TOPICAL PROMOS ARE LOCATED AT THE END OF SIDE

1. #883-2C: TRICKSTERS TRIUMPH (:28)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. This colorful rock quartet first hit the Top 40 back in 1979 with a Top Ten song called "I WANT YOU TO WANT ME". Now, almost a decade later, they want the Top Spot on the Official Billboard Chart. They've been sizzling in the survey with "THE FLAME". Cheap Trick stoked the fire at #3 last week. Will they burn more brightly at #1 this week? We'll find out as we count down the hottest hits — on American Top 40.

2. 883-2D: A CONTOURED CLASSIC (:30)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The last few years has seen quite a few old hit records returning to the chart — like "STAND BY ME" - and "TWIST AND SHOUT". Well just last week, another golden oldie was reborn in the Top 40. A 1962 Top Ten hit by the Contours that was featured that was featured last year in the movie "Dirty Dancing". And now, that song, "DO YOU LOVE ME" is back on the Official Billboard Survey nearly 26 years after it first hit. The Contours are climbing the countdown — on American Top 40.

3. #883-2A RECORD SETTING 'BAD' MAN (:20)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, Michael Jackson hit #1 with "DIRTY DIANA" — the fifth #1 in a row from his album, "Bad". And it made Michael the first Recording Artist in history to get Five #1s from one album. Will Record-breaking Michael hold on to that top spot this week? Join us for the Legends who rewrite the Record Books each week — on American Top 40.

4. #883-2B TWISTIN' THE CHART AWAY (:21)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And here comes another new version of a rock'n'roll classic. It's a rap remake by New York's Fat Boys — with guest vocals by the man who originally took this song to #1 back in the early 60s — Chubby Checker. The Fat Boys and Chubby are climbing the Official Billboard Chart doin' "THE TWIST". And they may be twisting our way this week — on American Top 40.
