1) MORE THAN PRETTY FACES (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, Englishman Steve Winwood hit number one with "HIGHER LOVE." And the act with the best chance of replacing Steve this week is also English: Three great-looking women called Bananarama with a song called "VENUS." At first, people thought they were three models trying to sell records strictly on their looks. But these girls have paid their dues as singers, and they're making it on talent. We'll be tracking their action, and everybody else's, on American Top 40.

2) THE DEBUTS (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, the official Billboard survey put six new songs into our Top 40. But it doesn't look like there'll be that many this week. If you're a betting Pop fan, put your marbles on a one woman, eight-man band from Oregon, Nu Shooz. Also on a piano-playing rocker from New York, Billy Joel. And, on a cop-playing actor from Miami Vice, Don Johnson. We'll see how close I hit 'em this week, on American Top 40.

3) BEATLES SHAKE IT UP (:18)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week a 22 year old hit returned to the countdown. The Beatles were shakin' things up with "TWIST & SHOUT." Back in 1964, it hit number two. What'll happen this time around? We'll be on the Beatle watch as we count 'em down from the official Billboard chart on American Top 40.
