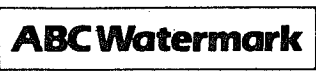

1) WONDER WOMEN (:20)

Hi, this is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem. Last week, the top of the countdown was still a woman's world. At number three with her recent number one song, "WHEN I THINK OF YOU," was Janet Jackson. At number two was "TYPICAL MALE" by Tina Turner. And at number one was the smash by Cyndi Lauper, her ballad "TRUE COLORS." How will the women do on this week's official survey? We'll be watchin', on American Top 40.

2) LIVE FROM THE PYRAMIDS, IT'S THE BANGLES (:21)

This is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem. One of the hottest new chart acts of the year has been the Bangles, the four-woman band from Los Angeles, with those heavenly harmonies. They're now climbing Billboard's Hot 100 with a new song called, "WALK LIKE AN EGYPTIAN." Will it make the Top 40 this week? Only the ancient Pharaohs, and the Billboard chart, know for sure. And the rest of us'll find out on American Top 40.

3) TAKE A STAND (:20)

Hi, this is Charlie Van Dyke for Casey Kasem. A few months ago, the Beatles old hit song, "TWIST AND SHOUT," made the Top 40. And now an even older record looks like it's about to debut. It first hit 25 years ago, the classic "STAND BY ME," by Ben E. King. Now it's been revived by the hit movie "Stand By Me." We'll watch for it as we survey the nations' biggest hits, on American Top 40.

4) THE GREAT PRETENDER (:15)
