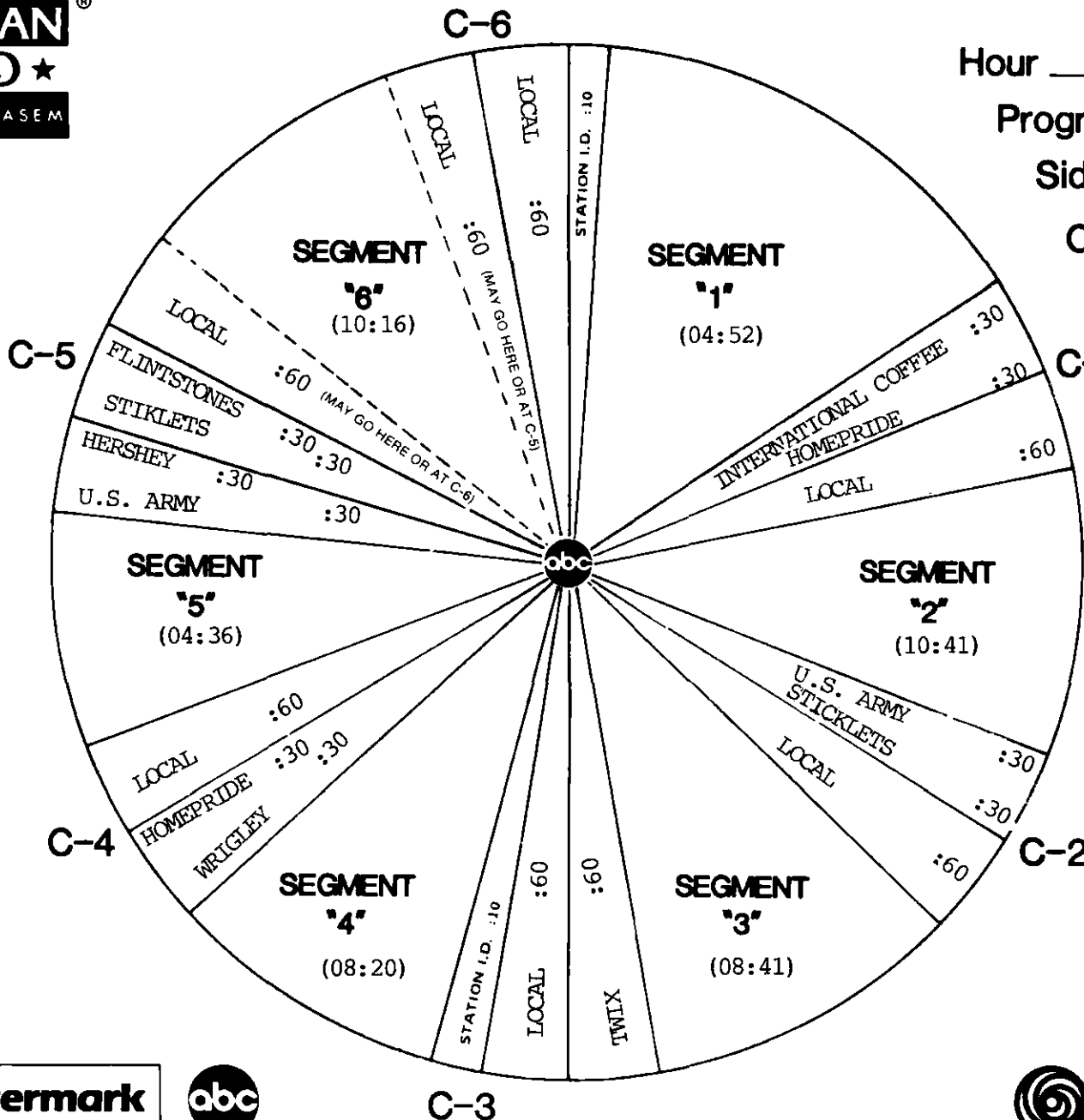

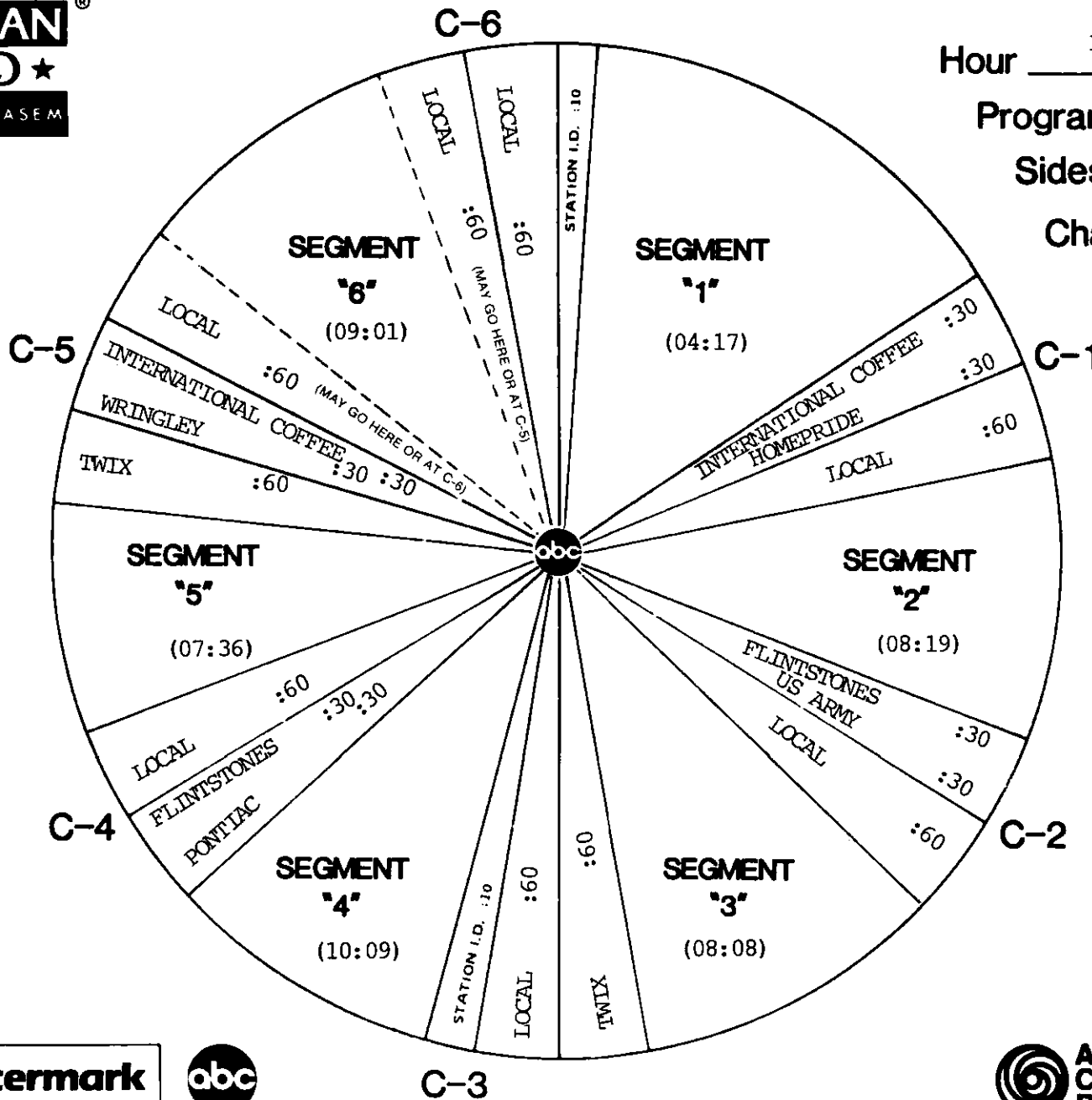

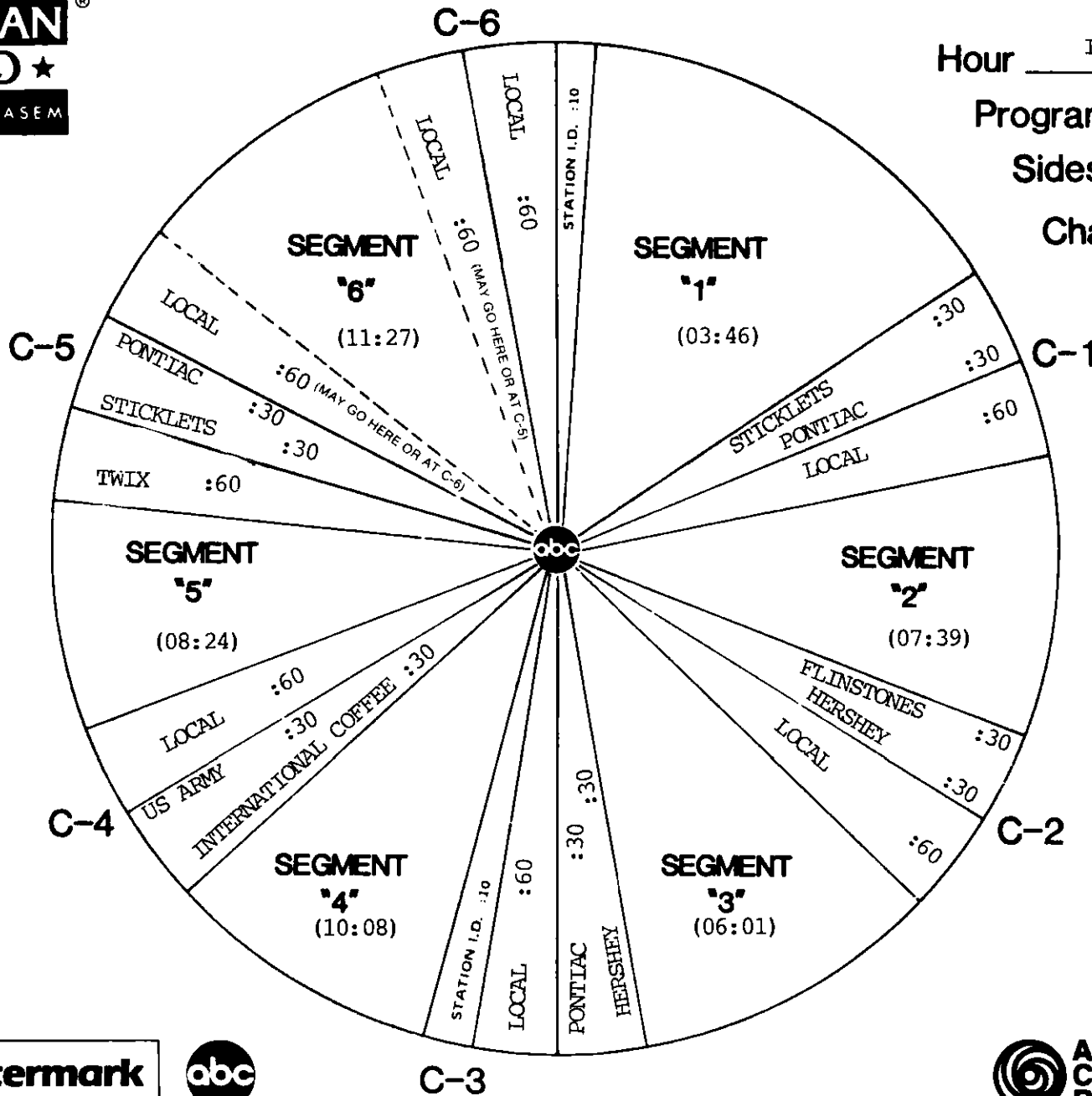

1) THE TOMMY JAMES SOUND ON THE 80S REBOUND (:25)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. What's the hottest sound around? How about 1980's remakes of 1960's songs originally by Tommy James and the Shondells! Climbing to Number Two was Billy Idol with "MONY MONY." And up above, holdin' on to number one, was Tiffany with her version of "I THINK WE'RE ALONE NOW." As Tommy James himself told us, "Yow! Who'd have thought it?!" Old songs -- redone -- and bigger than ever--on American Top 40

2) DIRTY DANCING IN A BAD TUNNEL OF LOVE (:29)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And most everyone thought the big battle on the album chart was going to be fought out by Michael Jackson and Bruce Springsteen. Two weeks ago, Michael's album "Bad" was dethroned at number one by Bruce's "Tunnel of Love." The along comes this little soundtrack from the movie, "Dirty Dancing." And it shows the Boss who's really Boss, knocking him out of the top spot last week! But all three albums are supported by strong hit singles. So what happens next? We'll have all the latest chart action--on American Top 40.

3) THE SMITHS OF AVIATION WING ON BACK (:23)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well last week, the group who helped Run-DMC take rap and hard rock into the top ten came back. Aerosmith, who joined Run-DMC for a remake of "WALK THIS WAY," returned with their own hit, "DUDE LOOKS LIKE A LADY." Debuted in last week's countdown--and looks like a big comeback smash for Aerosmith. We'll see just how they fly--on American Top 40.

And without missin' a beat--the first single--"VALERIE" - is climbing up our chart. Steve Winwood's enjoyin' the Hit Life -- on American Top 40.

Belinda Carlisle has a heavenly hit on American Top 40.
