1) AT40 ALL YOU CAN HEAR (:33)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And there's a smorgasbord of songs in the countdown: On the menu, we've got soft ballads -- like Whitney Houston's "DIDN'T WE ALMOST HAVE IT ALL". Rockers like John Cougar Mellencamp's "PAPER IN FIRE". There's hot dance numbers like "CAUSING A COMMOTION" by Madonna -- rowdy party tunes like Billy Idol's "MONEY MONEY" -- folk rock from Bruce Springsteen's "BRILLIANT DISGUISE", electrified Mexican-American music in "LA BAMBA" by Los Lobos -- and a little urban taste with rapper LL Cool J's "I NEED LOVE". It's pop in all kinds of flavors -- on American Top 40.

2) SMOKEY IS NOT TRIVIAL (:28)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And for you trivia buffs, last week we had a unique chart first. It was the first time in chart history that a singer has had a hit in the Top Ten -- at the same time as a song sung about him. The song sung by him, at #10, was "ONE HEARTBEAT"...the song sung about him, at #8, was by the British band ABC -- "WHEN SMOKEY SINGS". That's a song by and a song about -- Smokey Robinson. In pursuit of a little chart trivia -- on American Top 40.

3) TUNNEL VISION (:22)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, America's top rocker returned. He debuted on the entire Billboard Hot 100 Chart way up in the Top 40, with his latest hit, "BRILLIANT DISGUISE". It's the first single from his new album, "Tunnel of Love" -- his first studio album since "Born in the U.S.A." three years ago. Bruce Springsteen is back -- on American Top 40.

4) HOUSTON HOLDS ON (:24)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week, Whitney Houston spent her second week at #1 with "DIDN'T WE ALMOST HAVE IT ALL". But can she hang tough for a third week? Comin' up from below, eyein' that top spot, are Whitesnake, with "HERE I GO AGAIN", and Lisa Lisa and Cult Jam with "LOST IN EMOTION". Who'll have the #1 song this week? The Official Billboard Chart will tell the tale -- as we count down the most popular songs in the U.S.A. -- on American Top 40.
