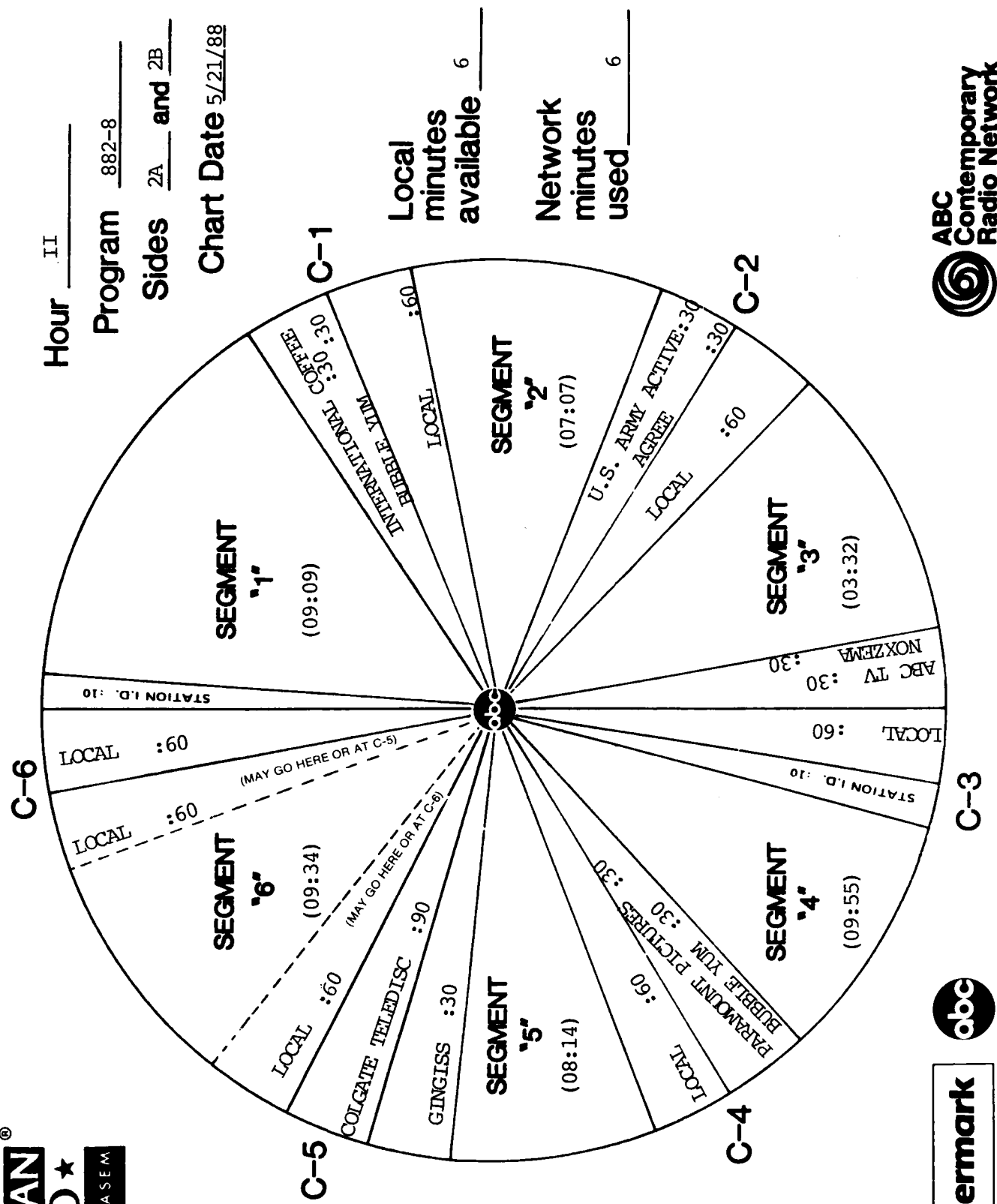

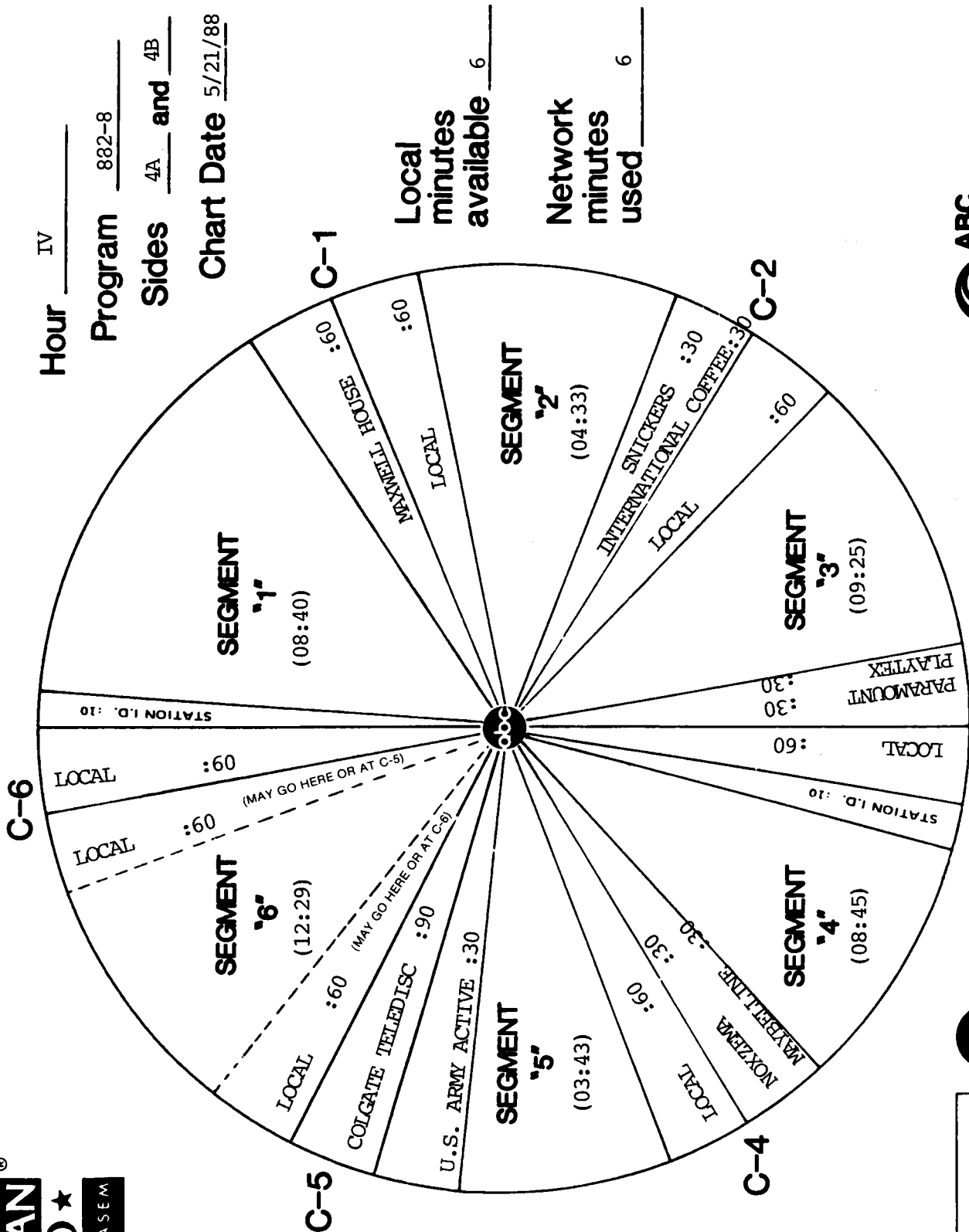

1. THEY FOUND THE SOUND THAT GOES 'ROUND (:25)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, Gloria Estefan and Miami Sound Machine hit #1 for their first time with "ANYTHING FOR YOU." Will they hold on to #1? Coming up fast from below is Johnny Hates Jazz with "SHATTERED DREAMS" and then there's George Michael's latest smash, "ONE MORE TRY." Who'll be on the top of the Official Billboard Survey this week? We'll count down the biggest hits by the hottest stars and find out on American Top 40.

2. ONE MORE ONE? (:28)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem, Who's the hottest star on the charts right now? Well, his solo album "Faith" just returned to the #1 spot on the Album Chart. And his last two hits from that album, the title song "FAITH" and the song "FATHER FIGURE", both hit #1. Will George Michael's latest hit, "ONE MORE TRY" spell one more #1 on the Official Billboard Survey? Last week, he took a big leap from #14 to #4 even' the top. We'll check out George Michael's moves this week on American Top 40.

3. ROCKERS RETURN (:26)

The popular pop rockers of the late 70's and early 80's, Cheap Trick, could have their first Top 40 hit in eight years with "THE FLAME." It's litin' a fire on the Official Billboard Chart, and Cheap Trick could be hot stuff to debut this week on American Top 40.
