1) FAST FOLLOW UPS TO BIG HITS (:25)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Among the records with a good chance to debut in this week's Top 40 - are follow-ups to some recent Top Ten hits: The Bangles follow-up to "MANIC MONDAY" is "IF SHE KNEW WHAT SHE WANTS"...Janet Jackson's follow-up to "WHAT HAVE YOU DONE FOR ME LATELY?" is "NASTY"...and the Rolling Stones' follow-up to "HARLEM SHUFFLE" is "ONE HIT TO THE BODY". If they debut or they don't, we'll know it - on American Top 40.

2) THE BRITISH ARE COMING -- AGAIN (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, the official Billboard survey put 18 British acts in the Top 40. That ties an all-time record! And this week, that record may be broken! Several more British acts could enter the Countdown this week: There's The Dream Academy...the new band, GTR... solo star Peter Gabriel...and--the Rolling Stones. The welcome mat's always out at American Top 40.

3) MADONNA TELLS ALL (:23)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40 Madonna moved up from Number Five to Number Two with "LIVE TO TELL". Will she be telling us this week that she's chalked up her third Number One smash -- or will Patti Labelle and Michael McDonald beat her to the Number One spot? Their dynamic duet -- "ON MY OWN" -- jumped all the way from Number Eleven to Number Three! Join me for our weekly scramble to the Top -- on American Top 40.
