1) BATTLE OF THE BRITTONS (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well, at the moment, the number one spot on American Top 40 is being fought over by two English acts. Last week, Yorkshire-born Robert Palmer was at number one with "ADDICTED TO LOVE." And he's feeling pressure from the London-based duo, The Pet Shop Boys, who are sitting at number two with the "WEST END GIRLS." We'll see how the English and a lot of other nationalities sort things out this week on American Top 40.

2) HOUSTON'S HOT STREAK (:20)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. One of the hottest acts in the business is Whitney Houston. Her recent number one Album has already given her two number one songs in a row. And it looks like a third is on the way: Whitney's current hit "GREATEST LOVE OF ALL" leaped five notches last week to number seven! Join me for the Whitney Houston watch--on American Top 40.

3) FRESH FROM THE FARM (:21)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The Rock Star who, together with Willie Nelson, organized the "Farm Aid Concert" to call attention to the plight of the American Farmers, is still at it. He released a single about the vanishing family farm called "RAIN ON THE SCARECROW." It could enter the countdown this week. We'll be watching for John Cougar Mellemcamp's latest hit--on American Top 40.

4) ABSOLUTELY PRETTY IN PINK (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Among the songs that stand a chance of debuting on American Top 40 this week are the title songs from two hit motion pictures. One--by David Bowie--is the title song from "ABSOLUTE BEGINNERS." David also acts in the movie. The other is the title song from "PRETTY IN PINK" by Psychedelic Furs. We'll see if the official Billboard survey puts 'em into the countdown, this week, on American Top 40.

5) THE TIP TOP OF THE CHARTS (:24)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week, the number one album in the land was "Fifty-One Fifty" by Van Halen. Number one Soul was "I'VE LEARNED TO RESPECT THE POWER OF LOVE" by Stephanie Mills. Number one on the Dance Chart was "WEST END GIRLS" by the Pet Shop Boys. And the number one Pop song was "ADDICTED TO LOVE" by Robert Palmer. What hits will top the official Billboard charts this week? We'll report all the action on American Top 40.
