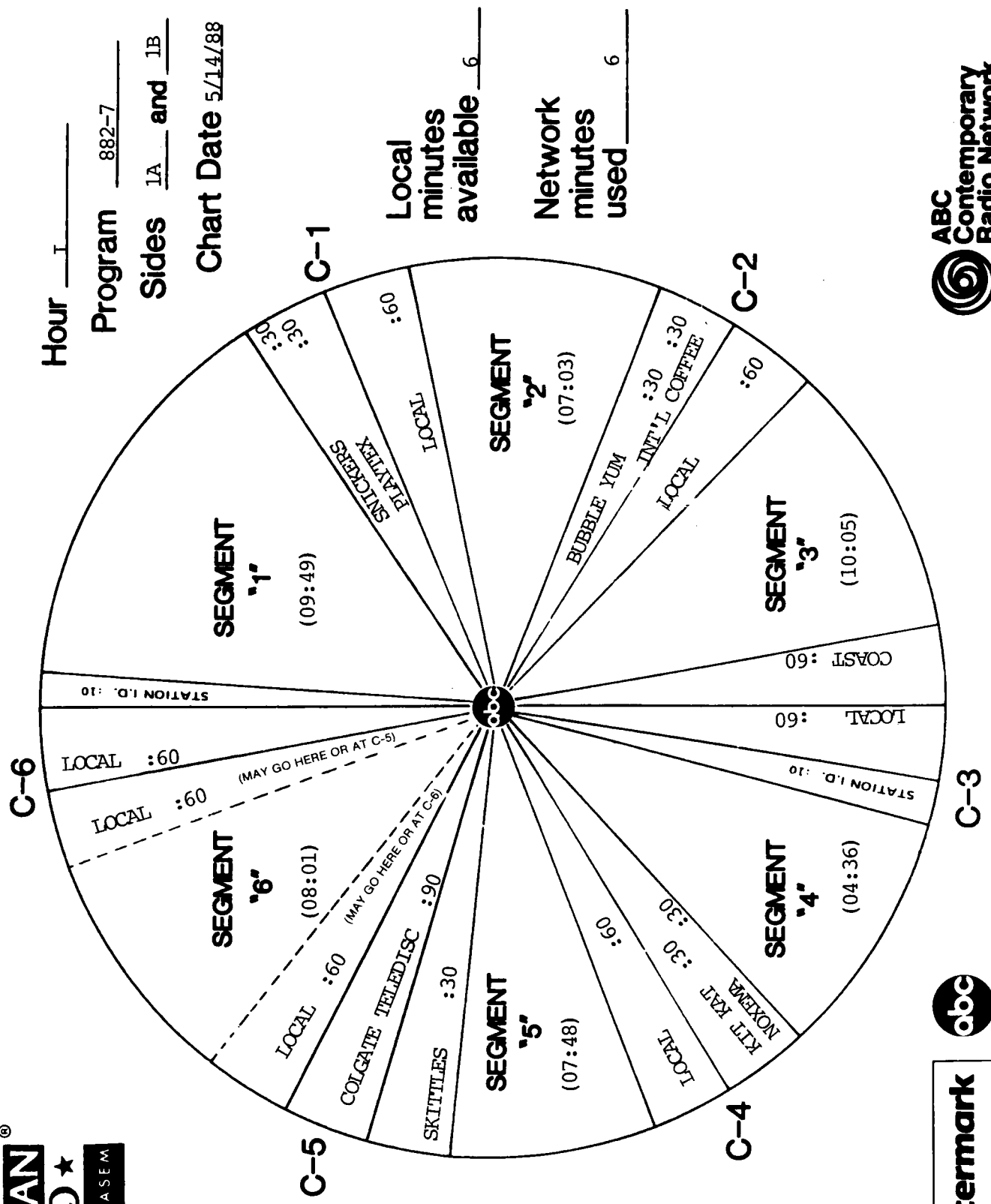

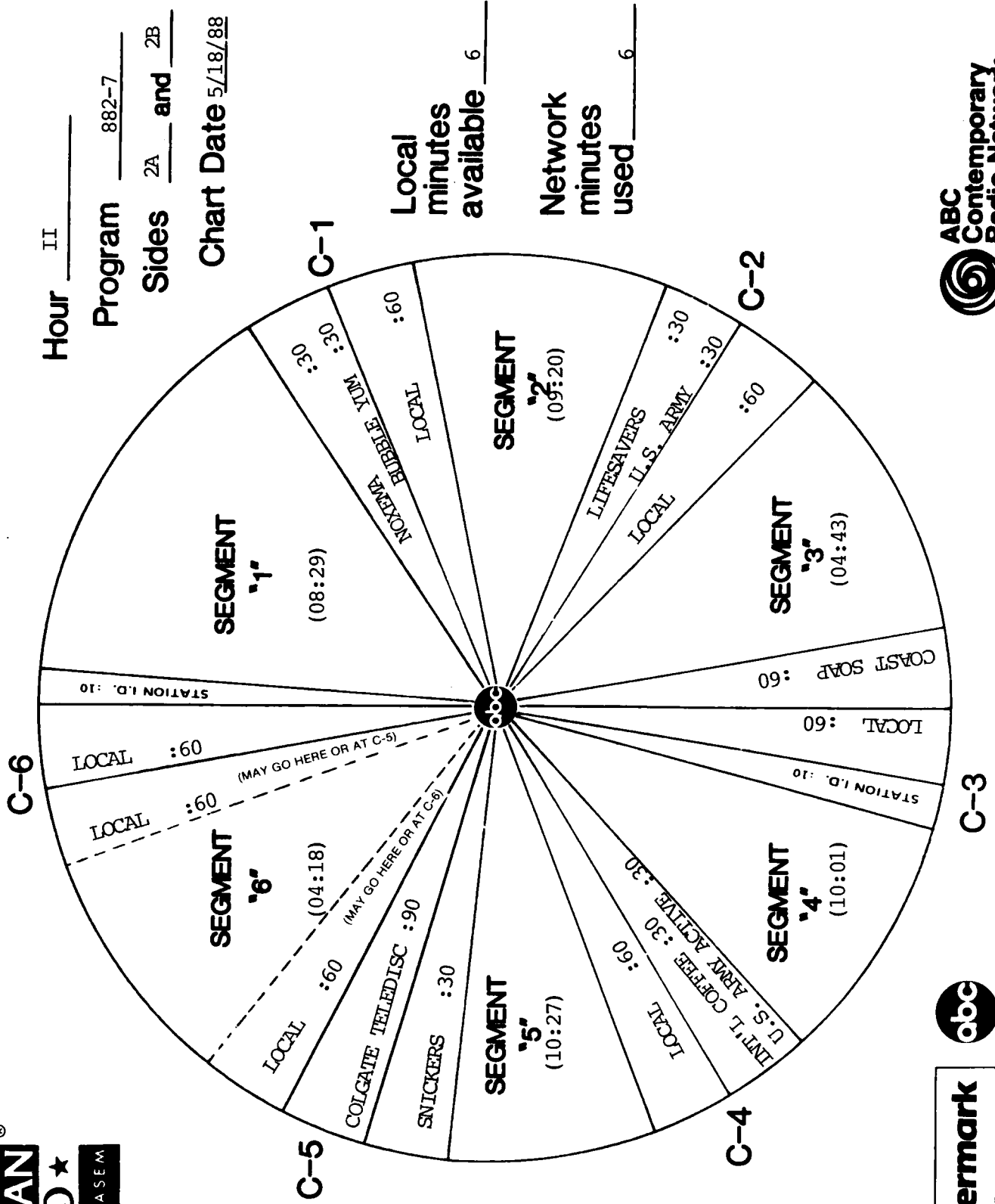

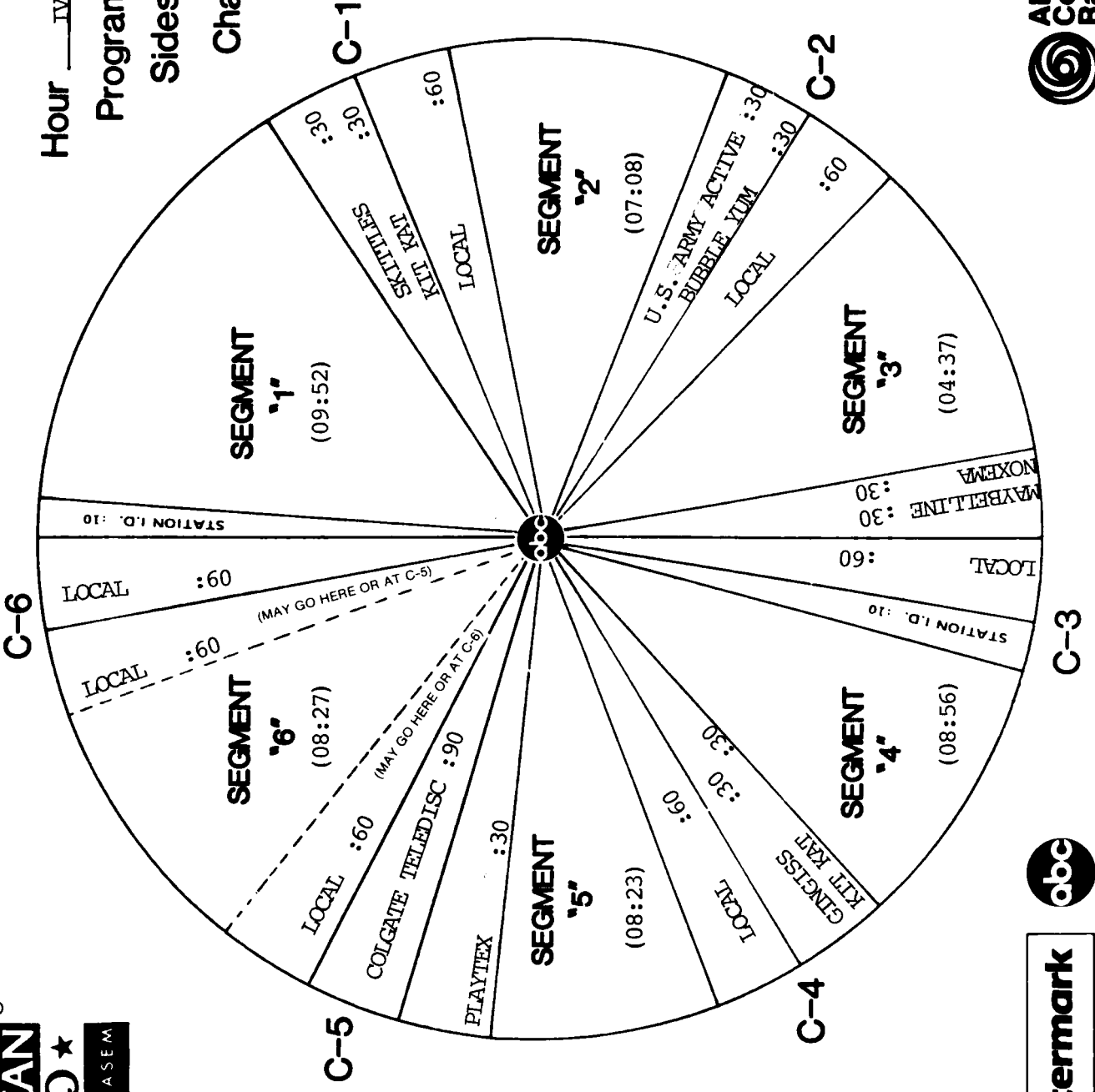

1) UNDER HIS SPELL (:23)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem, His last album "Sign of the Times," was named album of the year in the Village Voice Newspaper Poll of music critics across the country. That same album gave him three Top Ten hits. Now he's back, movin' fast up the Official Billboard Chart with the first release from his new album, "LoveSexy." That song, "ALPHABET CITY," could spell a debut for Prince on American Top 40.

2) GETTIN' DOWN AND DIRTY (:18)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The first four singles from his album "Bad" all hit #1 and set a new chart record. And now here comes the fifth "Bad" hit. Can Michael Jackson top himself with his latest, "DIRTY DIANA?" With Michael's moves, "Diana's" a good bet to debut this week on American Top 40.

3) HAS GLORIA FOUND THE SOUND AT #1? (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Gloria Estefan and Miami Sound Machine have had a lot of big hits in the last three years, six of 'em have hit Top Ten. Yet they've never hit #1. But just last week, Gloria and the Sound Machine climbed to #2 with their latest smash ballad, "ANYTHING FOR YOU." Could this be the one that takes them to the top of the Official Billboard Chart? We'll count 'em down and unveil this week's #1 song on American Top 40.

4) LIKE, TOTALLY HORNSBY (:21)

This is Casey Kasem. The group who took home a Grammy last year as Best New Artist are back. Bruce Hornsby and the Range have returned with their second album, "Scenes from the Southside." And the first hit, "THE VALLEY ROAD," is climbing the Official Billboard Chart. Does that road lead to the Top 40? The Top Ten? To find out travel the highway of hits on American Top 40.
