1) ANOTHER CHART K.O. FOR ROCKY? (:27)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The movie series about America's favorite fictional boxing hero Rocky Balboa, has generated two number one songs: From the first "Rocky," there was "GONNA FLY NOW" by Bill Conti--and from "Rocky Three," "EYE OF THE TIGER" by Survivor. Last week, a song from "Rocky Four," "BURNING HEART" By Survivor, climbed to the number two spot. Is another Rocky song about to hit number one? I'll have a blow-by-blow account for you this week on American Top 40.

2) HOT, COOL, FAST, SLOW (:25)

This is Casey Kasem. Among the strong debut possibilities this week on American Top 40 are some hot rockers and cool ballads. On the slow side, there's "NIKITA" by Elton John--and "THIS COULD BE THE NIGHT" by Loverboy. On the fast side, there's "STAGES" by ZZ Top--and the latest from John Cougar Mellencamp, "R.O.C.K. IN THE U.S.A." Hot, cool, fast, slow--we've got 'em all on American Top 40.

3) MR. DYNAMITE'S TOP TEN RETURN (:24)

This is Casey Kasem. One of the hottest hits on the official Billboard Chart is the sizzling comeback by Mr. Dynamite--The Godfather of Soul, James Brown. His song "LIVING IN AMERICA" leaped from Number 23 to Number 15. If it keeps that rate-of-climb, it'll become James Brown's first top ten hit in eighteen years! Join me for the Superstars--and the Supersongs--on American Top 40!

4) ITCHING FOR NUMBER 1 (:25)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40, the song at number one was "THAT'S WHAT FRIENDS ARE FOR" by Dionne & Friends. That song's been at number one for three weeks. There are a couple of songs itching to take its place. Like Survivor's "BURNING HEART" at number two. And Wham's "I'M YOUR MAN" at number three. We'll see how it turns out and who's at number one when we count down the official Billboard survey on American Top 40.
