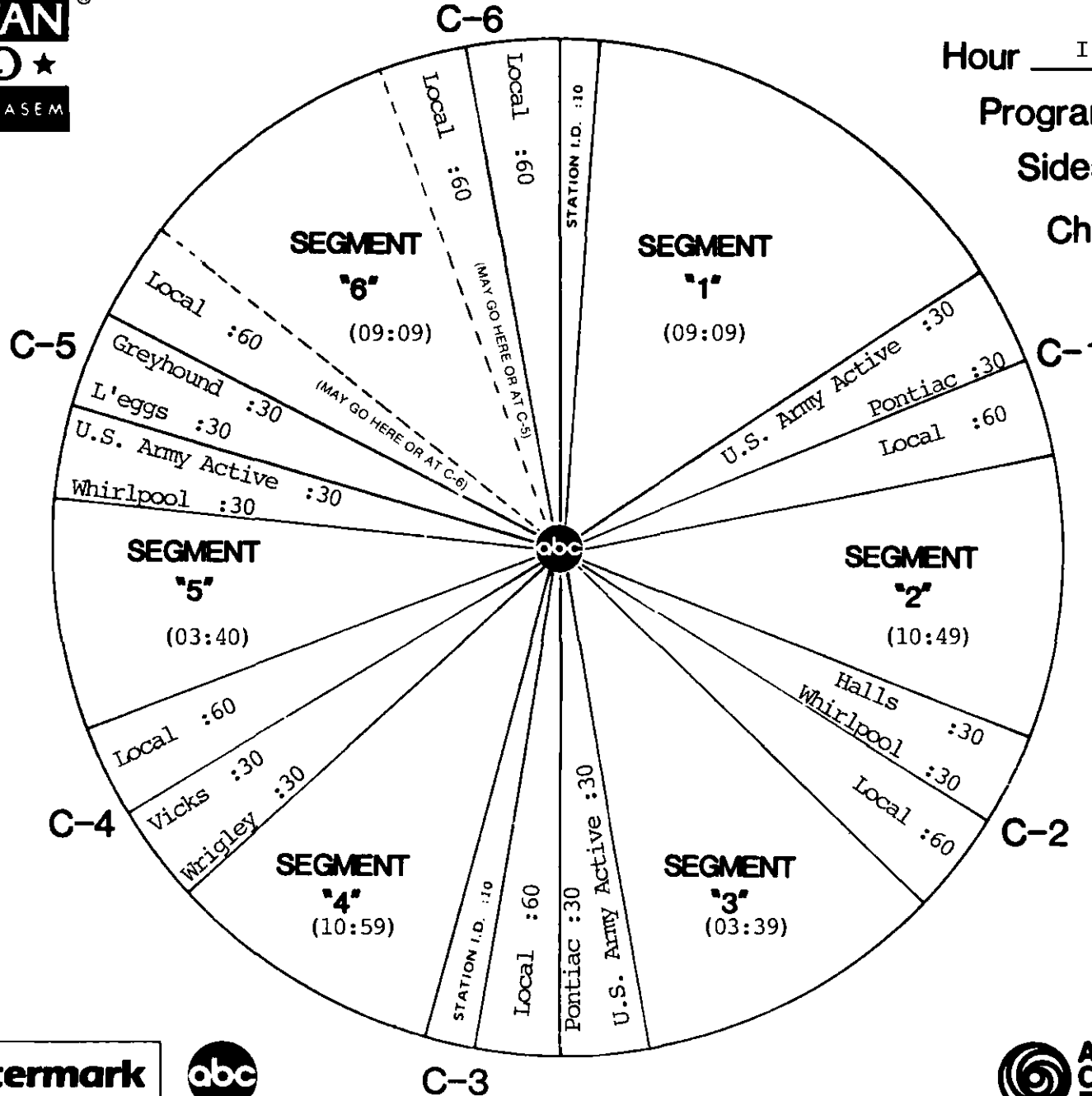


Hour I

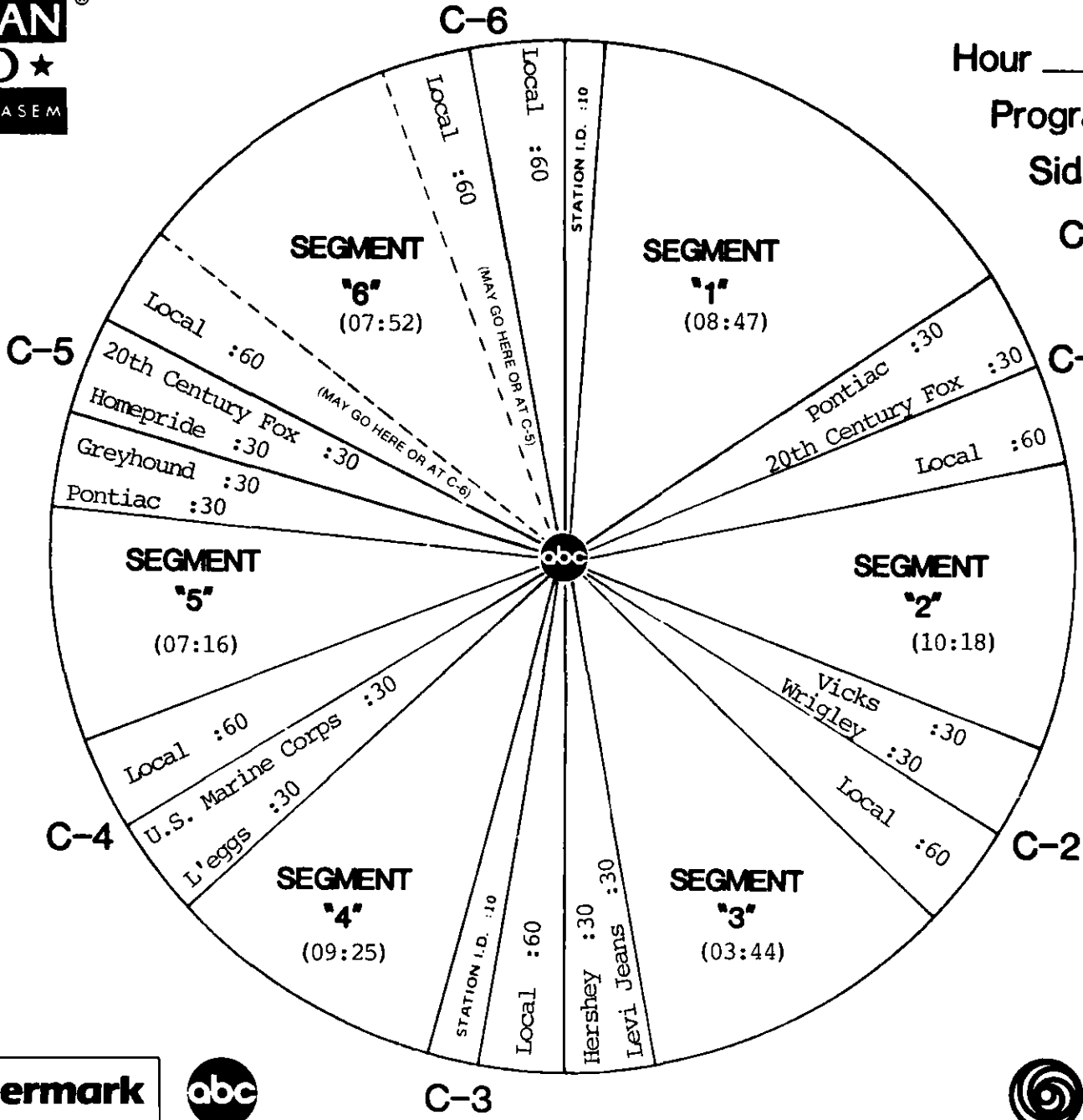


Hour II

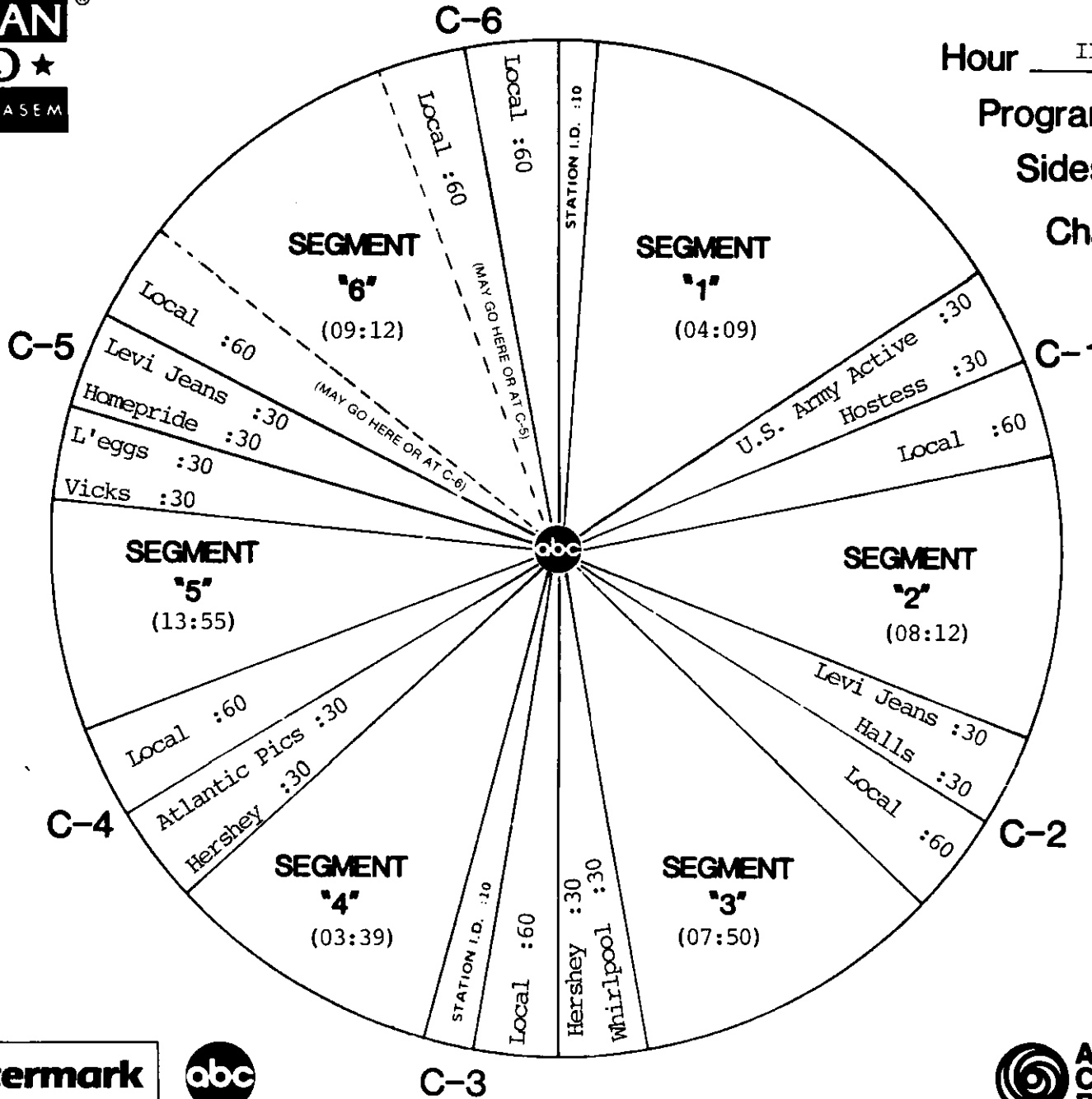


Hour III

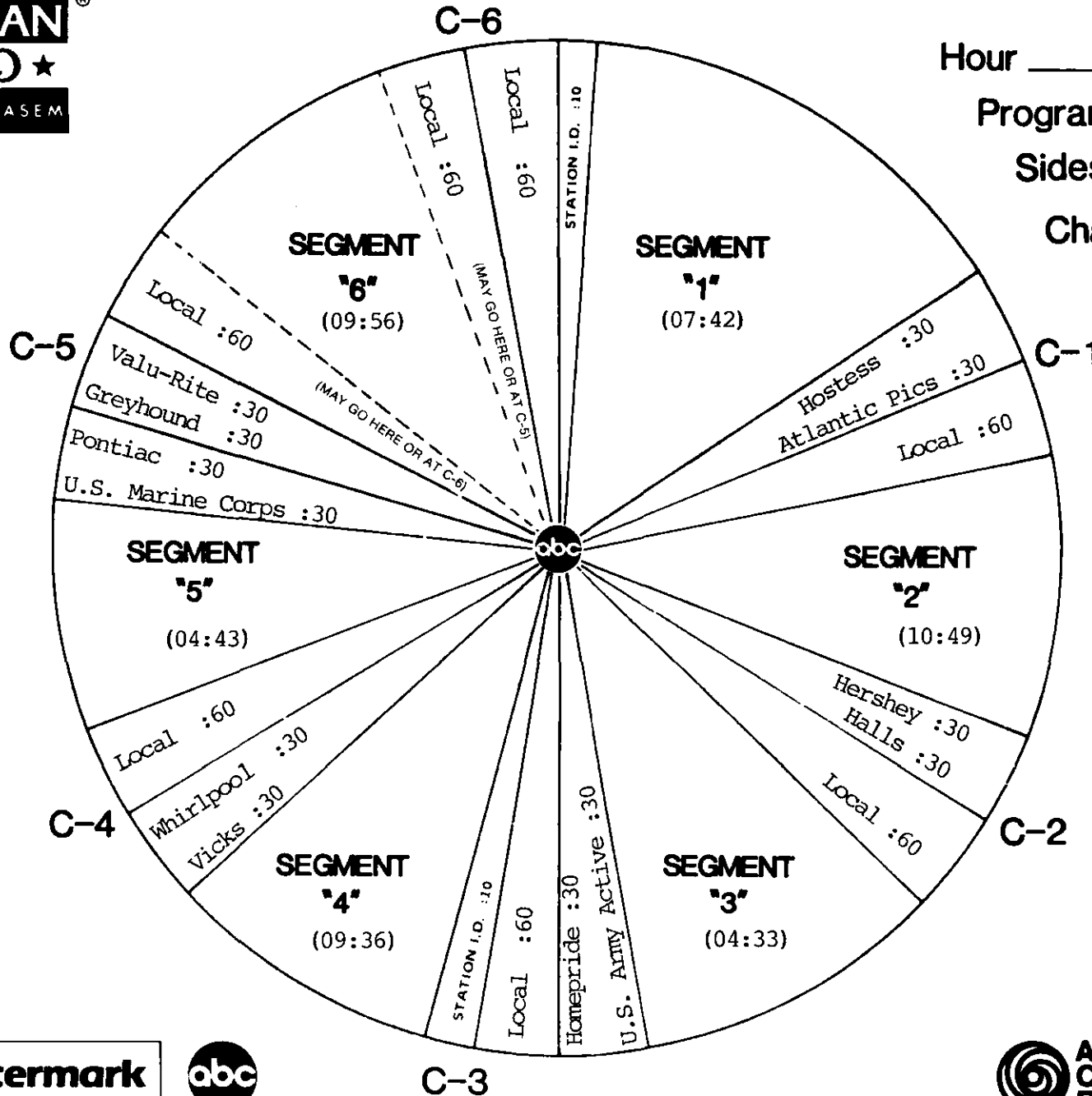


Hour IV

1) SPONTANEOUS BILL AND TIFF (:32)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. In the countdown we've had a unique happening -- two songs that are both remakes of hits originally done in the 60's by Tommy James and the Shondells -- Billy Idol's "MONEY MONEY" and Tiffany's "I THINK WE'RE ALONE NOW". Now, about a month and a half ago both songs debuted in the Top 40 the same week...that was a chart first. Then, two weeks ago, both songs hit the Top Ten the same week. That was a chart first. Will the two remakes hit #1 at the same time? That would certainly be a chart first. But you never know -- on American Top 40.

2) WINNING WHITNEY (:31)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Whitney Houston first dominated our countdown with hits from her debut album "Whitney Houston", and now she's doing it again with her second album, "Whitney". The album's first single "I WANNA DANCE WITH SOMEBODY" shot to #1. Then the second single, "DIDN'T WE ALMOST HAVE IT ALL" followed it to the Top. Just last week the third single "SO EMOTIONAL" debuted on the entire Billboard chart at #47. Is it also bound for Number One? Too soon to tell. But Whitney Houston's happenin' on American Top 40.

3) DANCING UP THE CHART (:30)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And dance music continues to kick up its heels in the countdown. Last week, two dance smashes debuted: "SUGAR FREE" by Wa Wa Nee, and a recent dance Number One, "CATCH ME I'M FALLING" by Pretty Poison. There's also toe-tappin' hits like "SHAKE YOUR LOVE" by Debbie Gibson -- "LOST IN EMOTION" by Lisa Lisa and Cult Jam, and "BAD" by Michael Jackson, and don't forget the current Number One Dance song "CAUSING A COMMOTION" by Madonna. We're shakin', stompin', spinnin' -- and countin' 'em down -- on American Top 40.
