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1. Kirk Pengilly of INXS, gives us a brief explanation of their new hit, "NOT ENOUGH TIME.":

**KIRK PENGILLY ACTUALITY:** (:14) "It's kind of a love song, but it's basically speaking about the fact that, we don't really have a lot of time with whatever incarnation you're in at the time. It's just about living life to the fullest, and being aware of your, sort of, niche in the whole sort of, global thing."

2. The group After 7 is riding the charts with their latest hit "KICKIN' IT," and we recently caught up with brothers Kevon and Melvin Edmonds, who told us how they first got into singing, years ago. It all started innocently enough with a little tape recorder:

**KEVON AND MELVIN EDMONDS ACTUALITY:** (:58) "I recall back when we were younger, my father used to, -- have a tape recorder. I guess it was kinda, family talent show or something. Everybody came on and did their little thing. Basically, it was like singing commercials. I remember (sings). Lucky, Lucky Strikes. That's right

-- we knew all the commercials that were on TV. What's the thing about California? (sings) Don't be late! I can hardly wait. There was some little songs about Indiana -- (sings) Indiana is the place I love to be, or something like that. There was a lot of songs. Just basically commercials off TV, or music that we heard on the radio. But I think the major fascination was that you know, it was a tape recorder, you could hear it back. And it was fascinating. It was a big thing back then, reel to reel tape. didn't too many people in the neighborhood have one, but we did. It was a fascinating thing for a child to be able to hear their voice back."

3. We had a chance to talk recently with Phil Collins, about his versatility... starting with his songwriting for Genesis. Here's how HE rates his songwriting for Genesis:

**PHIL COLLINS ACTUALITY:** (:35) "I've written some of the best lyrics that anyone's ever written. No. (laughs) Just a joke. I've written some of the best stuff written, yeah, especially for Genesis. I mean, I think probably that includes my solo stuff too. I think there are a couple of songs on this album which, I, am very proud of, you know. Not that I'm not proud of the other things, but I mean, they're just areas that I think I've actually done very well in. As I've become more of a singer, in a way, and less -- slightly less of a drummer -- I mean, whether I like it or not, I suppose I'm less of a drummer now. I've become more involved and interested in writing lyrics in what they say, and how they sound, and how I sound. And how I sing 'em."
