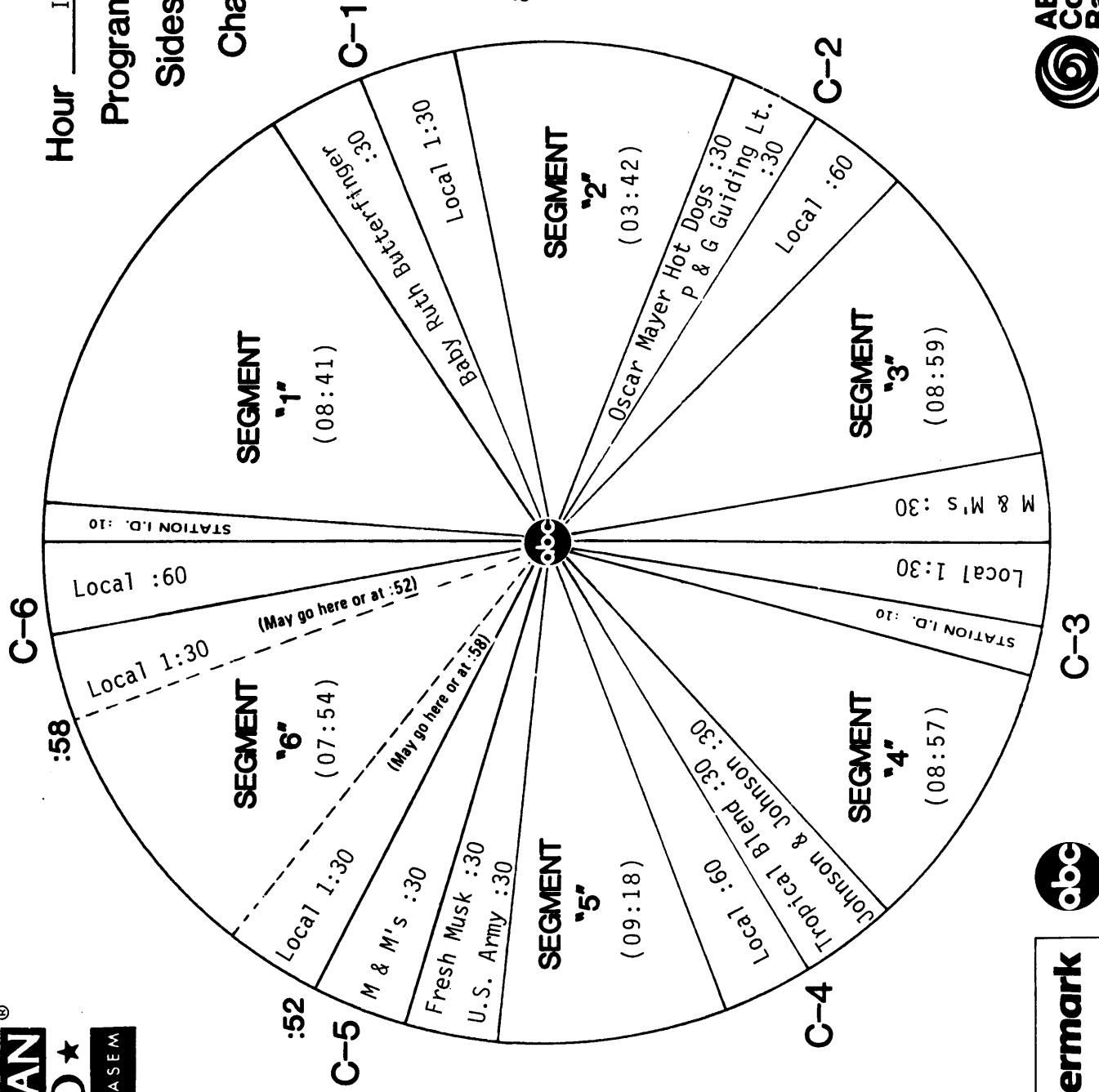

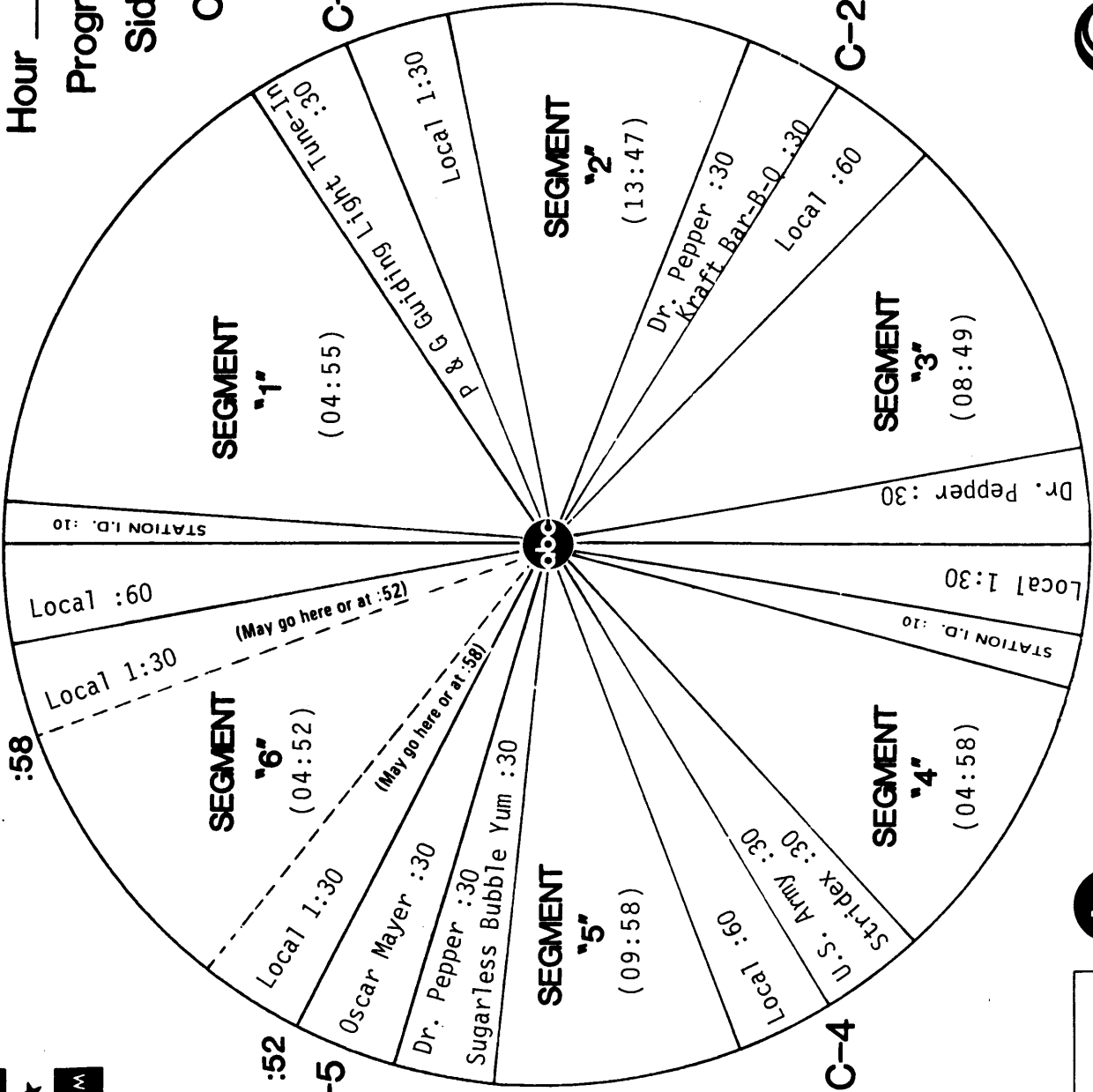

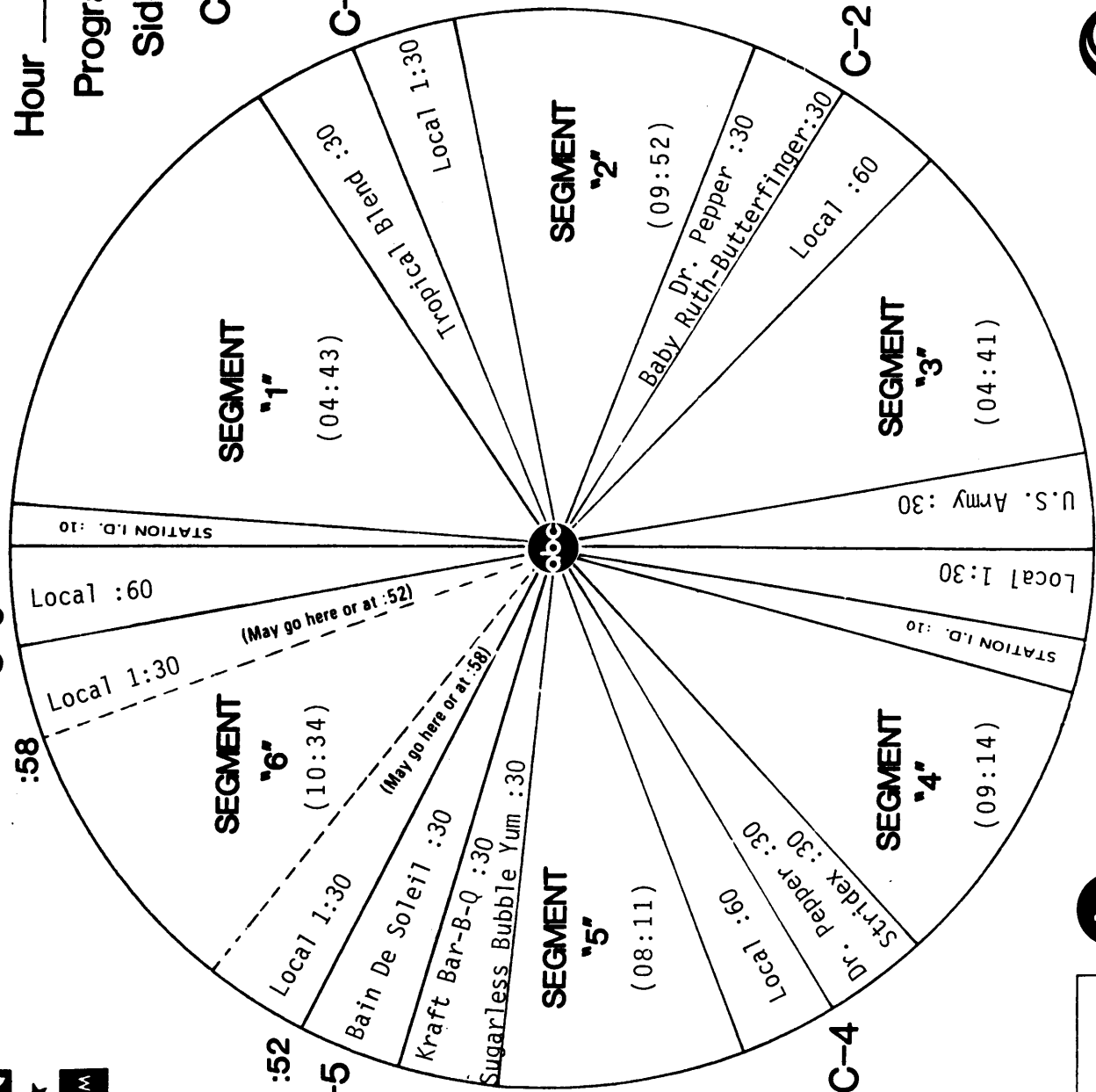

1) ACTION AT NUMBER ONE (:27)

Hi, I'm Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40, Bryan Adams moved into the top spot with his first number one song, "HEAVEN". It could hold on for a 2nd week--but there's a lot of competition for that top spot on the official Billboard chart--especially from "SUSSUDIO" by Phil Collins at no. 2, from "RASPBERRY BERET" by Prince at no. 4 and "A VIEW TO A KILL" by Duran Duran at no. 5. Who'll be at number one this week? Find out on American Top 40.

2) NEWCOMERS ON THE CHART (:19)

Hi, I'm Casey Kasem. This week, a number of big acts stand poised to enter the Top 40. Strong contenders are "ANIMAL INSTINCT" by The Commodores, "WHAT ABOUT LOVE?" by Heart, "BLACK CARS" by Gino Vanelli and "EVERYTHING I NEED" by Men at Work. 3) THE HUBBUB OVER 19 (:26)
