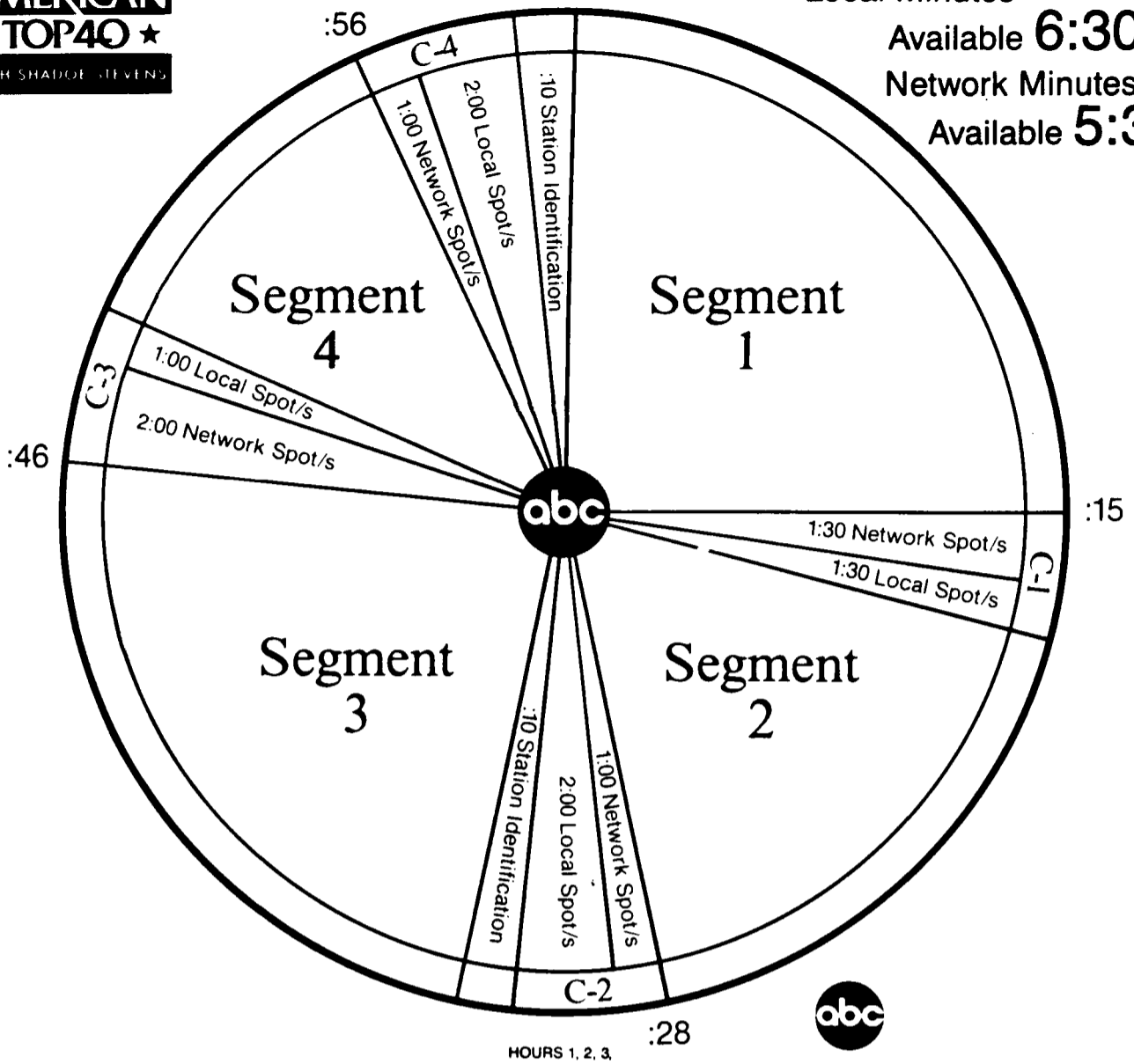
3. **JODY JUMPS BACK IN** :25

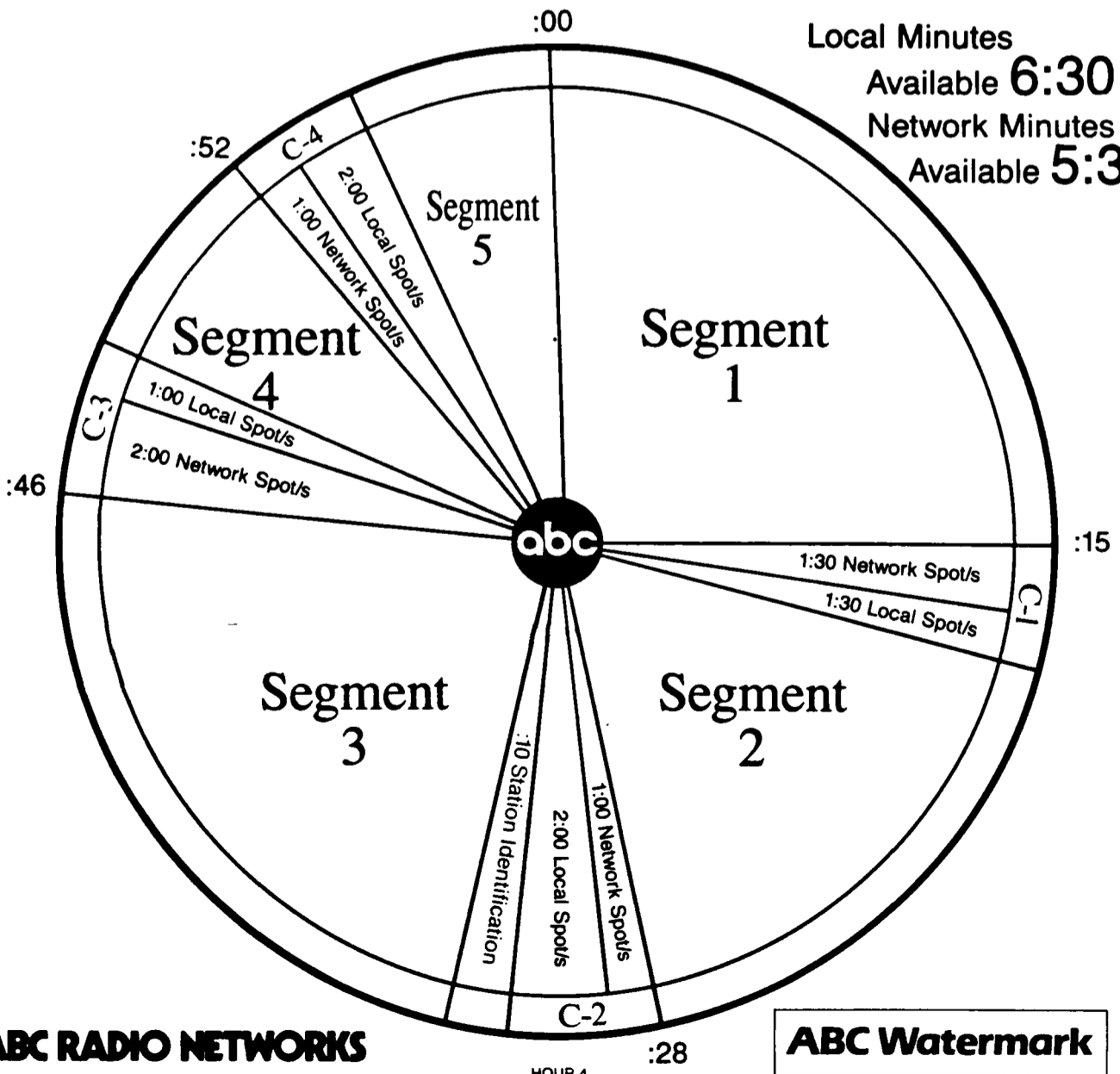
