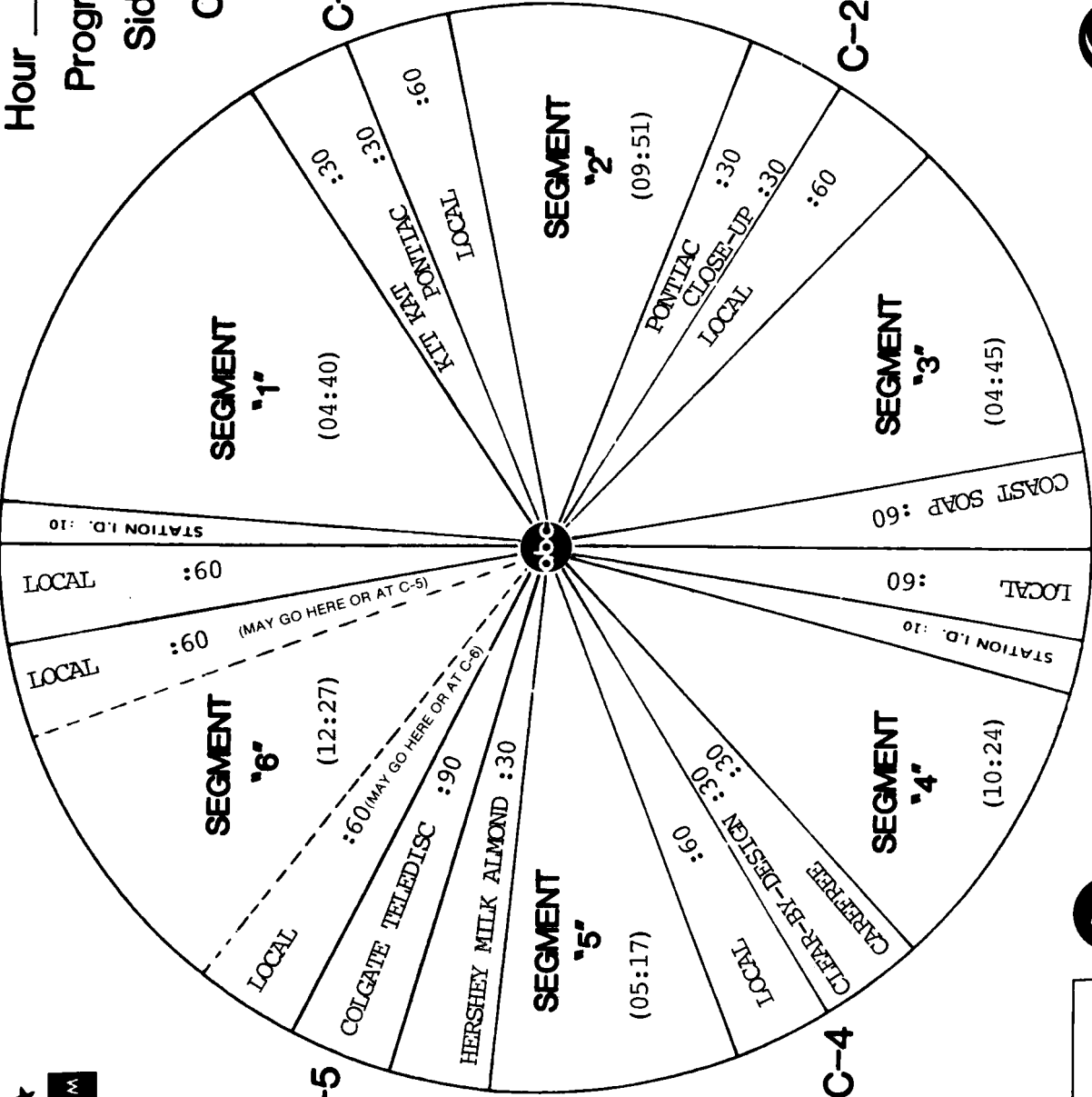

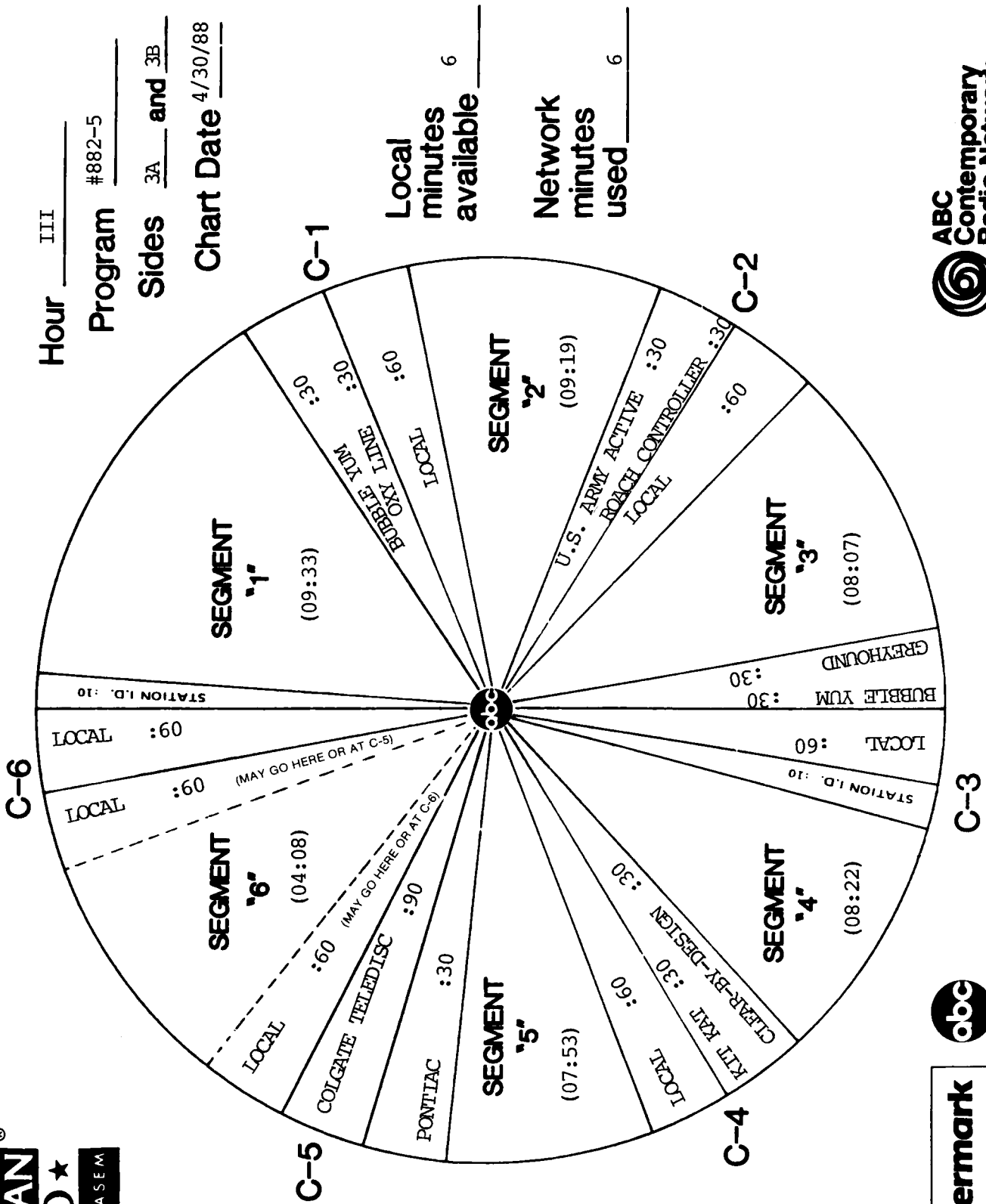

1. WONDER WHITNEY, PRINCESS OF CHART POWER (:21)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Just last week, Whitney Houston broke a tie with Madonna as woman with the most solo #1's in the rock era. She pulled ahead with her new #1 song, "WHERE DO BROKEN HEARTS GO?" By going to the top again, Whitney's actually broken a few records. Join me for the stars who re-write the record books each week on American Top 40.

2. WHERE DO NUMBER ONES GO? (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, Whitney Houston answered her own question, "WHERE DO BROKEN HEARTS GO?" --she hit #1. And she's got her heart set on another week on top. But right below, breathin' chart fire, are Inxs with "DEVIL INSIDE." And comin' up fast is Terence Trent D'Arby with "WISHING WELL." Wishful thinking may take him to the top.
