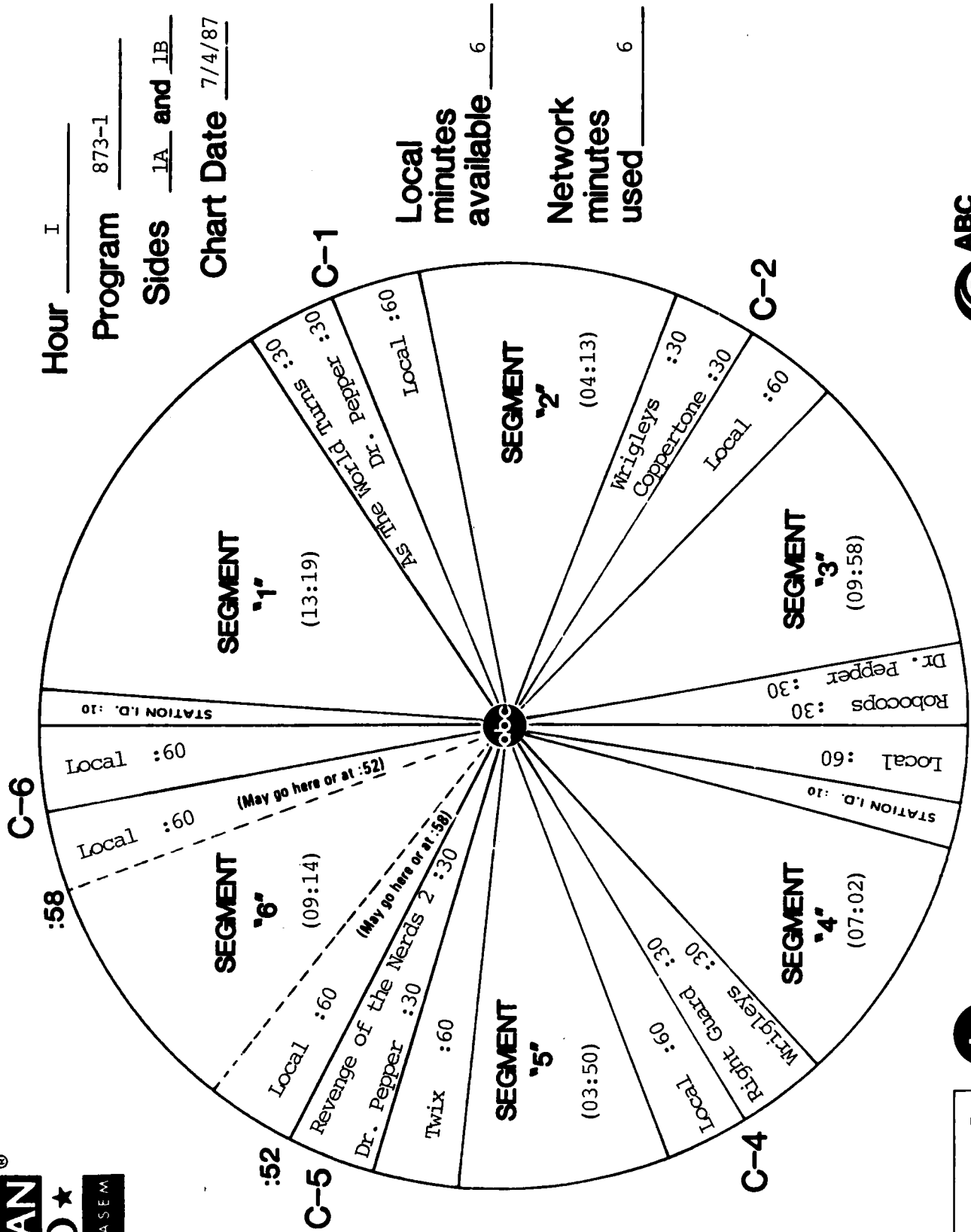

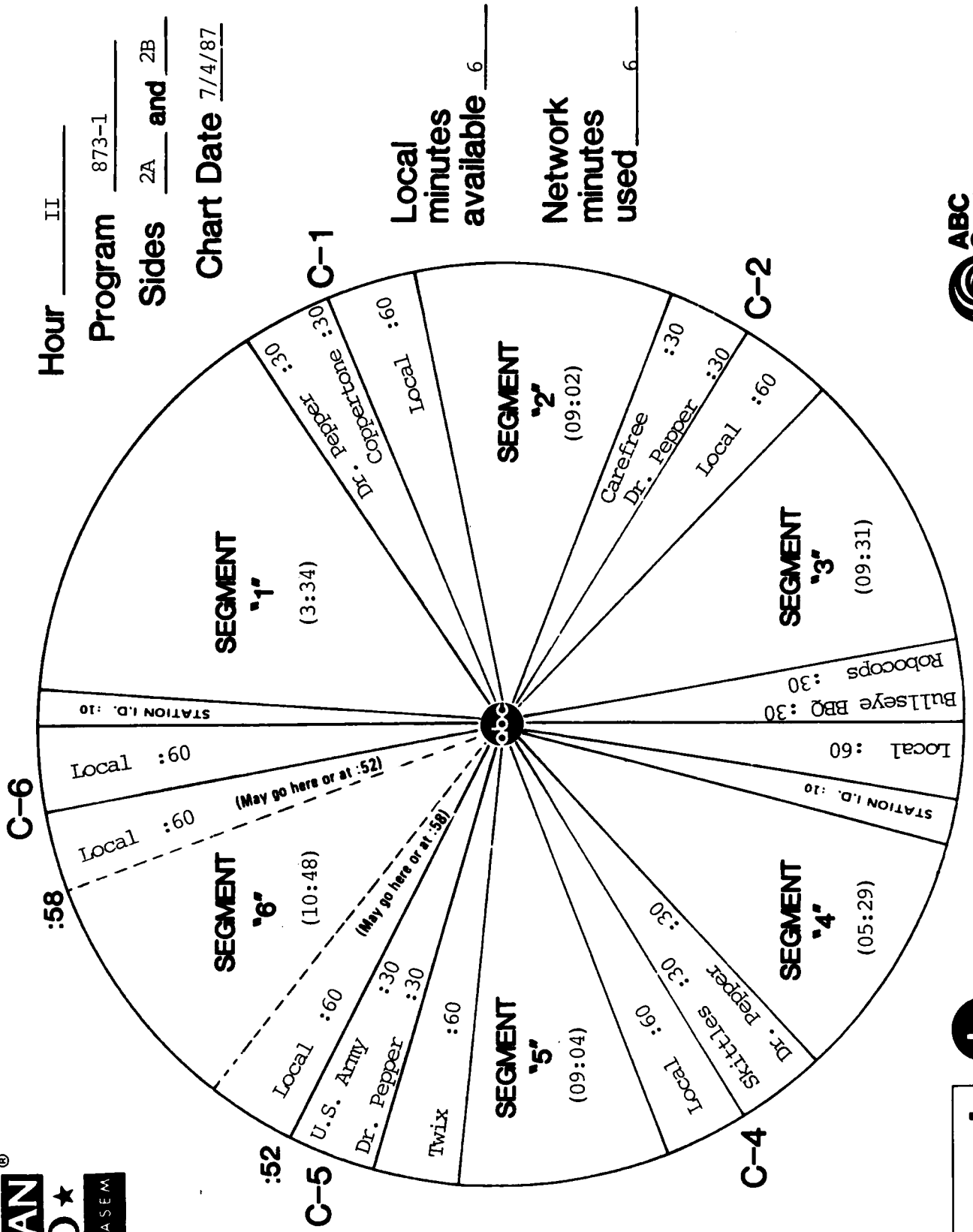

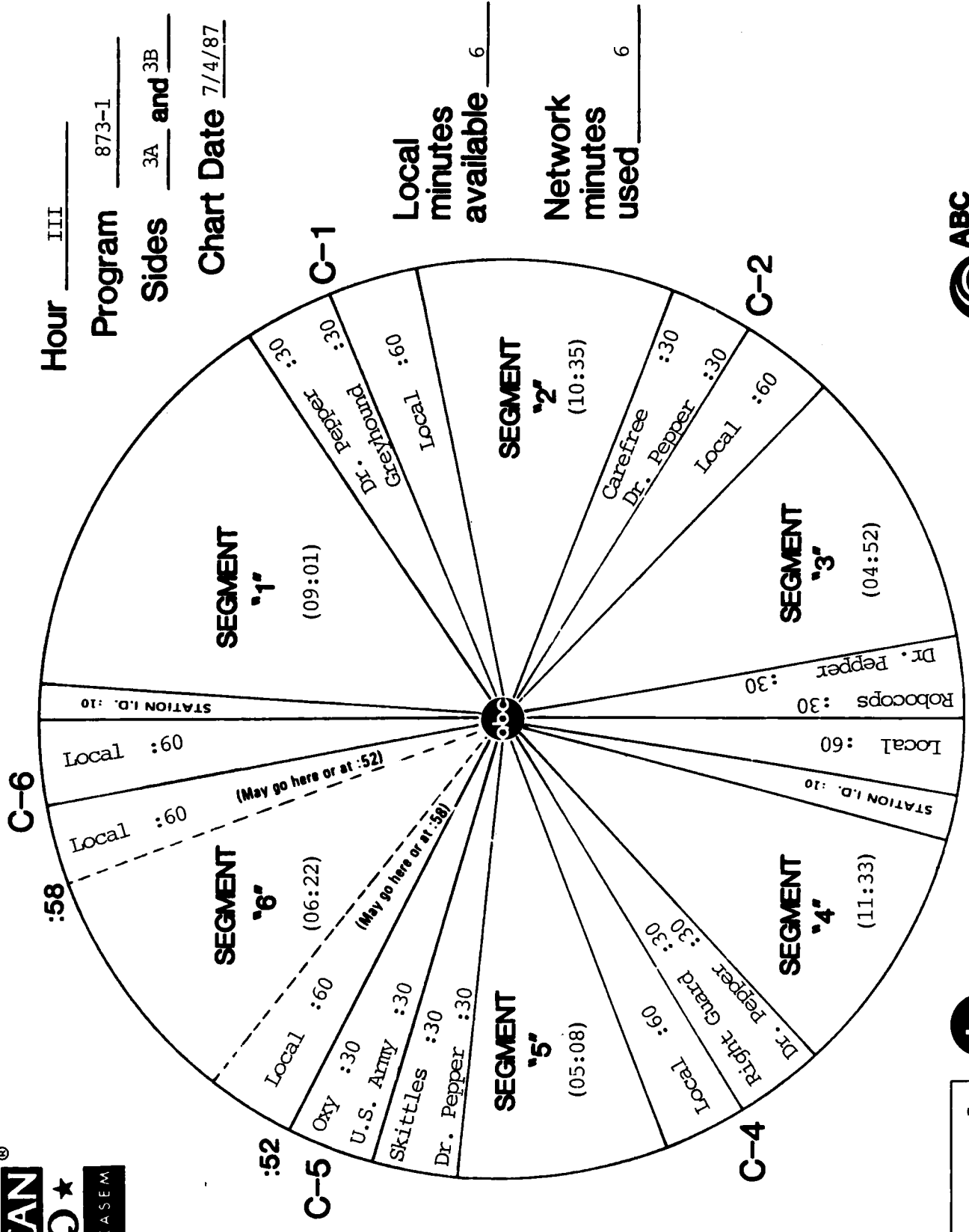

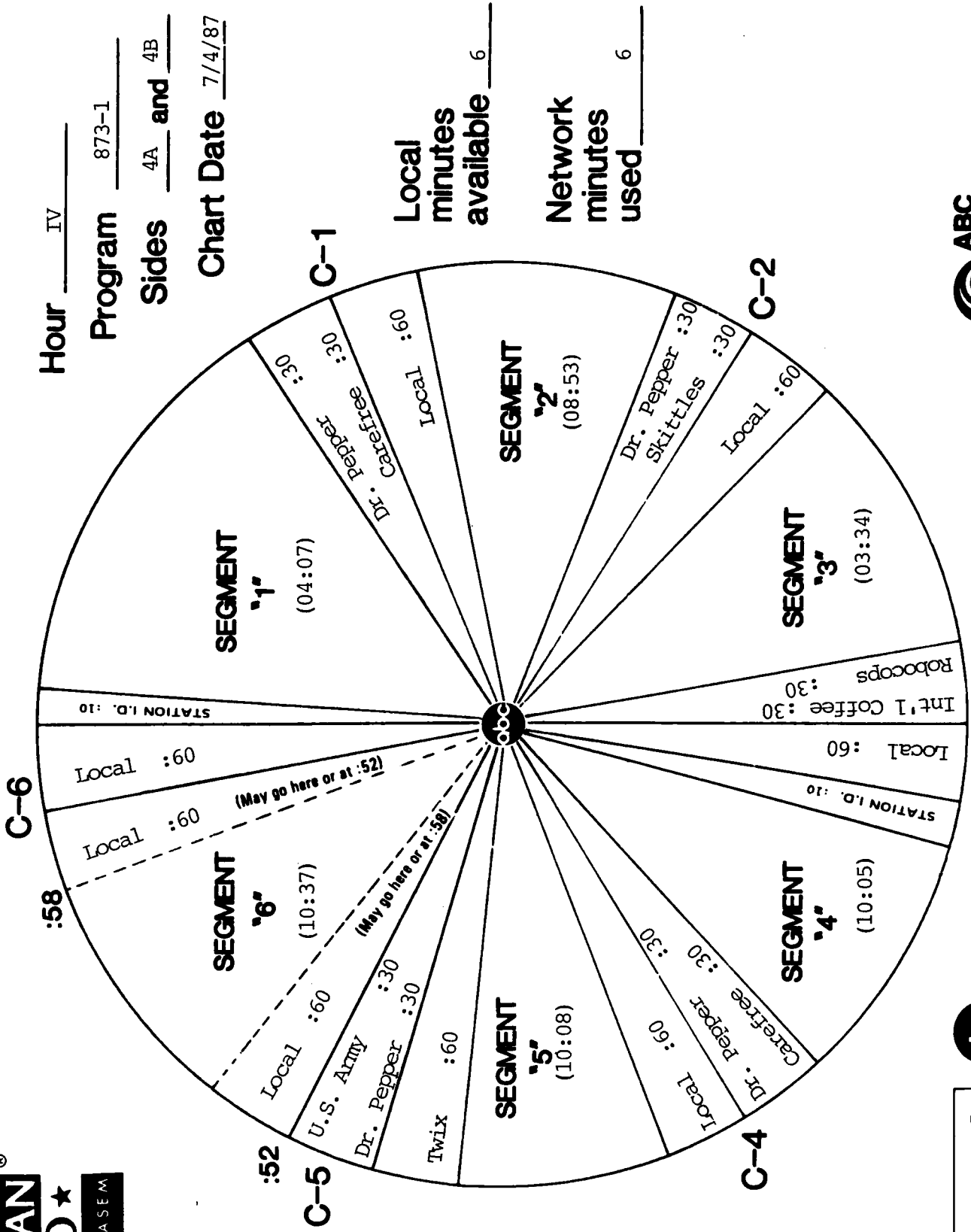

TOPICAL PROMOS

TOPICAL PROMOS FOR SHOW #873-1 ARE LOCATED AT THE END OF SIDE 4B

DO NOT USE AFTER JULY 5, 1987

1) SAVE US THE AISLE SEAT (:19)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The summer's hottest comedy film is doin' big numbers at the box office -- and big numbers on the chart. It's Eddie Murphy's smash, "Beverly Hills Cop, Two". And it's bustin' up the countdown with hits by Bob Seger, George Michael, and The Jets. We'll have to Cop it -- that Beverly Hills Officer is arrestingly successful -- on American Top 40.

2) LOOK AND YE SHALL FIND (:28)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. For years, rock fans loved 'em. Critics praised 'em. But the pop charts showed 'em no respect. Only one Top 40 hit in 8 years. But this year, things have changed for U2. They shot to #1 with their album, "The Joshua Tree". And the first single, "WITH OR WITHOUT YOU" hit the top. Now, the follow-up "I STILL HAVEN'T FOUND WHAT I'M LOOKING FOR" is climbing fast in the countdown. Looks like U2 have found chart power -- on American Top 40.

3) DO BEES BEE, DO BEARS BEAR, DOES AL JARREAU? (:19)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And movin' up the chart towards the countdown is the theme song from one of America's most popular TV shows. The romantic comedy about those unlikely detectives Maddie Hayes and David Addison. The theme song from "MOONLIGHTING". All Jarreau sings it, and "MOONLIGHTING" could shine in the survey this week -- on American Top 40.

4) A VEGA VOYAGE ON THE CHART (:20)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. One of this week's debut songs in the countdown could be by a singer named Suzanne Vega. A few years ago, she emerged from the New Folk music scene, in Greenwich Village, New York, to a lot of critical acclaim. Well now she has her first hit, called "LUKA". Suzanne Vega could venture in -- on American Top 40.
