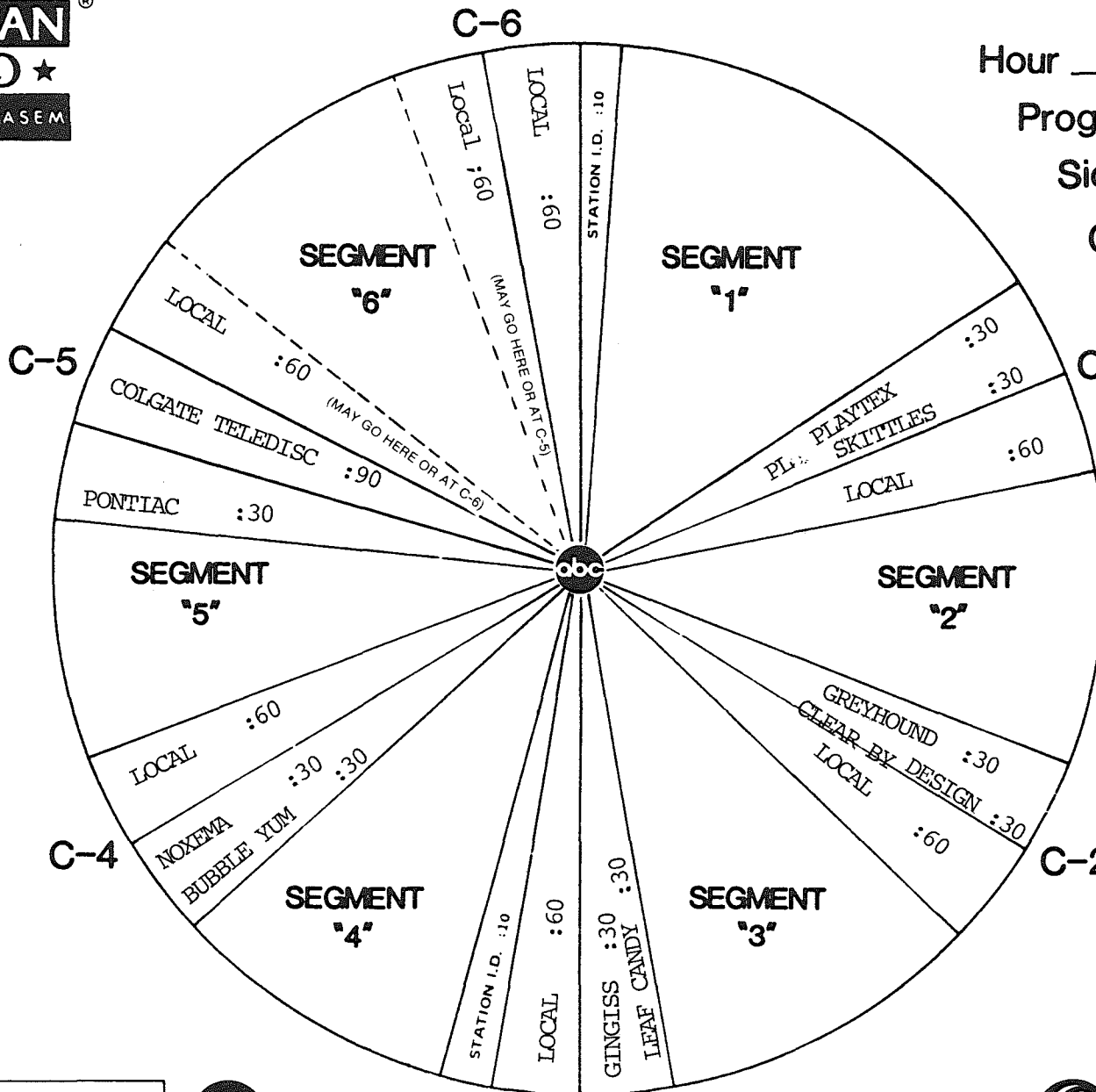

1) SMALL TOWN BOY MAKES GOOD (:23)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. There's a young, freckled-face English newcomer comin' on strong in the countdown. He's 22-year-old Rick Astley from a small town called Newton-Le-Willows. He took his first hit "NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP" all the way to the #1 spot on the Official Billboard Chart. And last week, his follow-up, "TOGETHER FOREVER" was the week's highest debut. Small-town boy Rick Astley is making Big News on American Top 40.

2) ONE MORE SMASH (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And George is back for "ONE MORE TRY." That's the latest hit from English Pop Sensation George Michael. He's following up Two Number Ones in a row, "FAITH" and "FATHER FIGURE." Now, he's back again, taking another shot at the Official Billboard Chart. Last week it was the countdown's biggest mover. Will it be one more #1 for George? We'll check out his fancy chart moves on American Top 40.

3) NATALIE'S TAKING BRUCE FOR A RIDE (:21)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, Super Rocker Bruce Springsteen's hit "ONE STEP UP" started taking a few steps down. But jumping into the driver's seat for him is Natalie Cole. She cruised into the Top Ten with a song written by Bruce, "PINK CADILLAC." Will Natalie steer Springsteen's song to #1? She's got a green light to go, on American Top 40.

5) MAKE A WISH (:19)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well that Hot New Singer from New York who went to England to make it has returned to the U.S.A. and found a home on the Official Billboard Chart. Terence Trent D'Arby climbed to #2 last week with his smash, "WISHING WELL." Will it reach the #1 spot this week? Well, Terence is wishing on American Top 40.
