1) WE'RE ONLY HUMAN (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Back in 1982, the British launched their techno-pop invasion with a song called "DON'T YOU WANT ME" by Human League. Well, the Human League are at number one again right now with their big hit "HUMAN." And the best chance of replacing them at number one comes from a New Jersey act with a more traditional kind of rock. No, not the "Boss." The heavy metal rockers, Bon Jovi. We'll be tracking that action and more, on American Top 40.

2) RAPPERS, POINTS, A TIGER, AND A BOSS (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Here are the possibles for debuting in the countdown this week. From Canada, the band Glass Tiger with their second hit, "SOMEDAY," and the rappers from New York, Run-DMC with their second hit "YOU BE ILLIN'." Also, look for the Pointer Sister with their latest, "Goldmine," and Bruce Springsteen with the E Street Band on his concert recording of Edwin Starr's "WAR." That's what maybe coming up this week on American Top 40.

3) BRING 'EM BACK ALIVE (:23)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. In record stores across the land, the word is "BROOOCE." The new 40 song collection of live concert recordings by Bruce Springsteen is the hottest-selling album in the U.S.A. Bruce & The E Street Band came on to the Billboard "Hot 100" at number 45 last week with their remake of the song "WAR." Look for it in the top forty this week, on American Top 40.

4) ON THE MOVE, DURAN TO THE SECOND POWER (:19)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The number one British group in America, so far in the 1980's, were climbing fast last week with their latest hit "NOTORIOUS." Duran Duran leaped nine notches to number 21. They're looking to rack up their seventh top ten. We'll scan for Duran Duran as we count 'em down this week, on American Top 40.
