1) CHECKIN' TOPS OF CHARTS (:27)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem on American Top 40. Last week, Billboard's Number One Soul Song was "MR. TELEPHONE MAN" by New Edition. The Number One Country Song was "A PLACE TO FALL APART" by Merle Haggard. The Number One album was "BORN IN THE U.S.A." by Bruce Springsteen. And the Number One Pop Song in the land was "I WANT TO KNOW WHAT LOVE IS" by Foreigner. What will the Tops of the Charts look like this week? Join me for that and more on American Top 40.

2) BATTLE FOR NUMBER ONE (:28)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem on American Top 40. Last week, Foreigner knocked Madonna out of Number One with their big hit, "I WANT TO KNOW WHAT LOVE IS." But the battle for the Top Spot is just beginning. Moving up to Number Two is "EASY LOVER" by Phillip Bailey and Phil Collins. And moving up to Number Three is "CARELESS WHISPER" by Wham. So can Foreigner hold on to Number One? We'll find out about that, and all the Official Billboard Chart Action right here-- on American Top 40.

3) POTENTIAL DEBUTERS ON CHART (:27)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem on American Top 40. A lot of name acts are set to debut into the Top 40 this week. Among those potential debuters on the Official Billboard survey are: Pat Benatar with "OOH OOH SONG"--Billy Joel with "KEEPIN' THE FAITH"--Survivor with "HIGH ON YOU"--and, the latest from Duran Duran--"SAVE A PRAYER." They'll debut in our countdown this week if Billboard says so. Join me to find out right here on American Top 40.

4) FAST CLIMBERS IN COUNTDOWN (:29)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem on American Top 40. Last week's Countdown saw some fast climbers. Two songs leaped Ten notches each: "MR. TELEPHONE MAN" by New Edition, up to Number 25--and "CALIFORNIA GIRLS" by David Lee Roth up to Number 23. But last week's biggest climber leaped 16 notches to 13: "THE HEAT IS ON" by Glenn Frey.
