..."And in the '80's, Lionel Richie. Thanks for writing in. And the countdown continues!"



TOPICAL PROMOS FOR SHOW # 872-13 ARE LOCATED AT THE END OF SIDE 4A

DO NOT USE AFTER JUNE 28, 1987

1) I WANT YOU SIXTH (:23)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, Janet Jackson made chart history when she became the first woman, ever, to get six Top 40 hits from one album. Only three men have done that -- her big brother, Michael Jackson, and Bruce Springsteen and Billy Joel. Janet's sixth Top 40 hit from her album "Control", is "THE PLEASURE PRINCIPLE". Join Janet as she re-writes the record books -- on American Top 40.

2) ANOTHER WINNER FROM WHITNEY (:18)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The last three records released by Whitney Houston all hit Number One. And now it looks like Whitney could score with a fourth Number One in a row. Her song, "I WANNA DANCE WITH SOMEBODY" leaped to Number Three last week. It could top the chart this week -- Another winner from Whitney -- on American Top 40!

3) ANOTHER MAC ATTACK (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well, even though they were off the chart for four years, it looks like America still has a taste for the Big Mac -- Fleetwood Mac. They last hit together back in 1983. But now, their new album, "Tango In The Night" has given us a Number Five smash, "BIG LOVE". And here comes the follow-up, it's "SEVEN WONDERS." Wonder if it'll hit the survey? Could have another Mac Attack -- on American Top 40.

4) DOO-WOP, DOO-WOP (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, a record debuted in the countdown that only uses one kind of instrument -- percussion. The rest is all voice -- the four voices of the four-man group called The Nylons. They're bringing 1950's doo-wop singing into the 80's with a 1960's song, "KISS HIM GOODBYE". Will The Nylons have a long run on the chart? We'll check 'em out -- on American Top 40.

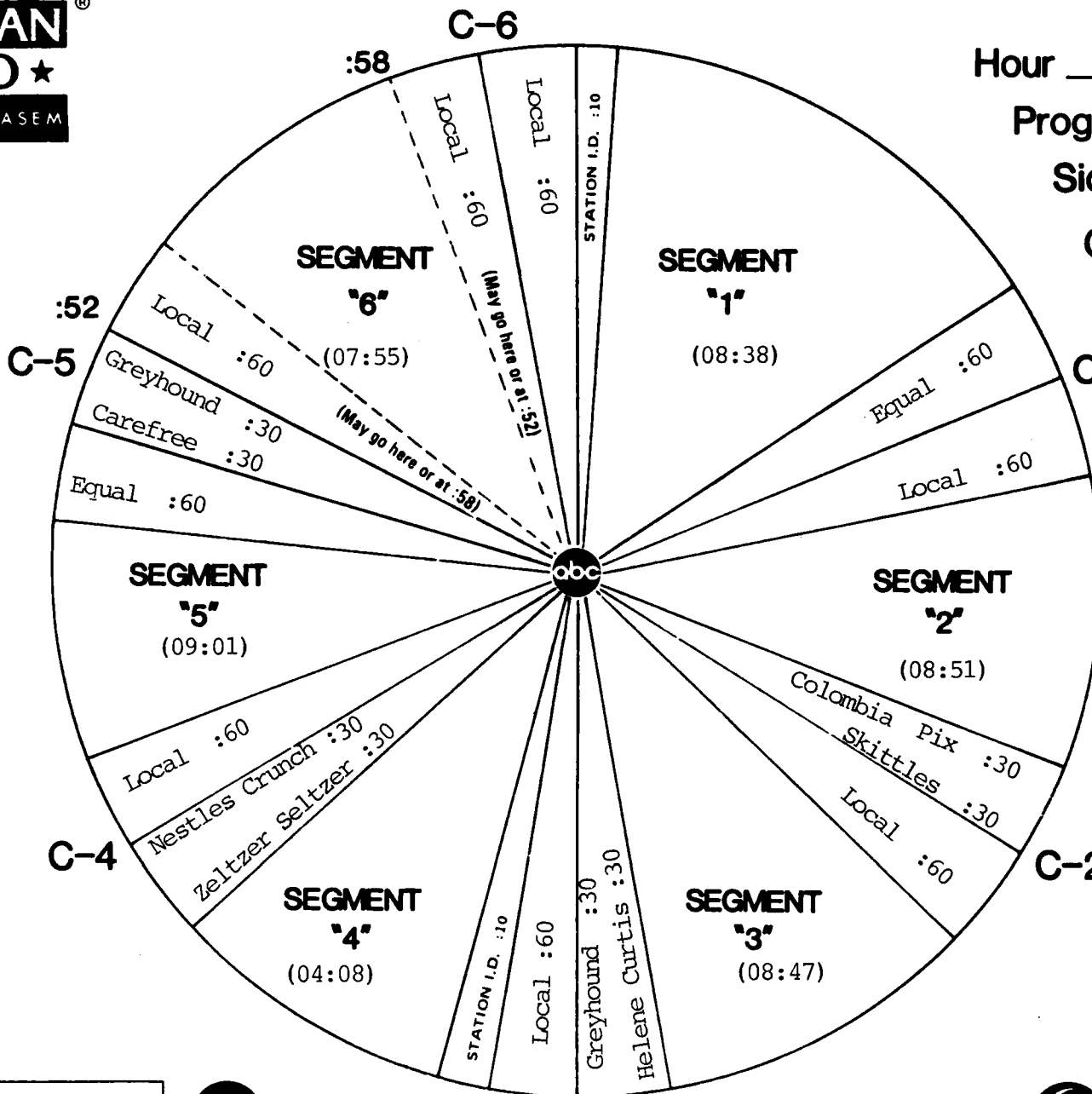


Hour I

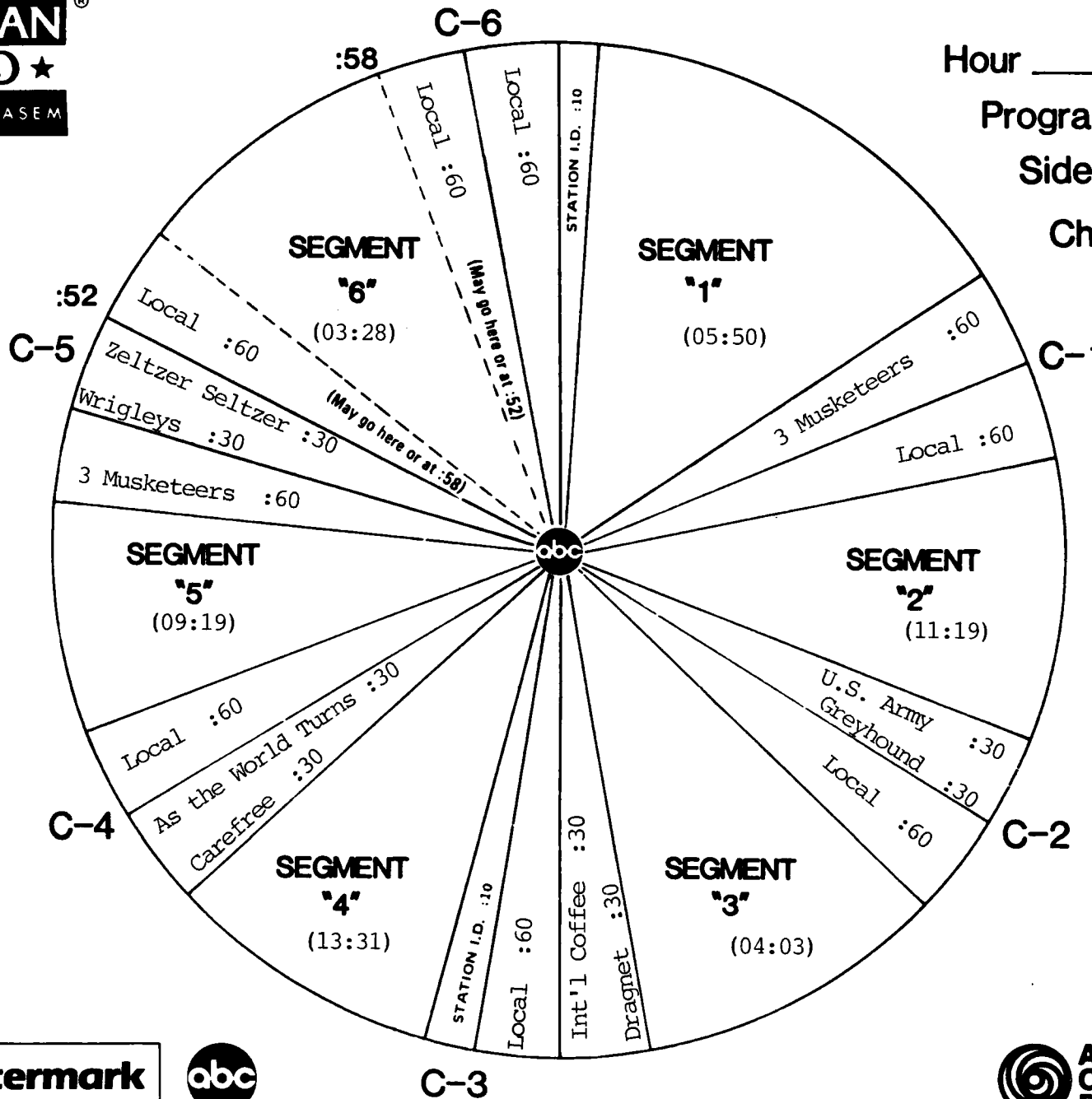


Hour II

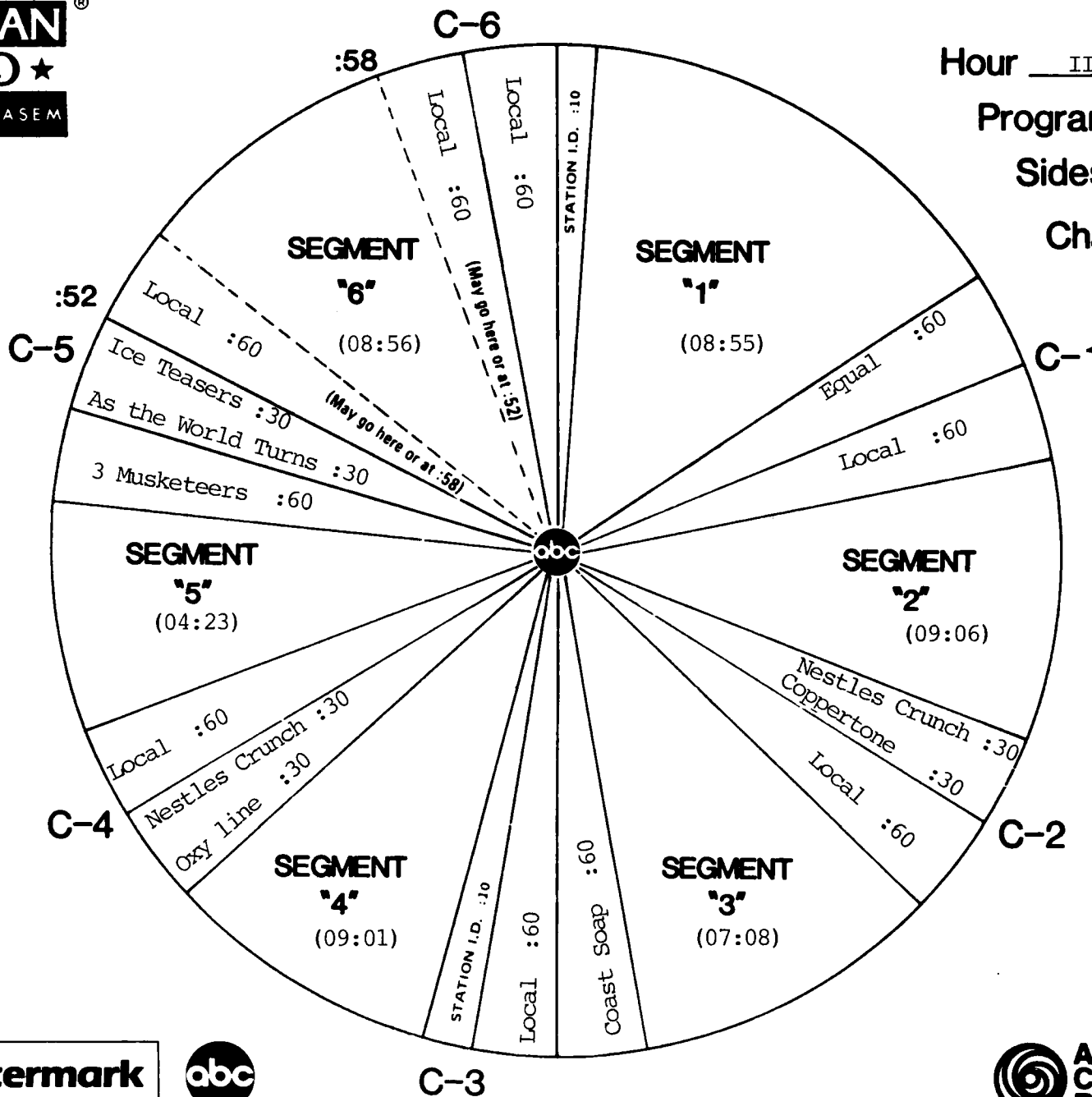


Hour III

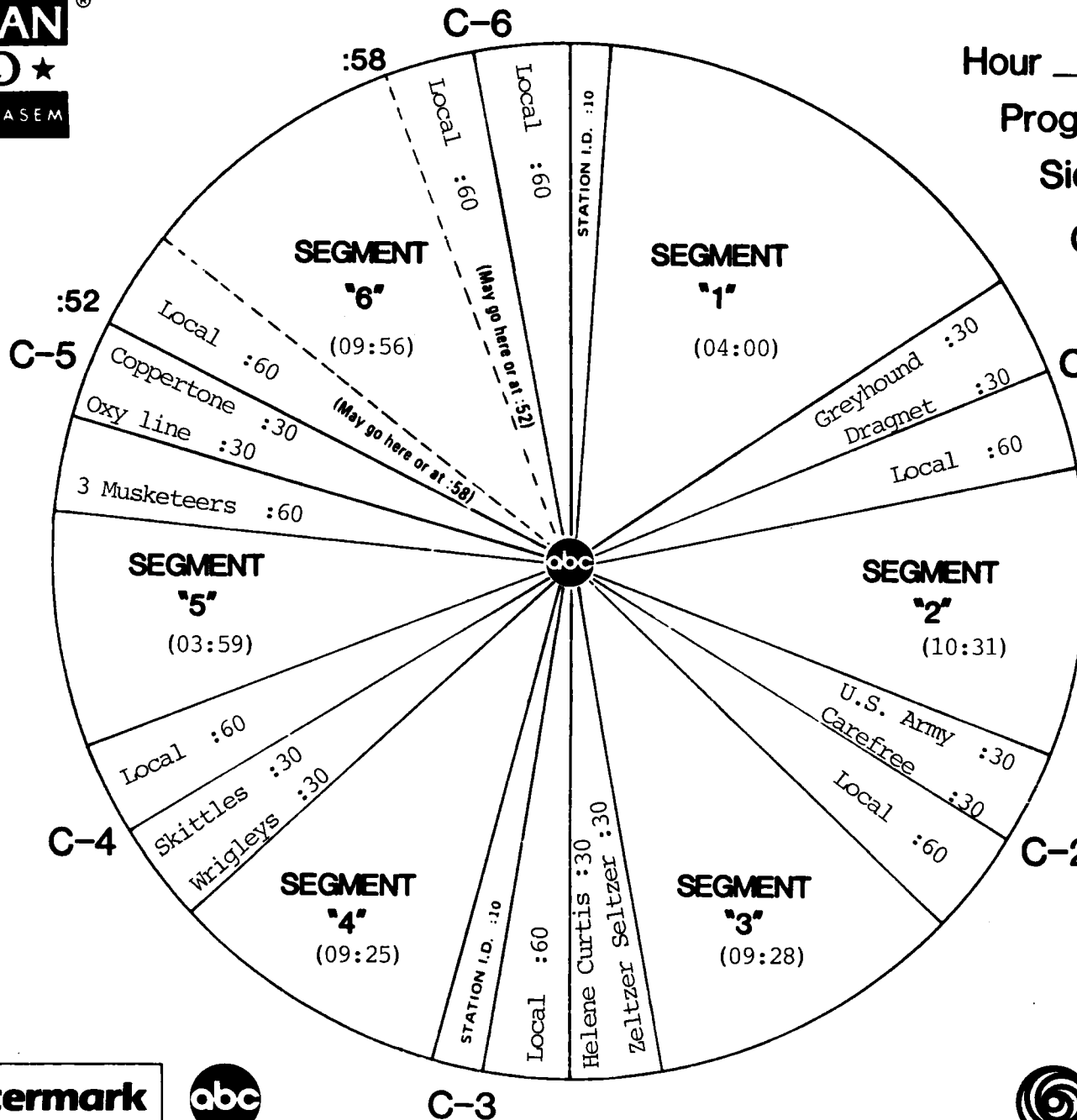
