1) U.K. HOPES TO DETHRONE PRINCE (:22)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week the number one song in the U.S.A. (for a second week) was "KISS", by Prince & The Revolution. But coming up fast were two English acts who've never had number ones: Robert Palmer at number two with "ADDICTED TO LOVE" and the Pet Shop Boys at number three with "WEST END GIRLS." Will Prince still be King of the Hill this week? We'll find out on American Top 40.

2) VAN HALEN'S COMET (:22)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week the new number one album in the land was "Fifty-One Fifty", by Van Halen, with new lead singer Sammy Hagar. Meanwhile on the Pop chart, their hit song from that number one album climbed to number five-- "WHY CAN'T THIS BE LOVE." Why can't it be number one? That's what Van Halen wants to know. We'll see what the official Billboard survey says this week on American Top 40.

3) SOLO WHAM MAN (:20)

This is Casey Kasem. Just a few months ago, the successful English duo Wham announced their break-up. George Micahel and Andrew Ridgely went their separate ways. The way George went was straight back to the charts--solo. There's a good chance he'll debut in the countdown this week with a song called "A DIFFERENT CORNER." If it happens, it'll happen on American Top 40.

4) SPRINGTIME FOR THATCHER (:22)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well, the British Pop Invasion of North America--continues. Most of the acts likely to debut in the Top 40 this week are from the United Kingdom. Howard Jones, Simple Minds, Tears For Fears, Billy Ocean, and ex-Whammer George Michael are all possibilities for coming in this week. We'll see what Billboard's official tally tells us--on American Top 40.

5) CHART HOPPIN' (:22)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week, the number one album in the land was "FIFTY-ONE FIFTY" by Van Halen. The number one Country song was "CAJUN MOON" by Ricky Skaggs. The number one Soul song was "KISS" By Prince & The Revolution. And it was also the number one Pop song in the USA. Any changes at the Top of the Billboard charts this week will be duly noted--on American Top 40.
