RE: Live Satellite Feed of American Top 40

Effective Sunday, October 4, 1987, American Top 40 will be fed live via satellite on Sundays from 12noon until 4:00pm Eastern Time (Also please note the new late night feed change from Saturday 1am-5am to Friday 1am-5am Eastern.

If you are running AT40 live:

Tones and a time check for AT40 beging exactly five minutes before the start of the first hour (11:55am Eastern Time).

At exactly 12:00 noon eastern time, American Top 40 begins. THERE IS NO BREAK IN SATELLITE TRANSMISSION UNTIL THE SHOW IS OVER (4pm eastern time). Local commercial positions are filled with PSAs and station ID locations have 10 second music beds that segue back into the program.

Local Avails:

Public Service Announcements will be fed during local avail positions during the live feed. These should be covered with your local spots. In the event of unsold local inventory, simply let the PSAs air.

Station IDs:

At the beginning of each hour (except hour 1) your local station ID can be placed over the music bed which will run for ten seconds and segue back into the theme music at the top of the hour. At C-3 (the third commercial break) for all hours, your ID can be placed over the music bed which also runs 10 seconds and segues into the American Top 40 jingle.

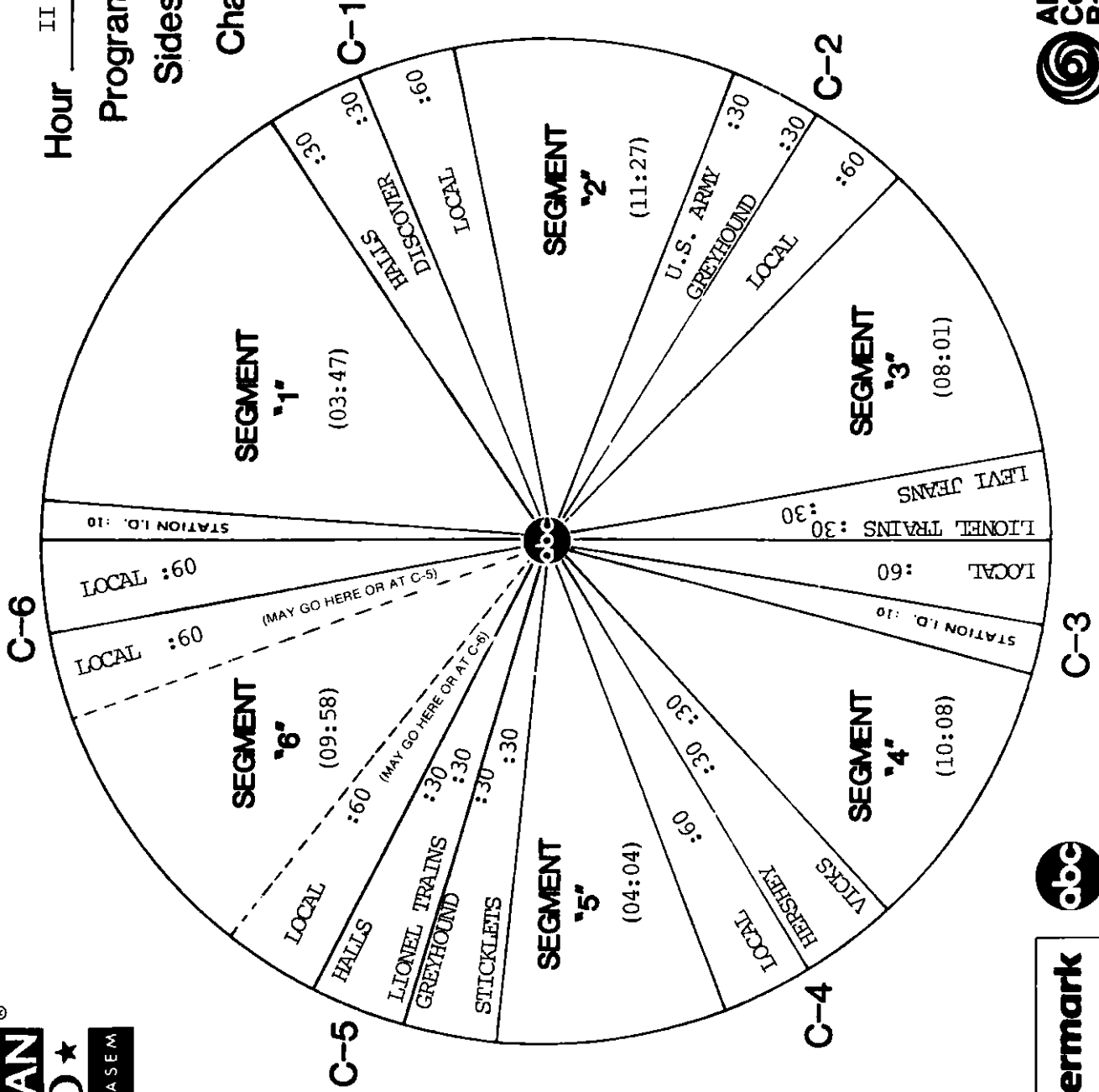

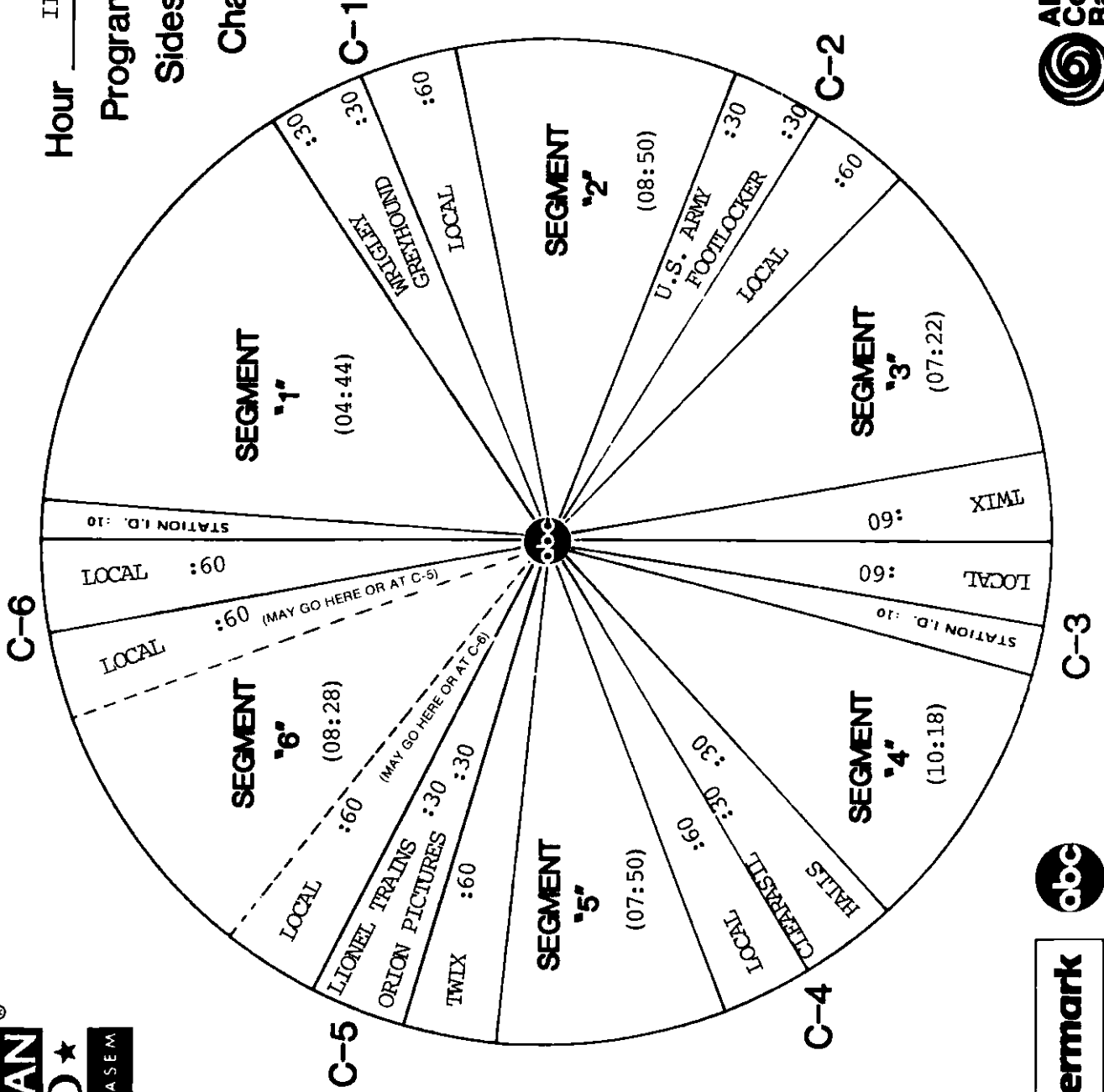

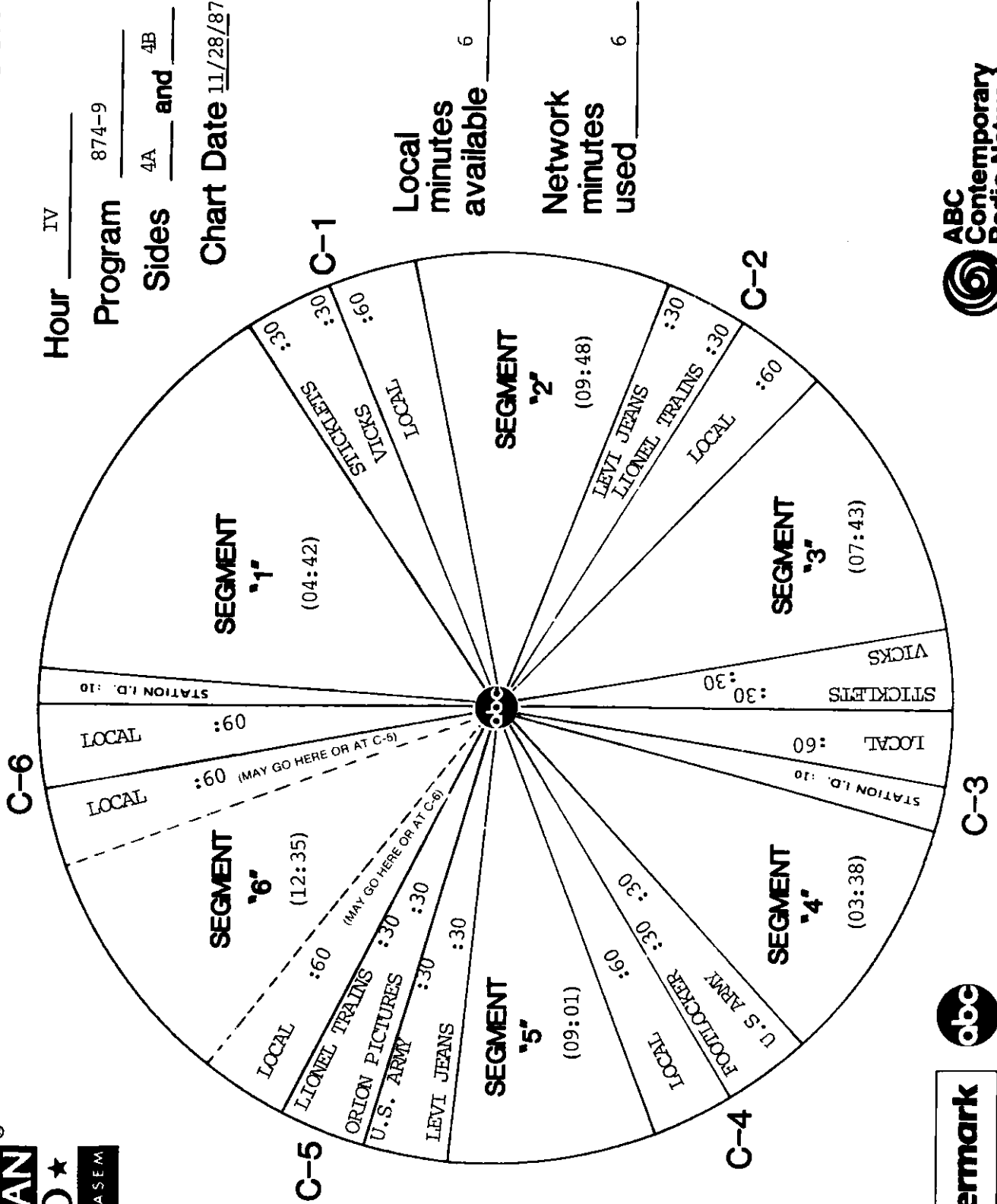

1) WE'RE IN THE MONY

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, Billy Idol hit number one with "MONY MONY." But can he hold on to that top spot? Coming up fast--jumping to number three last week --was the smash duet from the movie "Dirty Dancing" --"I'VE HAD THE TIME OF MY LIFE" by Bill Medley and Jennifer Warnes. Will Billy still be in the Mony --or is it Jennifer and Bill's time? We'll have all the chart action --on American Top 40.

2) STEVIE(S) ! (:27)

Hi this is Casey Kasem. Last week, we had two Big "littles" back-to-back in the Top 40. At number 23, --the former "Little Stevie Winwood" and at number 22, the former "Little Stevie Wonder." Both started their careers in their teens. But, now, all-grown up, Steve Winwood's climbin' with his song "VALERIE." And Stevie Wonder's movin' up with "SKELETONS." Toss in Stevie Nicks, who's in Fleetwood Mac, on "LITTLE LIES" and it looks like a little Stevie survey on American Top 40.

3) BACK IN THE SADDLE (:23)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Well, for nine long years, they said they were on "Permanent Vacation" --so when they decided to make a new album --that's what they called it "Permanent Vacation." Aerosmith, the band that in the 70s told us to "DREAM ON" and "WALK THIS WAY" are back to hard work and hard rockin' with their comeback hit, "DUDE LOOKS LIKE A LADY." Aerosmith --back in the saddle again --on American Top 40.

POISONOUS POP (:24)

- 4) Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And in the countdown we've got two very Lethal Acts --with two very different kinds of venom. Movin' up the countdown with a toxic taste of Glam Rock its the L.A. band, Poison. Their song is called "I WON'T FORGET YOU." And right below 'em is a deadly danceable song from the group out of Camden, New Jersey, Pretty Poison --their hit "CATCH ME I'M FALLIN." A double dose of Poisonous pop right here on American Top 40.
