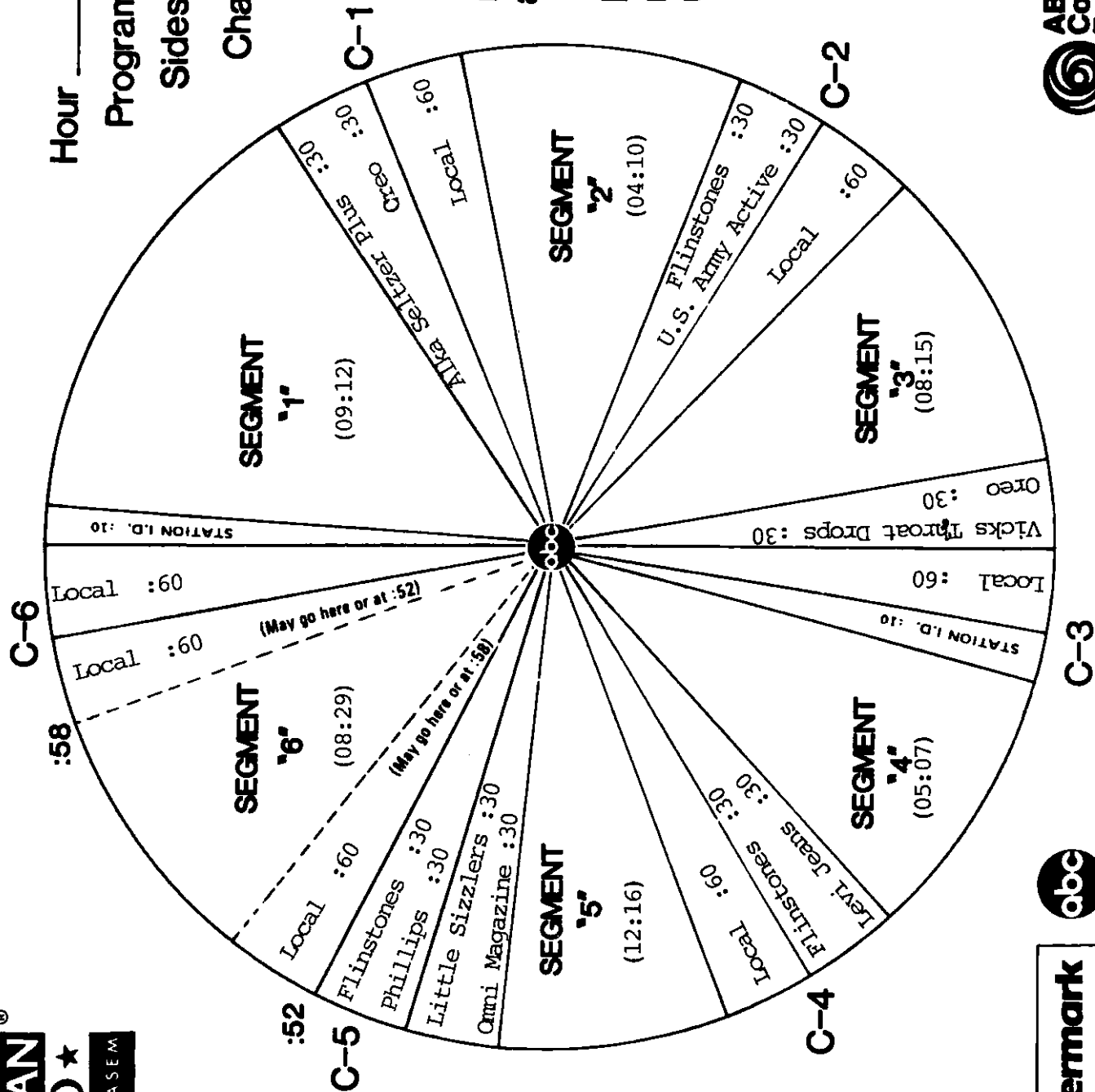

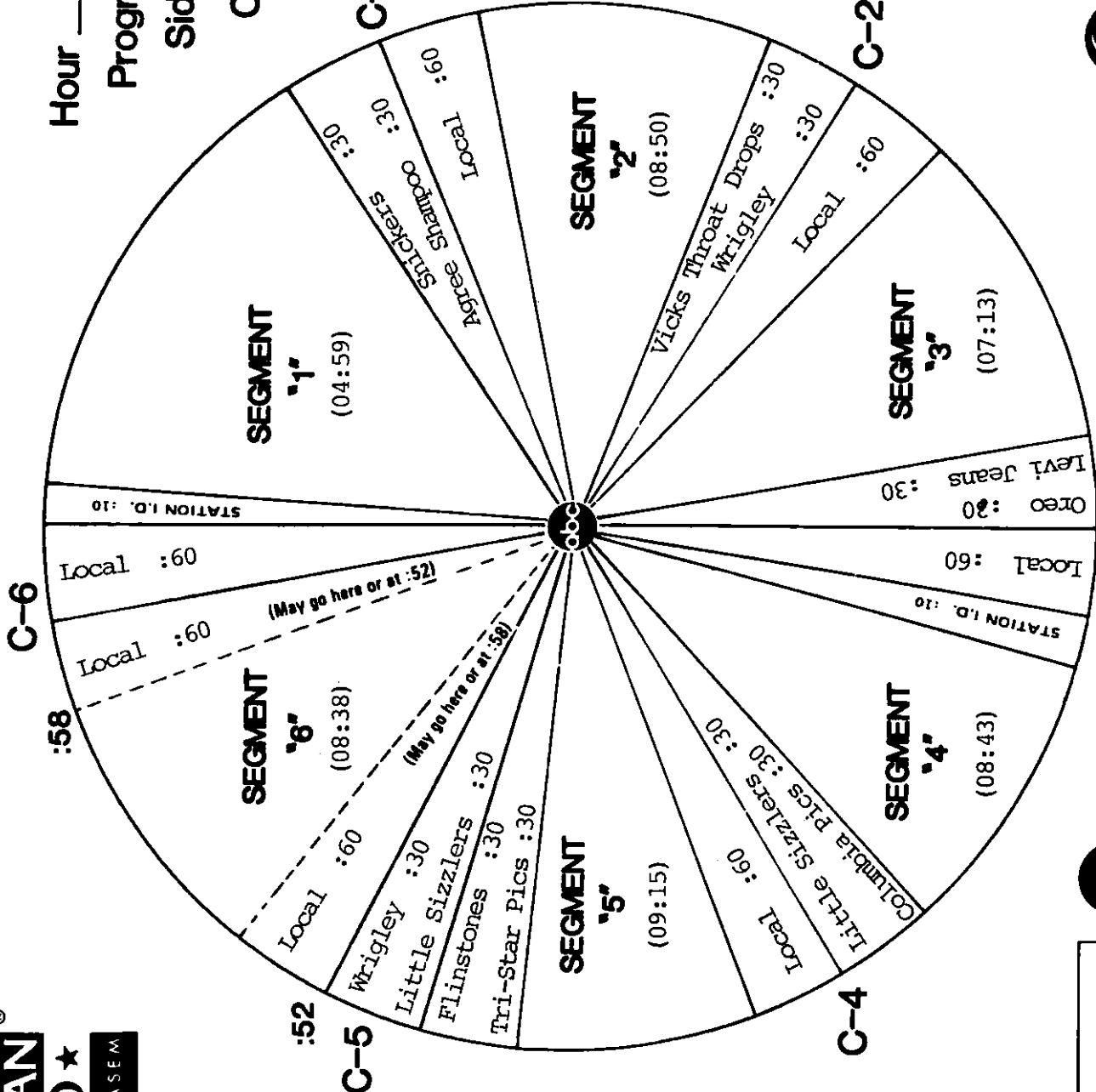

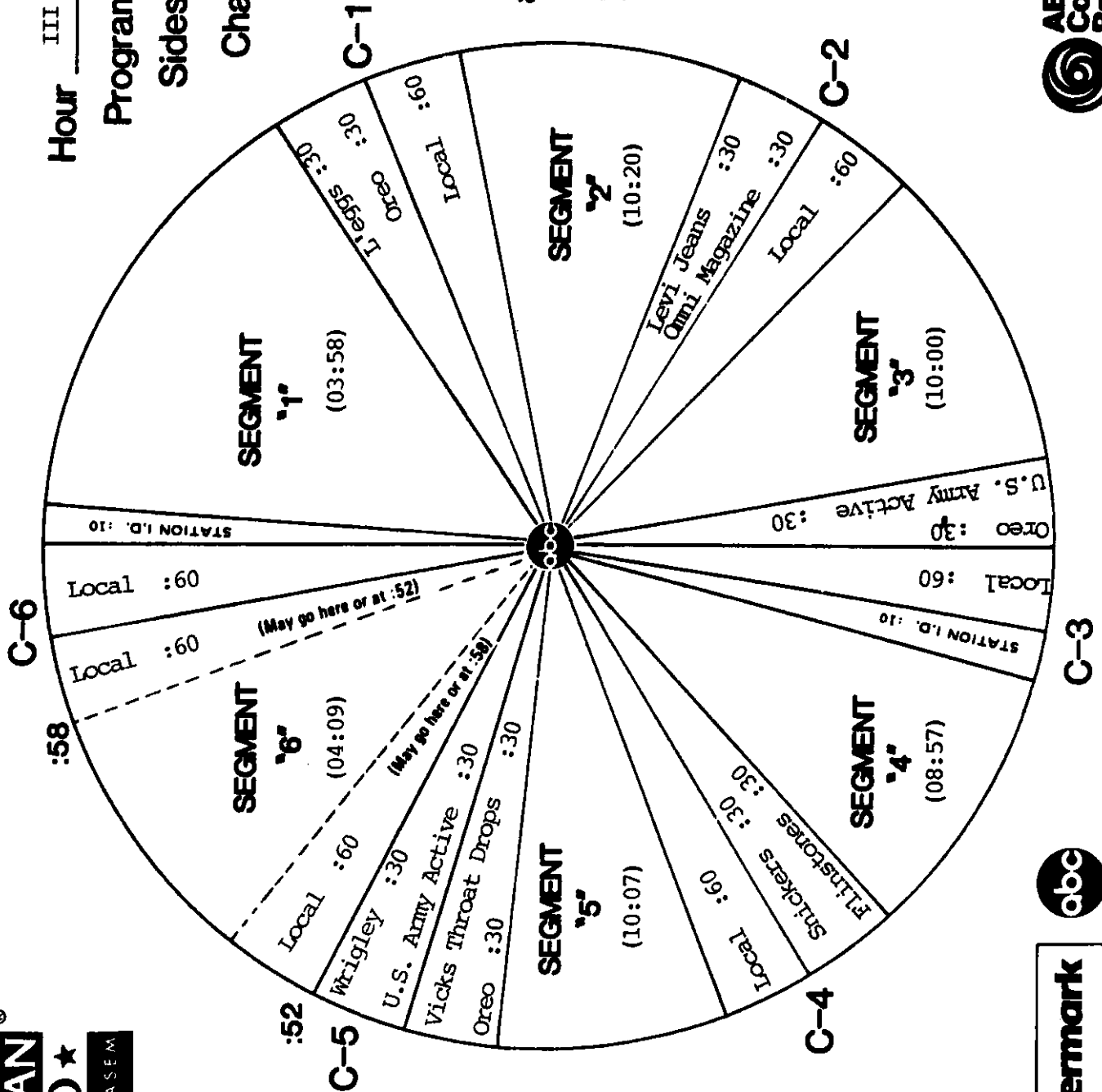

DO NOT USE AFTER OCTOBER 4, 1987

- 1) BROOOOOCE IS BACK (:15)
Hi, this is Casey Kasem -- and Bruce is back! The radio waves are rockin' with Bruce Springsteen's new song "BRILLIANT DISGUISE", from his upcoming album, "Tunnel Of Love". It's a good bet to debut right here in the Top 40 this week. Could be a 'Boss' countdown -- on American Top 40.
- 2) U2 STALKES THE STREETS (:26)
Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And the band who broke through big this year with sold-out arena shows and a #1 album "The Joshua Tree" are back in the U.S.A. They're filling stadiums and aiming towards the countdown once again. They hit #1 with "WITH OR WITHOUT YOU", and then hit #1 again with "I STILL HAVEN'T FOUND WHAT I'M LOOKING FOR". And now U2 are looking for a place "WHERE THE STREETS HAVE NO NAME". U2 may find it -- and debut this week -- on American Top 40.
- 3) BAD BOY (:24)
Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, he debuted on the entire Album chart at #1. That's "Bad". The title song from that album leaped from #40 to #29. That's "Bad". And Bad is good for Michael Jackson. The first single from the "Bad" album "I JUST CAN'T STOP LOVING YOU", hit #1. Will the follow-up be just as bad? We'll track Michael's moves -- on American Top 40.
- 4) THE FIGHT OF THE DECADE (:33)
Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well sports fans, on the Pop Chart we've got the champ and the contender battlin' it out. A few months ago, Madonna claimed her 6th #1 of this decade with "WHO'S THAT GIRL" -- makin' her the undisputed champ of #1's in the 80's. But she's got a challenger, because last week, Whitney Houston scored her 5th #1 with "DIDN'T WE ALMOST HAVE IT ALL". But the champ's lookin' like she's got another winner, her latest -- "CAUSING A COMMOTION". Will Madonna deliver her knockout punch -- her 7th #1 of the 1980's? We'll have a ringside seat -- on American Top 40.
- 5) THE YOUNG AND THE RESTLESS (:38)
Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And the young are restless in the countdown -- there's 20-year-old Lisa Velez with Cult Jam singing "LOST IN EMOTION". Gerald and Sean Levert -- who are 21 and 19 years old, sing about "CASANOVA". L.L. Cool J is 19 and he "NEEDS LOVE". 18-year-old Elisa Fiorollo sings on Jellybean's hit "WHO FOUND WHO". Debbie Gibson is 17, and she's hit with "ONLY IN MY DREAMS". And the baby of the youth group, Tiffany, just hit last week with "I THINK WE'RE ALONE NOW". She's just turning 16. Fairy tales can come true -- it can happen to you, if you're young on the chart -- on American Top 40
