1) BIG DEAL ON HOUSTON STREET (:21)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40, Whitney Houston hit number one on the pop chart for the first time with "SAVING ALL MY LOVE FOR YOU." But there's heavy competition breathing down her neck from Stevie Wonder with "PART TIME LOVER" and Tears For Fears with "HEAD OVER HEELS." What song does the Official Billboard survey place at number one this week? Find out on American Top 40.

2) ON THE VERGE OF A DEBUT (:27)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Two unusual acts are poised to debut on American Top 40 this week.
