1. If you're a recording act, it's got to be exciting when you hear your song on the radio or see your video on TV for the first time. It's probably hard to believe. Well it was VERY hard to believe for the band, LINEAR. When they first hit a couple of summers ago with "SENDING ALL MY LOVE" they were just FLYIN.' And when their video came on TV? Well listen to Charlie, Joey, and Wyatt:

LINEAR ACTUALITY: (:54) "We were in Houston Texas, me and Wyatt were sharing a room, and I guess it was late, maybe I'd say about 2 o'clock in the morning. And we're watching 'Night Tracks.' So we're talking, I was going into the bathroom to brush my teeth. All of a sudden we hear, 'And now, a trio from Ft. Lauderdale,' so I stopped! We're from Ft. Lauderdale, I figured well maybe we'll know who's on this, we'll maybe we'll know who it is!! So I stopped and listened! Maybe I'll know... fifty fifty chance! All of a sudden they go, 'Now, burning up the charts with their smash hit," I looked at Wyatt, he looked at me, my mouth dropped! I was like, come on, come on, give me Linear, "SENDING ALL MY LOVE." And he goes 'Linear, "SENDING ALL MY LOVE.'" I was like... (makes excited noises!) I ran to the phone, dialed Charlie... said "Charlie C-C-C-come! 10... put it on!" Hung up the phone, I was just sitting there, and I always have something to say, more or less!. I was speechless. I was in awe. There was nothing I could say. That had to be one of the most exciting experiences I had so far. Out of town. On a TV station I don't know of, seeing our video at 2 o'clock in the morning."
