AT40 PROMOS FOR SHOW #852-11 ARE LOCATED AT THE END OF 2A.

DO NOT USE AFTER SHOW #852-11.

- 1) EVERYBODY WANTS TO BE NUMBER ONE (:23)
This is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40 Tears For Fears hit number one with "EVERYBODY WANTS TO RULE THE WORLD." But there are others who'd like to rule the top of the Official Billboard chart...like Billy Ocean with "SUDDENLY" and Bryan Adams with "HEAVEN", last week's number 4 and 5 songs. We'll have the results of the race for number one on this week's American Top 40.

- 2) BIGGEST MOVER FROM DURAN TIMES TWO (:19)
This is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40 Duran Duran's "VIEW TO A KILL" jumped from number 27 to number 15. That made it the biggest mover last week, and that kind of momentum may carry Duran Duran straight to the top. We'll report all the Official Billboard chart action this week on American Top 40.

- 3) DEBUT CONTENDERS (:19)
This is Casey Kasem. If you've already heard the new record by Sting of the Police, you know it's got hit potential. If you haven't it will probably debut in American Top 40 this week. Listen for "IF YOU LOVE SOMEBODY SET THEM FREE" by Sting. We'll bring you all the Official Billboard chart action on American Top 40.

- 4) CHART VETS (:20)
Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week five new records joined the countdown: Night Ranger's "SENTIMENTAL STREET," Air Supply's "JUST AS I AM," Supertramp's "CANNONBALL," Bruce Springsteen's "GLORY DAYS," and GETCHA BACK" by the Beach Boys. We'll see which songs debut this week on the Official Billboard chart on American Top 40.
