen to Number Eleven with his latest smash, "MY HOMETOWN." If he keeps moving up, he'll tie the all-time record for Most Top Tens from One Album. Can the Boss make it Seven Top Tens from "Born in the U.S.A.?" We'll find out as we report the action on American Top 40.
- 3) MOVIE SONGS MOVING UP (:25)
