1) #852-1/A (:22)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week on the countdown the top spot was occupied by Phil Collins' "ONE MORE NIGHT." Will Phil last another week in the top spot? Well, no if Madonna, with "MATERIAL GIRL," or Teena Marie with "LOVERGIRL," or USA For Africa with "WE ARE THE WORLD" have anything to say about it. We'll be here to report it all, the official Billboard chart action this week on American Top 40.

2) #852-1/B (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The most-talked about record of the year is "WE ARE THE WORLD," by USA For Africa. Last week on American Top 40, it leaped from number 21 to number five.
