1. We asked Amy Grant how she went from writing "Spiritual" songs into "pop" smashes and she gave us the whole story:

AMY GRANT ACTUALITY: (:41) "I have spent, like over ten years, writing songs and just trying meticulously to articulate my faith...how that translates into everyday life. Trying to show the human side of spiritual things. I've never really said, 'Hey, I'm gonna take all this songwriting energy and pour it into something totally new.' And all I can say is it was like turning on a faucet that was jam packed full of water for the first time. I just...pphew! So, I just got lost in the waterfall of it all, you know?"

2. COLOR ME BADD may be one of the hottest singing acts of the 1990s, but some of their inspirations go back 20, 30 years:

COLOR ME BADD ACTUALITY: (1:29) "We like to go back to the Old School. And, uh, you know, learn from that. And we were at the BRE Convention, and we performed there. But in rehearsal, the Dells were there. And we got to sing for them. And it was - it was almost a tearjerker. I mean, I just had to hold back, you know, singing for people that we actually, admired and idolized. And, Sam Moore of Sam and Dave was there. And he gave us a lot of great advice. And it was just a real touching story and a great moment in Color Me Badd's life." "Yeah, we sang one of their tunes at our Senior Prom." "And then afterwards, it's like, 'I can't believe it! Wait a minute. I just sung with such and such'. And that was great."
