FEBRUARY 1-2, 1986, THERE IS AN ADDITIONAL THREE
MINUTES OF LOCAL COMMERCIAL AVAILABILITY.

THERE ARE THIRTY ADDITIONAL SECONDS IN HOUR ONE LOCATED
AT C-3 AND C-5. IN HOUR TWO THERE ARE THIRTY SECONDS
AT C-1 AND C-3 AND IN HOUR THREE AND FOUR THERE ARE
THIRTY SECONDS LOCATED AT C-1.

1) CINEMATIC CHARTS (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Movie songs are really hot now. On this week's official Billboard chart, there could be as many as four movie songs in the top ten: From "White Nights" "SAY YOU, SAY ME" by Lionel Richie. From "Rocky Four", "BURNING HEART" by Survivor. From "Spies Like Us", the title song by Paul McCartney. And from "Jewel of the Nile", "WHEN THE GOING GETS TOUGH" by Billie Ocean. Join me at the movies this week -- on American Top 40.

2) HERE COME THE CHART VETS (:22)

This is Casey Kasem, and the ones to watch for this week on American Top 40 are all Chart Veterans. Ready to debut with their latest hits there're Sting, with "RUSSIANS", Heart, with "THESE DREAMS", ZZ Top with "STAGES", and Super-Entertainer Barbara Streisand with "SOMEWHERE". If they make the right moves on Billboard's official survey, we'll hear 'em on American Top 40.

3) NUMBER ONE CONTENDERS (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40 Dionne Warwick and Friends held on to number one with "THAT'S WHAT FRIENDS ARE FOR". But two other songs are homing in on the top spot. Making a big move last week from number 12 to number 5 was "I'M YOUR MAN" by Wham. And leaping from number eight to number three was "BURNING HEART" by Survivor. Who's got what it takes to take number one this week? We'll find out on American Top 40.

4) SOMEWHERE OVER THE STREISAND (:30)

This is Casey Kasem. Among the potential debuts on American Top 40 this week -- is a remake of a song from one of the most successful musicals of the past 30 years. A musical that opened on Broadway in 1958 -- and has been performed thousands of times since then, by hundreds of theatre companies around the world. The musical is "West Side Story". The song is "SOMEWHERE". And the singer who's remade it is Barbara Streisand. Does she put it into the Top 40 this week? We'll find out on American Top 40.
