1) MIAMI VICE UBER ALLES (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40, a popular TV cop show did what no other TV show has ever done. Two songs generated by the TV show "MIAMI VICE" were in the Top 40 at the same time...the show's theme by Jan Hammer, and "YOU BELONG TO THE CITY" by Glenn Frey. And the new TV season has only just begun! Whatever happens on the Official Billboard chart, you'll hear about, on American Top 40.

2) WHAMMA LAMMA DING DONG (:23)
