1) DOUBLE ONES (:29)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Not many acts score with a number one album and number one single at the same time. The popular English band, Dire Straits, has a chance to do it this week on American Top 40. Their album "BROTHERS IN ARMS", was number one last week...and their single from it, "MONEY FOR NOTHING", leaped from six to three. Can Dire Straits take number one on both the album and the singles charts? The Official Billboard surveys will tell the story. This week on American Top 40.

2) TOP TUSSLE (:27)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40, John Parr spent his second-week-in-a-row at number one with "ST. ELMO'S FIRE (MAN IN MOTION)". And there's plenty of motion below. Leaping from number six to number three was "MONEY FOR NOTHING" by Dire Straits. And up from number seven to number four, "CHERISH", the number one soul song by Kool and The Gang. Only one can be number one. And we'll find out which one as we count down the Official Billboard rankings on American Top 40.

3) DEBUT TIME (:27)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. A lot of hot acts are releasing songs these days. Here's who's knockin' on the AT40 door this week: Night Ranger with "FOUR IN THE MORNING"... Don Henley with "SUNSET GRILL"...the British band ABC with "BE NEAR ME"...and Paul Young with the follow-up to his number one smash "EVERYTIME YOU GO AWAY." It's called "I'M GONNA TEAR YOUR PLAYHOUSE DOWN." They're all knockin', so who's going to come in? We'll have all the Official Billboard chart action on American Top 40.
