1) FROM THE HOTTEST ALBUMS -- THE BIGGEST HITS (:25)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And from the hottest albums come the biggest hits: From Bruce Springsteen's new album, "Tunnel Of Love", there's "BRILLIANT DISGUISE". From the "Dirty Dancing" soundtrack, there's "THE TIME OF MY LIFE" by Bill Medley and Jennifer Warnes. From the #1 album in the land, "Bad", there's Michael Jackson's title song. And from the #2 album, "Whitesnake", there's the #1 song "HERE I GO AGAIN". Top albums -- top hits -- on American Top 40.

2) WOLF REDUX (:21)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And the wolves are ready to pounce with their second hit. Those wolves from East LA -- Los Lobos -- are following up their #1 remake of "LA BAMBAM" with another remake of a Richie Valens rocker from the 50's. This time they're singin' "COME ON, LET'S GO". Los Lobos could go right up the chart and into the countdown -- on American Top 40.

3) INDIAN SUMMER OF HITS (:32)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And even though summer's over -- we're still gettin' a heat wave of hits from summer movies. There's Madonna -- "CAUSING A COMMOTION" -- from her movie "Who's That Girl". From the movie "Disorderlies", there's the Fat Boys' "WIPEOUT" and Bananarama's "I HEARD A RUMOUR". Debuting last week, from the movie, "Dirty Dancing" was "I'VE HAD THE TIME OF MY LIFE" by Bill Medley and Jennifer Warnes. And from "La Bamba" -- Los Lobos hangin' in with "LA BAMBAM" -- and lookin' like they might debut with "COME ON, LET'S GO". That's summer flicks -- givin' us an Indian summer of hits -- here on American Top 40.

4) HISSESSSSSSSS (:27)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And we've had a serpent strike at the top of the countdown. The heavy-metal band, Whitesnake, led by British lead singer, David Coverdale, slithered up the survey with their first Top 40 hit -- "HERE I GO AGAIN". And then, last week, they put the bite on #1. Will Whitesnake shake, rattle, and roll on top again this week, or do Lisa Lisa and Cult Jam with "LOST IN EMOTION" or the band Europe with "CARRIE" move on in? We'll find out -- on American Top 40.
