Dear Program Director,

George Michael's song, "I WANT YOUR SEX" moves up to #5 on the Billboard chart this week. Here's the information you'll need to do a quick edit, if you've decided to delete the song from the countdown:

Song #5 comes right after commercial break #3 in hour four. So you can make a simple edit: just jump from the end of the tease (which comes right after the outro to song #6, "RHYTHM IS GONNA GET YOU")--right into the payoff to the story at song #4.

OUTRO #6: "Rhythm Is Gonna Get You"--and it might get Gloria Estefen and Miami Sound Machine their first #1 hit. We'll see...This week, they jump four notches to #6. This is American Top 40, I'm Casey Kasem...We're counting down to the story of a basketball game with two of the biggest talents of the decade. One's a record producer who stands five foot ten. The other's a superstar singer who stands maybe five foot three. Place your bets, the story's coming up.

INTRO #5: AT 40 originates in Hollywood.  
(JINGLE #5)  
24 year old George Michael looks like he's just not satisfied with anything less than #1.....(etc.)

OUTRO #5: Up four notches to #5--that's George Michael with his ninth top 40 hit overall. Sixth week in the survey. This is Casey on American Top 40

INTRO #4 (PAYOFF TO THE TEASE THAT CAME AFTER #6 OUTRO)  
Now we're up to a song produced by one of the decade's hottest producers--who dared to compete with one of the decades hottest pop stars...in a game of basketball, that is...(etc...)

There's the line up. Again, I hope you'll keep the tease that goes to the payoff story at #4. Not only is the tease an effective way to keep listeners through a commercial break, but it sets the story up to have more impact. See you next week.

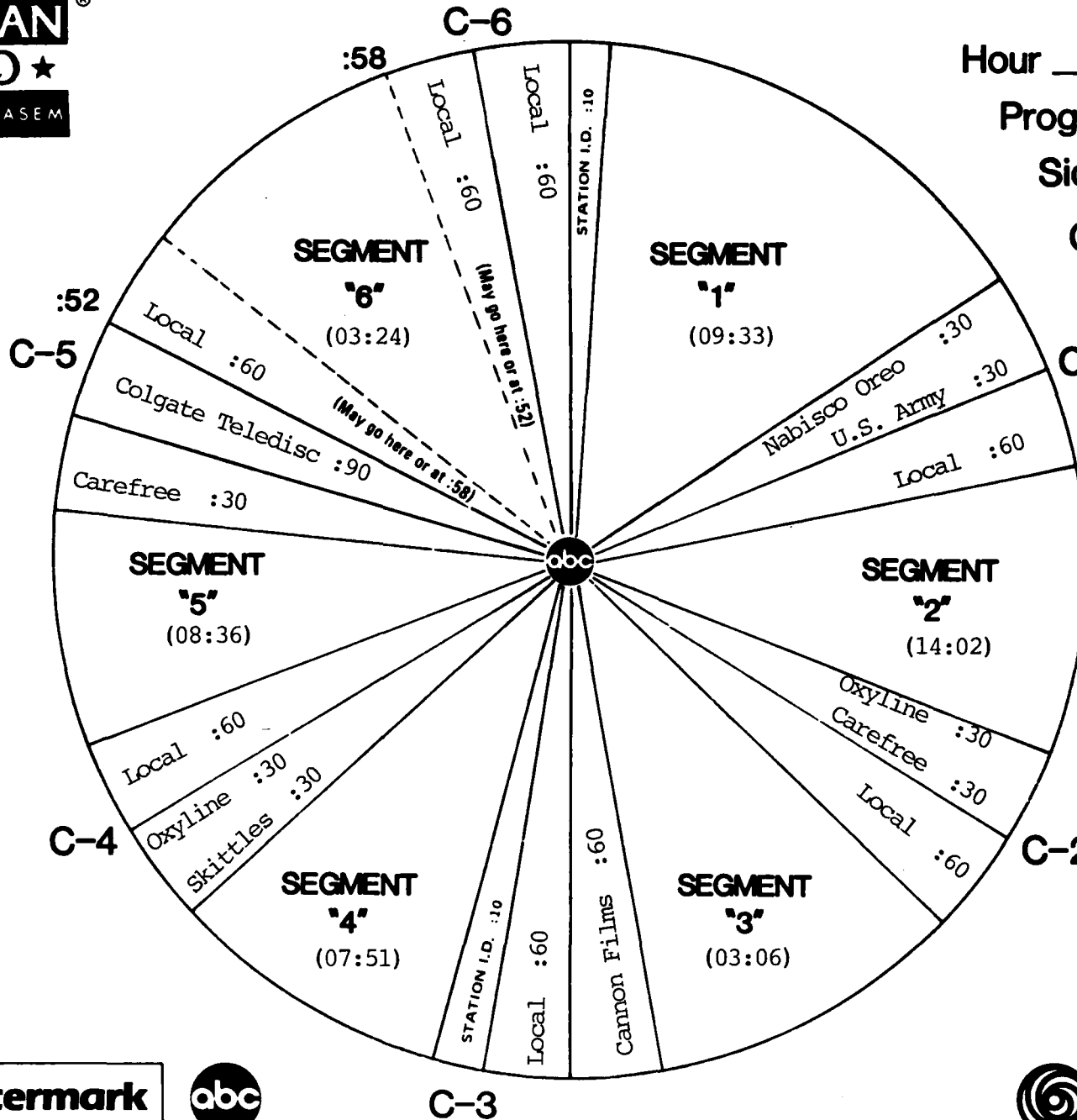

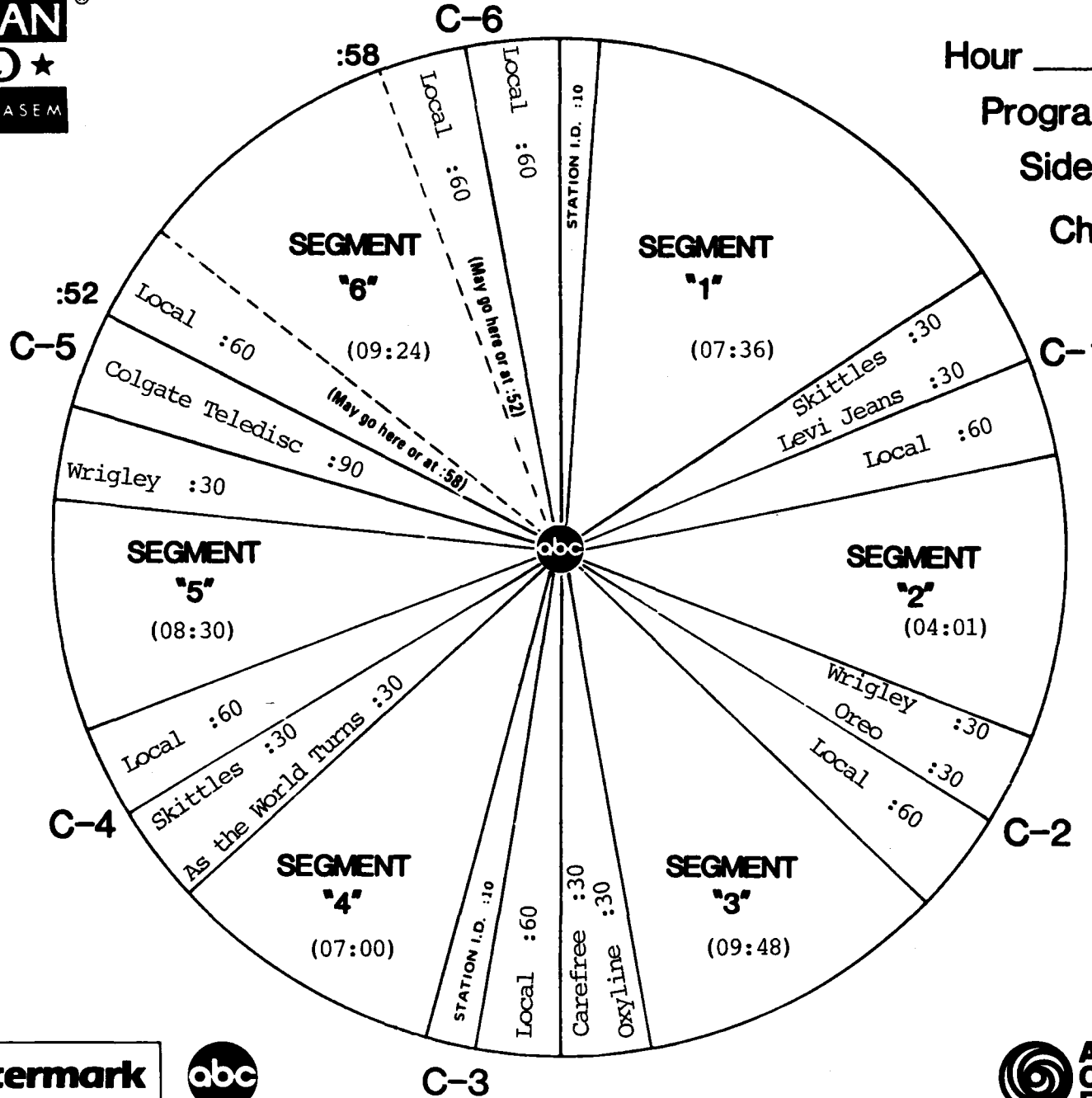


Hour II

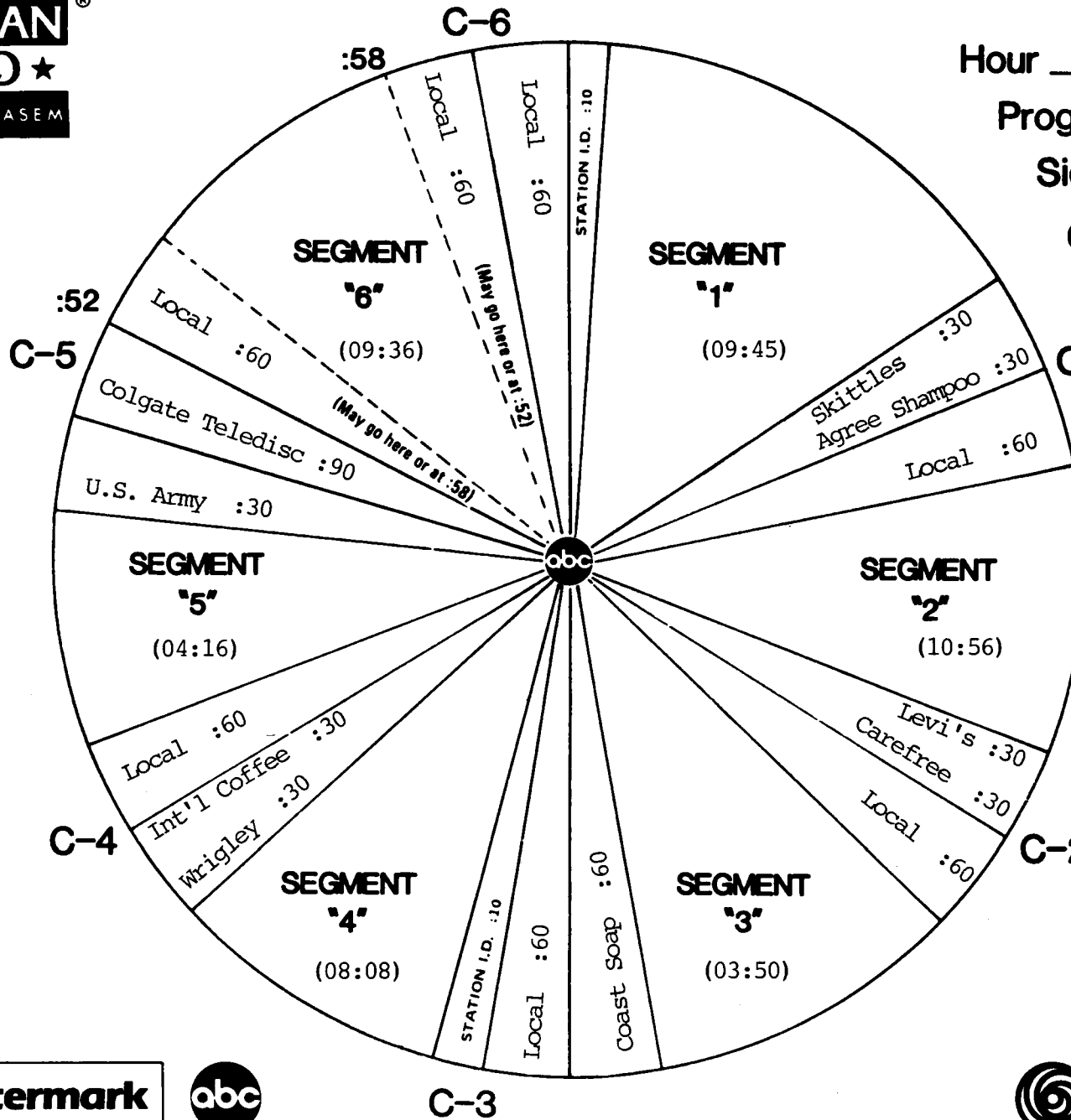

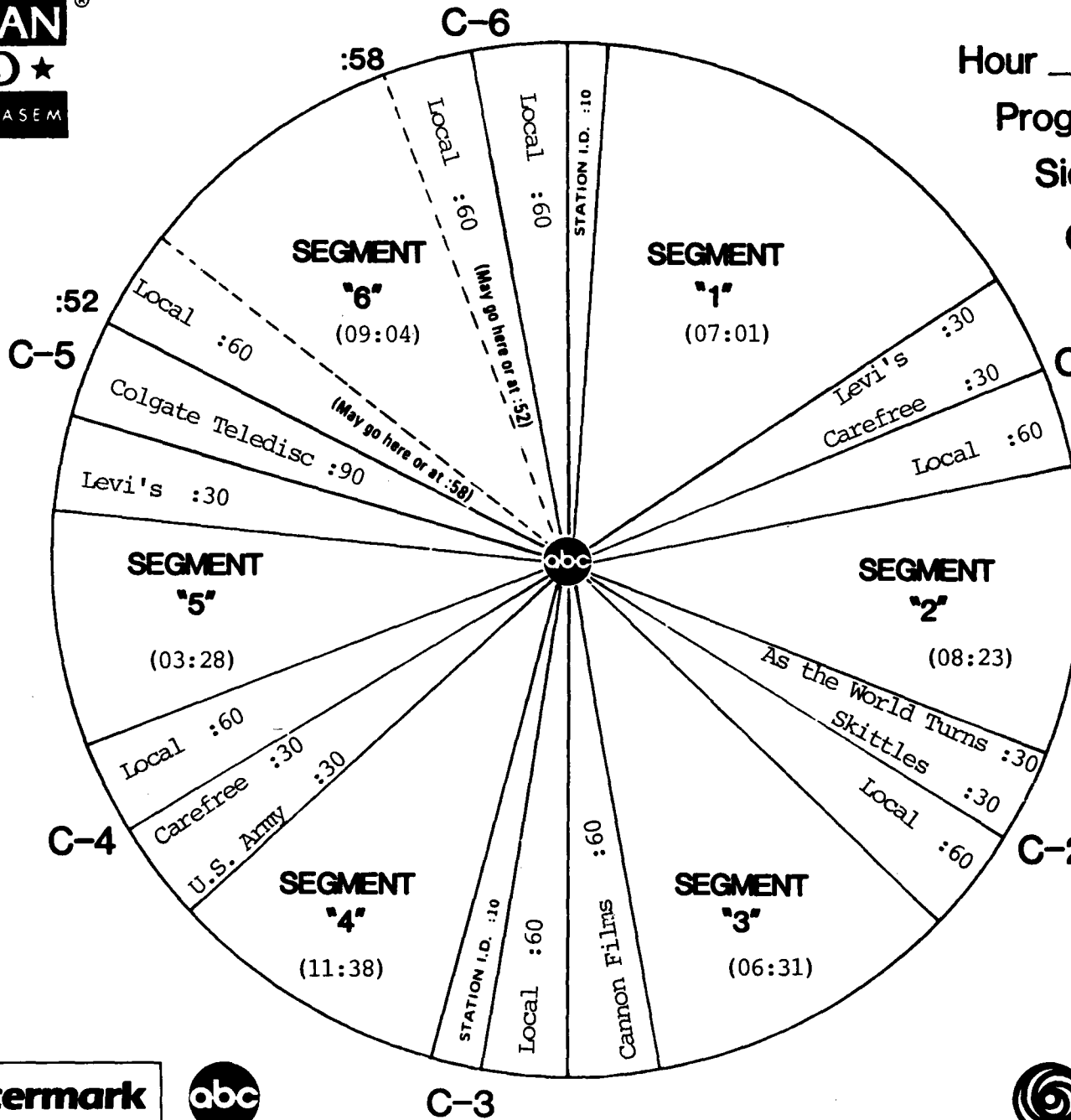

1) WHAT DO YOU DO FOR AN ENCORE (:28)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, three acts debuted in the countdown with follow-ups to #1 songs. There was Club Nouveau, followin' up their #1 "LEAN ON ME" with their new one, "WHY YOU TREAT ME SO BAD". There was Cutting Crew followin' up their #1 "I JUST DIED IN YOUR ARMS" with "ONE FOR THE MOCKINGBIRD". And then there's the Starship, hot on the heels of their #1 "NOTHING'S GONNA STOP US NOW" with "IT'S NOT OVER 'TIL IT'S OVER". Recent #1 groups -- making encore performances -- on American Top 40.

2) BACK IN THE CHART LIFE (:26)

Hi, I'm Casey Kasem. One of the past year's great comeback stories has been the English star who first hit the charts 20 years ago, with the Spencer Davis Group -- Steve Winwood. Recently he had his first #1 with "HIGHER LOVE". Followed that up with "FREEDOM OVERSPILL", and then "THE FINER THINGS". We'll check out all the chart action as it happens -- on American Top 40.

4) A HOWLIN' HIT (:22)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, the cry of the wolf was heard in the countdown. The Grammy-award winning band from East LA -- Los Lobos -- pounced into the survey. "Los Lobos" is Spanish for the Wolves -- and these rockin' wolves have remade Richie Valens' '50's classic "LA BAMBA". They play it on the soundtrack of the new movie "La Bamba", and it's climbin' the chart -- on American Top 40.

5) WHO'S THAT GIRL -- EVERYBODY KNOWS! (:19)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Who's that girl? Her concert tour is one of the hottest tickets of the summer. Who's that girl? It's the title song of her new movie. And she debuted last week with the title song from that movie. She's the biggest female star of the '80's. Who's that girl? Madonna. And we've got her -- on American Top 40.
