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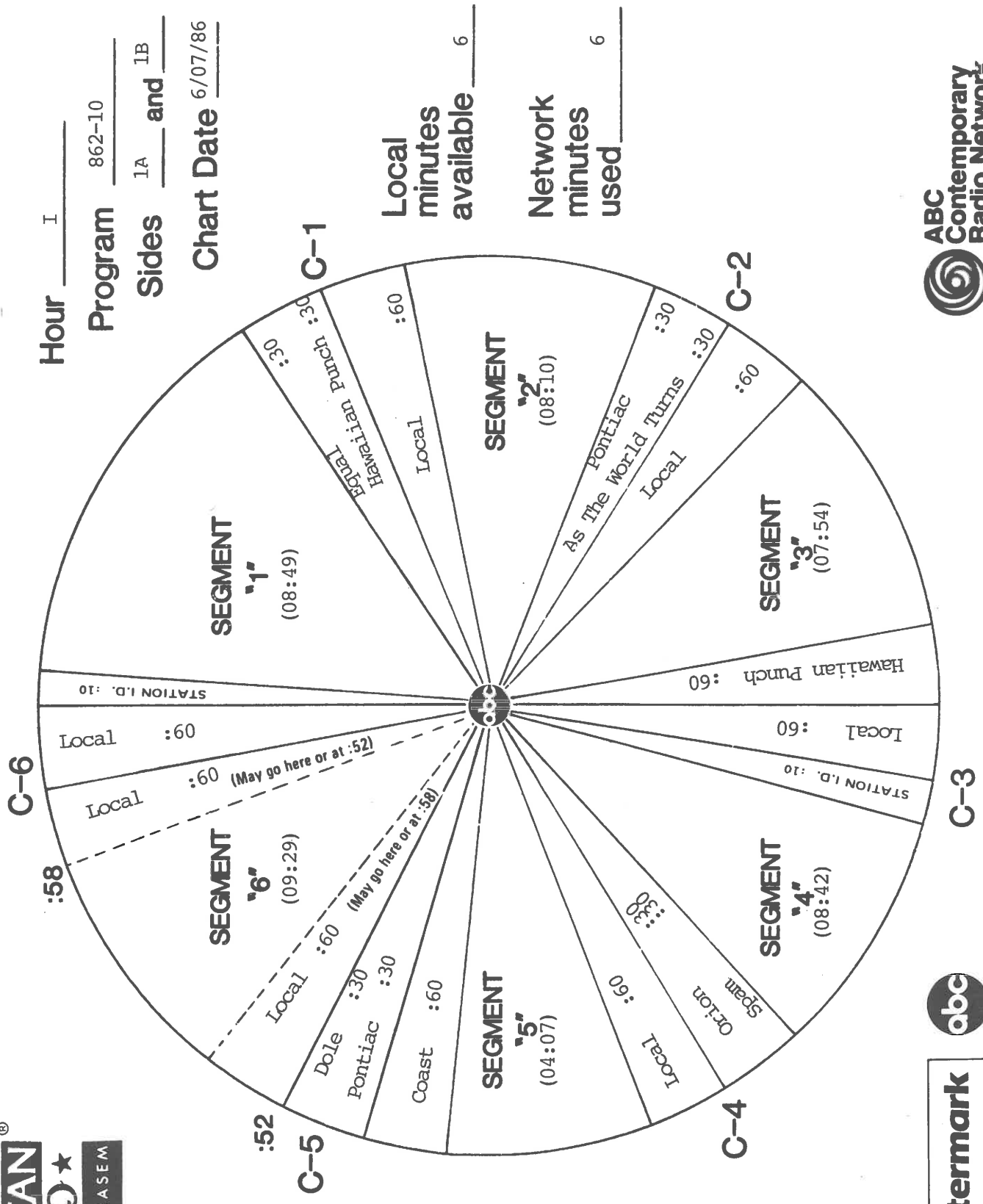

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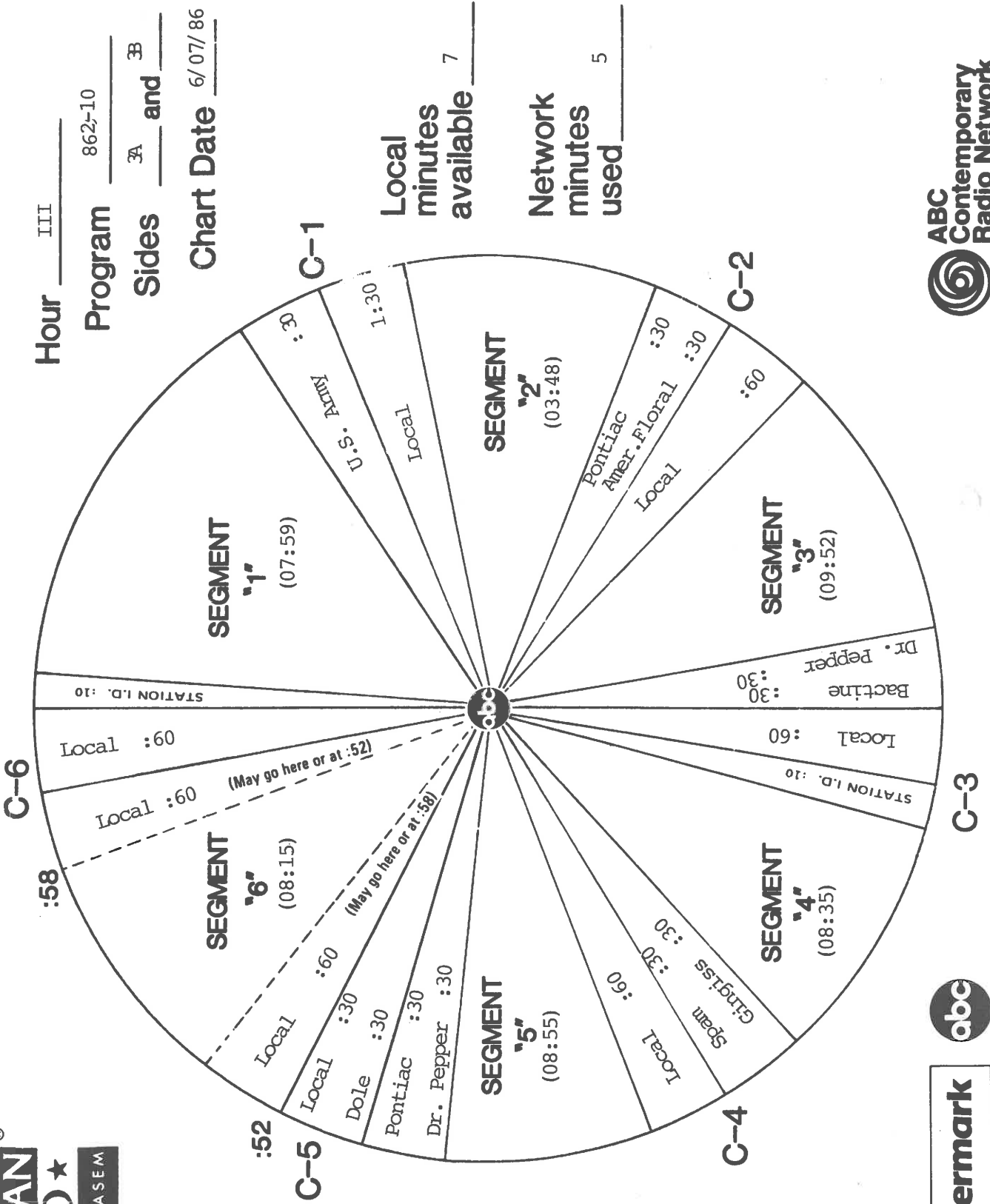

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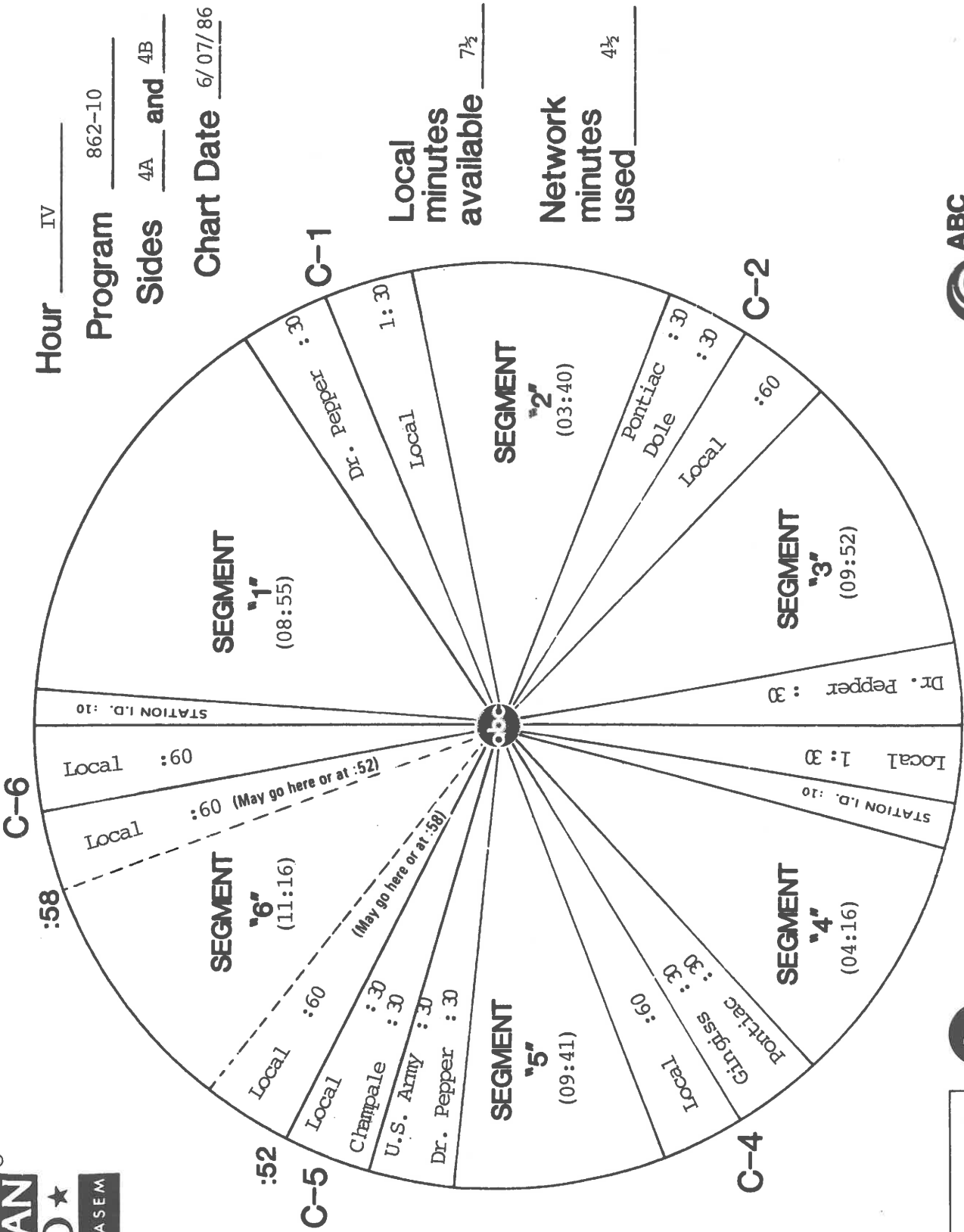

1) HERE COMES THE CAVALRY! (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week we had a record setting 20 British acts in the survey. But here comes the cavalry, riding to the rescue. On the chart horizon, ready to debut, are Americans Janet Jackson with "NASTY"--Kenny Loggins with "DANGER ZONE"--the Bangles, with "IF SHE KNEW WHAT SHE WANTS"--Van Halen, with "DREAMS"--and Prince & The Revolution, with "MOUNTAINS." We'll be watchin' for these homegrown acts on American Top 40.

2) FROM GENESIS TO REVELATION (:31)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. In last week's countdown, the English band Genesis was represented by four different men on four different records: Phil Collins on his solo hit---Mike Rutherford leading Mike & the Mechanics---former Genesis member Peter Gabriel with a solo hit---and former member Steve Hackett now in the band GTR. And those four men of Genesis may be joined by the band itself--because Genesis could debut this week with "INVISIBLE TOUCH." If it happens, we'll know about it on American Top 40.

3) BREAKIN' IN NU SHOOZ (:21)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, the top three hits in the survey didn't budge an inch: Patti LaBelle's duet with Michael McDonald sat at number three, Madonna at number two, and Whitney Houston at number one---all for the second week in a row. This week it looks like something's gotta give. Can Nu Shooz step into the top three with "I CAN'T WAIT?" We'll find out, on American Top 40.

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
