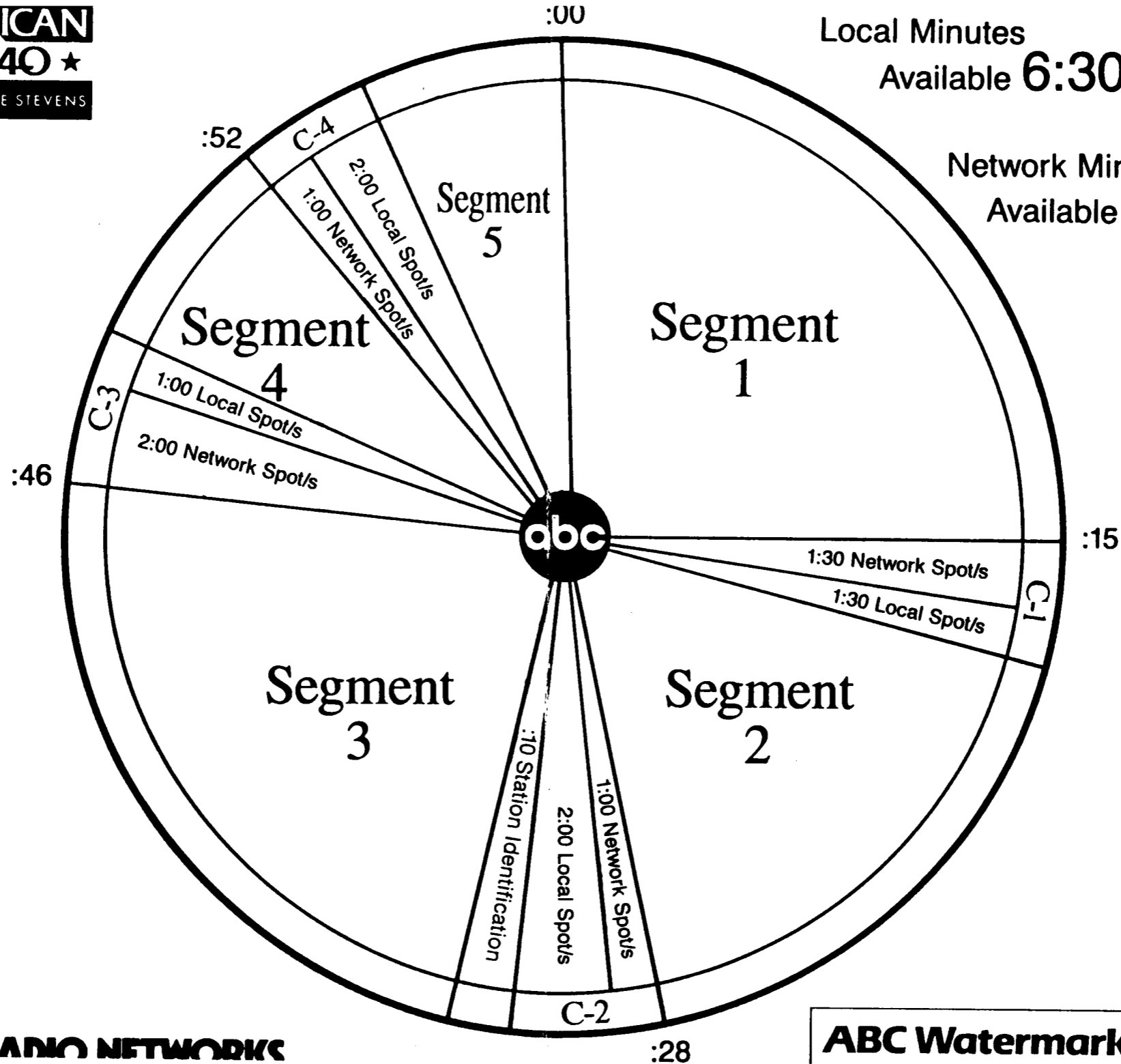

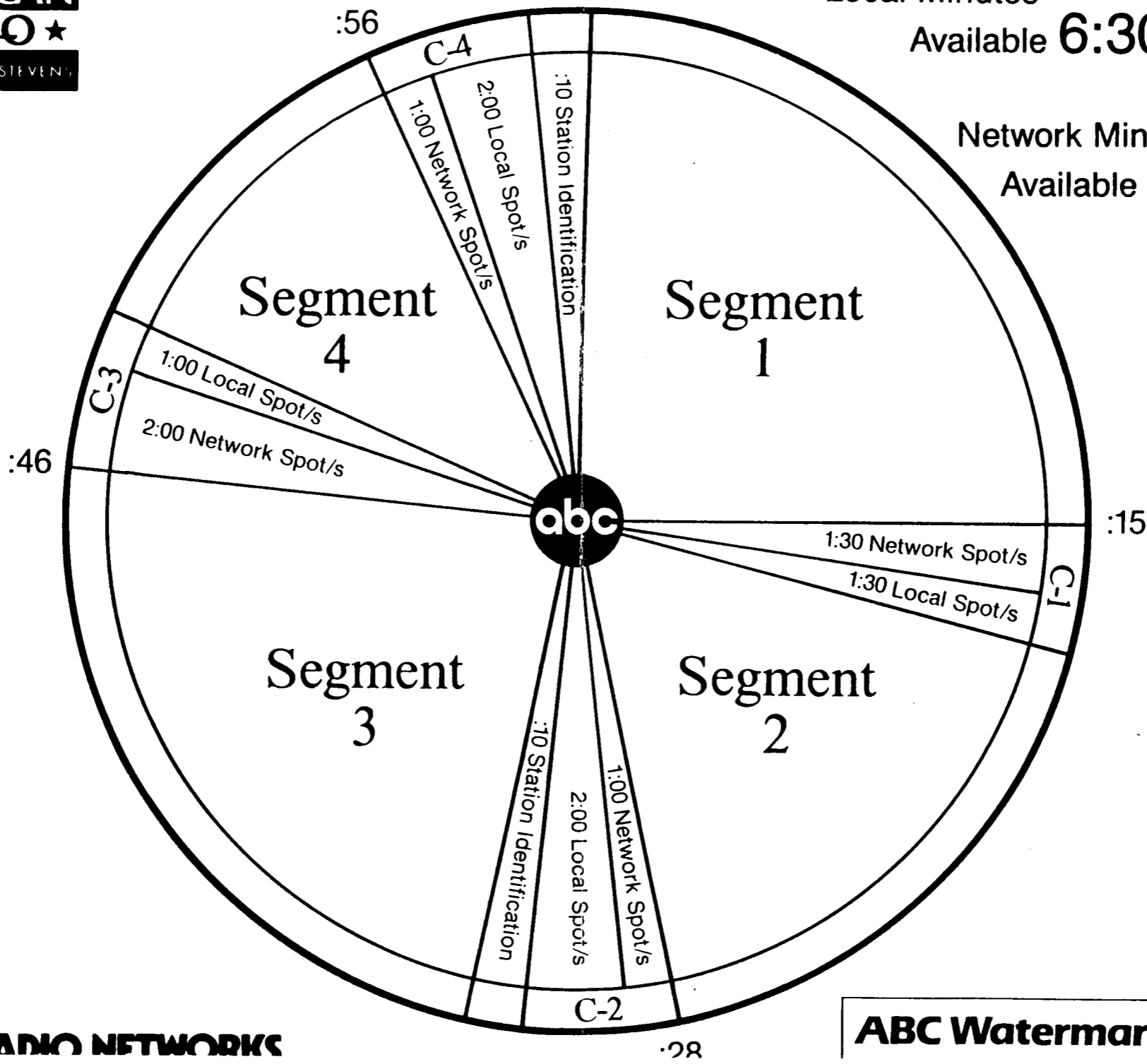

Hi, Shadoe Stevens on American Top 40. Last week, George Michael once again climbed to the pop peak of the Official Billboard Chart, hitting #1 with his song, "MONKEY". But comin' up fast from below are "I DON'T WANNA GO ON WITH YOU LIKE THAT" by Elton John and "I DON'T WANNA LIVE WITHOUT YOUR LOVE" by Chicago. Neither one wanna miss out on the top spot. And they'll take their shot this week -- on "Good Old" American Top 40.
