Dear Program Director,

This week, George Michael's controversial song, "I Want Your Sex," jumps into the Top 40 at #36--with a bullet. Even though some programmers have elected to delete the song from their playlists, Billboard Magazine reports that sales are strong. Strong enough to keep pushing it up the chart.

Since American Top 40 is faithful to the Billboard Hot 100 chart, we will, of course, include the song in the countdown. But we realize that each programmer is responsible for responding to the individual standards in his or her community.

So, if you'd like to delete the song from our countdown, here's the information you'll need to do it quickly. As I said, the song ranks at #36, so that's side 1A on disk, and the middle of hour one, if you tape it from satellite. It comes right after the third commercial break. Here's a transcript of the copy:

INTRO: "Well this next song is another debut. And it's a hit you may not be hearing a lot in your hometown. Some radio stations aren't playing it because of some controversy over the song's title and lyrics. But enough people are buying it to push it to #36 this week on the Billboard chart, sending it into our survey. Here's the latest by George Michael, "I Want Your Sex."

MUSIC: "I Want Your Sex"

OUTRO: That's the latest by English singing star George Michael. It debuts at #36. "I Want Your Sex." This is American Top 40, I'm Casey Kasem.


The song that comes right after it is "The Pleasure Principle" by Janet Jackson. And here's the beginning of that intro:

"Well now we're up to a woman who this week rewrites the history books..."

We're not exactly sure how many of our stations aren't playing it, but for the chart life of the record, we'll continue to give you the rank, and intro and outro cues in letter form. If you have any comments, please give me a call.

And we couldn't wait till the end of this decade for our next special. So here it comes now: "The 40 Top Hits of the 1980's, so far." That's the best of the '80's -- on American Top 40.

Y'see, T'Pau was the name of the High Priestess on Mr. Spock's home planet, Vulcan. And the group T'Pau has taken a highly logical move up the Top 40 with their hit, "HEART AND SOUL". Will it live long and prosper on the chart? We'll find out -- on American Top 40.

2. MS. JACKSON'S IN CONTROL (:22)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Who's the hottest female singer right now on the charts? Could be Madonna, but it might be Janet Jackson. She's currently climbing with "THE PLEASURE PRINCIPLE" -- the sixth single from her album "CONTROL". It's already topped the dance chart. If Janet's latest enters the countdown, she'll set a new all-time record for women -- re-writin' chart history on American Top 40.

3. IN NUMBERS TOO BIG TO IGNORE (:25)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And on the charts, women got the strength, women got the power. At Number One last week was Atlantic Starr, featuring singer Barbara Weathers. 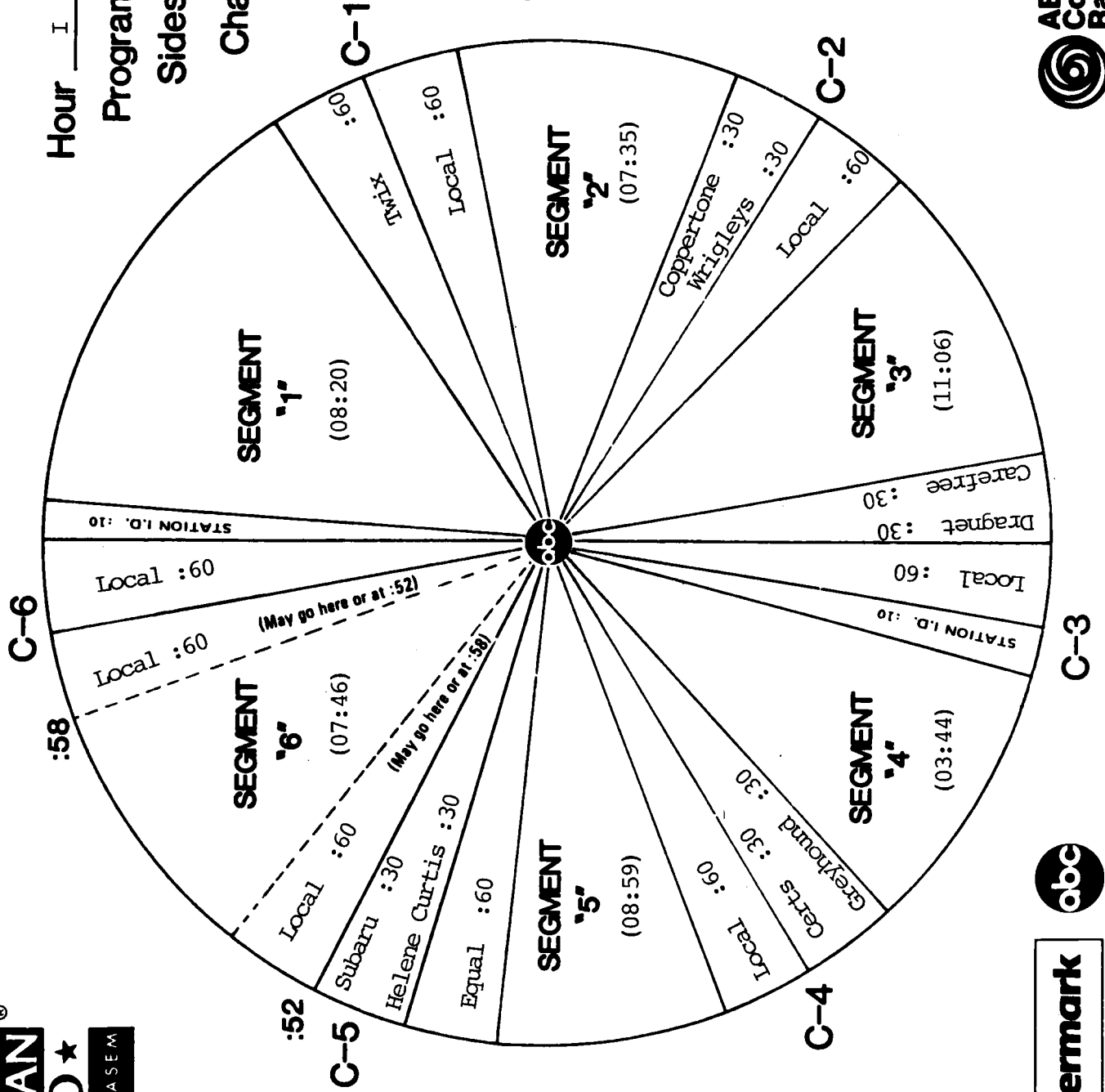

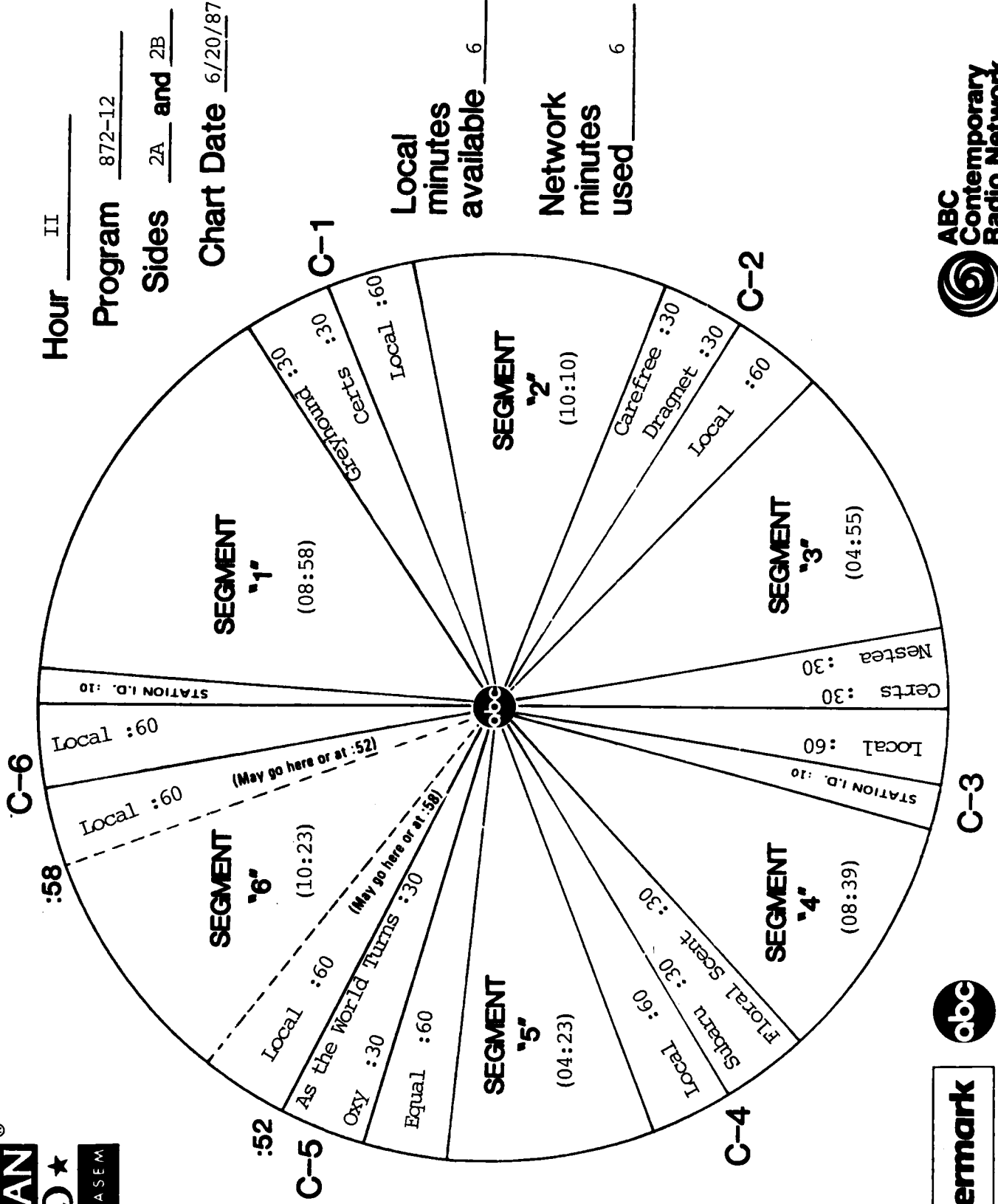

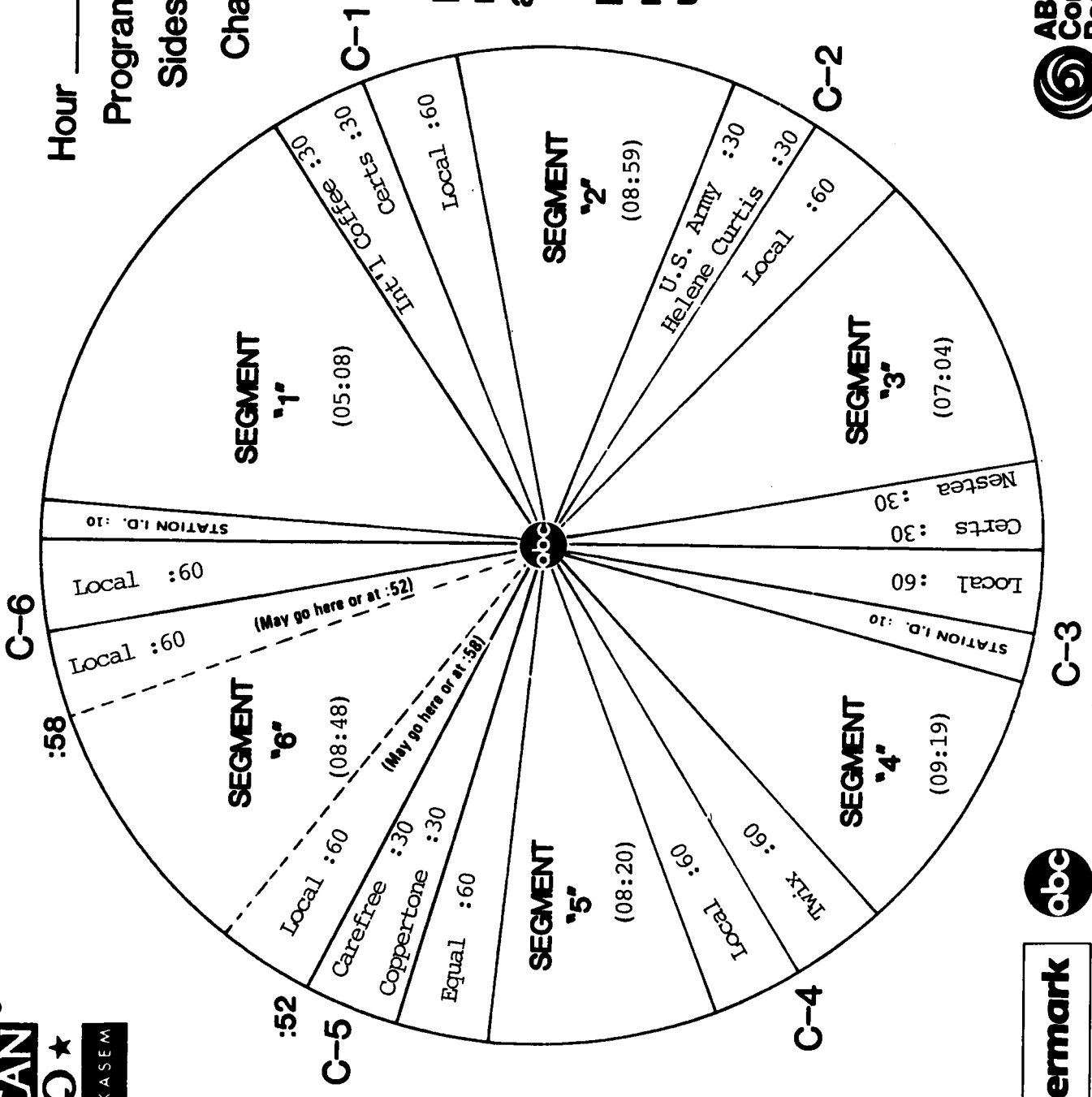

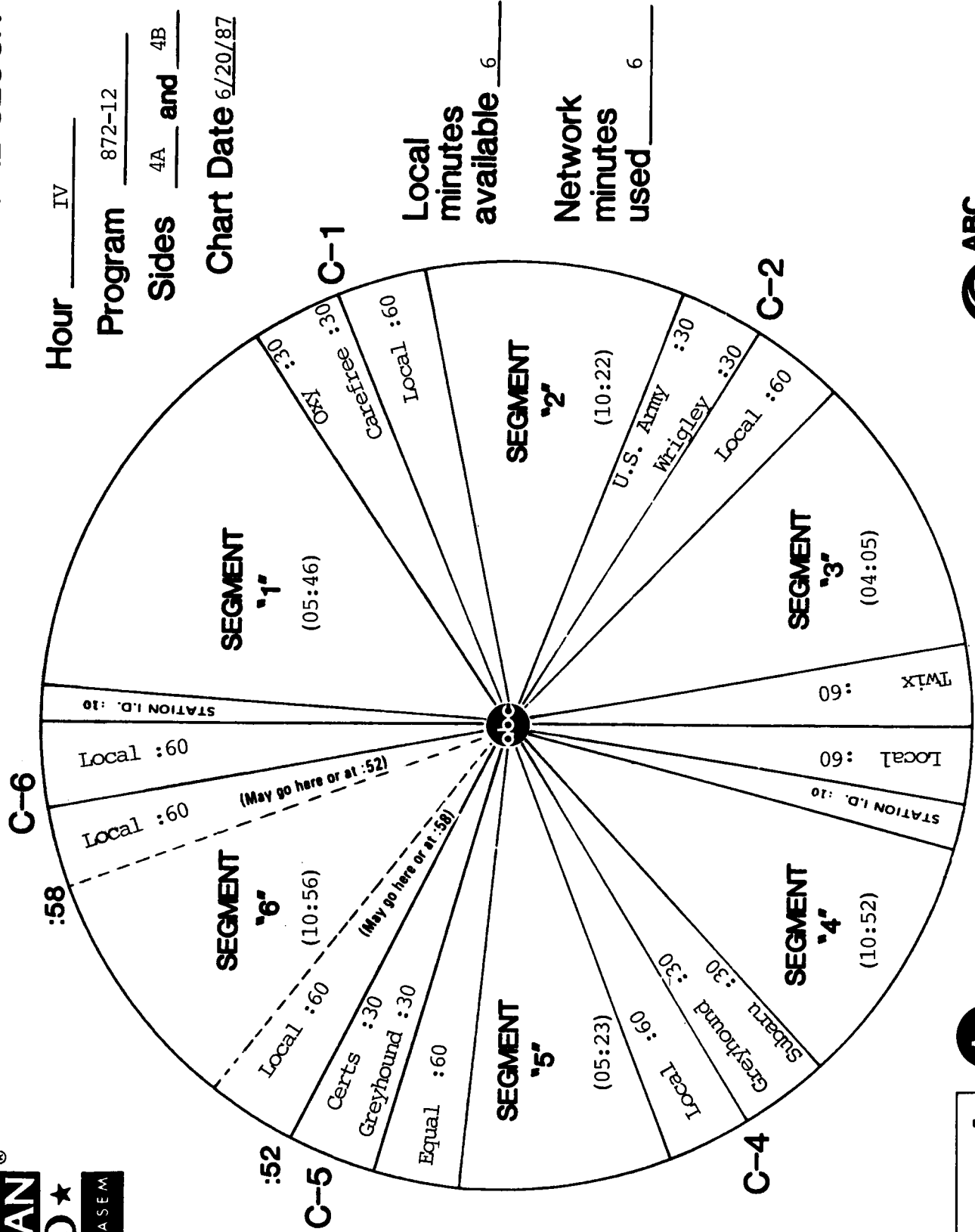
