The song won't write itself but, the actual nuts and bolts that hold the song together, you have the harmony, the structure of the song, lines that rhyme with other lines and writing bridges and middle eights, that takes a lot of work and... so don't get the idea that it's a magical process. It is a magical process to begin with and then you have to craft it and that takes hard work."
