1) Wham on Top :20

This is Casey Kasem on American Top 40. Last week, Wham landed back in the number one spot with their second number one in a row: "CARELESS WHISPER." Can Wham be knocked off the top of the official Billboard chart this week? Billy Ocean or the Pointer Sisters might have a chance. We'll find out as we count down the 40 biggest hits in the U.S.A. on American Top 40.

2) Possible Debuts :22

This is Casey Kasem on American Top 40. Most weeks, 4 new songs make their first appearance in the countdown. Some likely contenders this week are "I'M ON FIRE" by Bruce Springsteen..."SOMEBODY" by Bryan Adams..."ONE MORE NIGHT" by Phil Collins and "TAKE ME WITH U" by Prince and the Revolution and Appolania. They'll debut, if the Billboard chart says so, this week on American Top 40.

3) Mick Steps Out :21

This is Casey Kasem on American Top 40. For the first time, Mick Jagger is out on his own without the Rolling Stones. Last week he debuted at Number 40 with his first solo hit, "JUST ANOTHER NIGHT." How will it do compared to all the hits he's racked up with the Stones? We'll watch Mick's progress and check out all the Official Billboard chart action right here, on American Top 40.

4) Prince is Hot Stuff :29

This is Casey Kasem on American Top 40. The hottest act on the charts today is Prince. In the Top 40, he's written and co-produced Sheena Easton's smash, "SUGAR WALLS." He's co-produced the Time's hit "JUNGLE LOVE." And Prince is in the survey with his own hit, "I WOULD DIE 4 U." And look: climbing fast on the chart is a new hit by Prince and the Revolution -- "TAKE ME WITH U." It could debut this week in the 40. We'll find out, right here on American Top 40.
