1) HEART PUMPING FOR NUMBER ONE? (:19)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The band Heart has been a top group for years now--but they've never had a Number One Song. However--last week, Heart's current smash, "THESE DREAMS" leaped up the Official Billboard Chart from Number Ten to Number Four. Will "THESE DREAMS" become Heart's first Number One Song? We'll be monitoring the Heart-Beat on American Top 40.

2) OR WILL WOLFIE JOIN LUDWIG? (:25)

This is Casey Kasem. One of the fastest moving songs in the countdown is the European smash, "ROCK ME AMADEUS" by Austrian Recording Artist, Falco. It debuted just three weeks ago, and last week shot from Number 29 to Fourteen. With that kind of momentum, will the name of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart soon be joining that of Ludwig Von Beethoven at Number One? We'll count down the modern-day classics on American Top 40.

3) PRINCE PLASTERS THE CHART (:25)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The man from Minneapolis was all over the Official Billboard Chart last week. Prince debuted in the countdown with his latest hit, "KISS." He also wrote the hit song by the Bangles, "MANIC MONDAY." And another song Prince wrote, "DO ME BABY" by M'LEE-sah Morgan is ready to debut in this week's Top 40. We'll report on Prince--and all the hottest Pop Life in the nation--on American Top 40.

4) SO WHAT'S NEW? (:22)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40, there were 11 acts in with their first Top 40 hits. And this week, three new acts are poised to break into the countdown for their first times--Meli'sa Morgan--with "DO ME BABY," the Austrian band Opus with "LIVE IS LIFE," and the group the Outfield with "YOUR LOVE." We'll be tracking 'em all--the rookies and the veterans--on American Top 40.
