1) FAIR DINKUM CHART 'OLIDAY (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well, last week the Aussie's returned to the top. For the first time in 5 years an Australian group hit #1. Aussie's haven't waltzed at #1 since Men at Work did it with "DOWN UNDER." Now, the six-man band from Sydney, INXS, celebrate Australia's Bi-Centennial with a #1 in the U.S.A.--"NEED YOU TONIGHT." Another wonder from down under--here on American Top 40...mate.

2) TEEN QUEENS (:21)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. In the countdown we're still teeming with teen talent. 17-year-old Debbie Gibson looks like she's going to debut with her third Top 40 hit called "OUT OF THE BLUE." And up near the top of the chart, 16 year-old teen queen Tiffany looks like she might score her second #1 hit in a row with "COULD'VE BEEN." The teens are takin' over--on American Top 40.

3) CONCERT KINGS ON THE CHART (:18)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Two of the most exciting live performers of the '80s are rocking the countdown. There's Prince, pouncing up the survey with "I COULD NEVER TAKE THE PLACE OF YOUR MAN", and there's the boss of the E. Street Band, Bruce Springsteen, diggin' in with the "TUNNEL OF LOVE." Bruce and Prince come alive in the Top Ten--on American Top 40.

4) THE DEBUT DERBY (:30)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well, this week's contenders for debut action include big names, newcomers, and T.V. celebrities. There's Sting, pleading, "BE STILL MY BEATING HEART"; Eurythmics, demanding, "I NEED A MAN"; newcomer, Keith Sweat responding, "I WANT HER", and, from T.V.'s Saturday Night Live, Buster Poindexter and his Banshees of Blue finding it all, "HOT, HOT, HOT." And who's hot enough to debut? The official Billboard Chart ranks the results as we count 'em down--on American Top 40.
