1) BORN TO ONE (:27)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week on the Billboard Album Chart, history was made: Bruce Springsteen & the E. Street Band debuted on the entire Album Chart all the way up at Number One. And that's never happened before with an album containing more than two LP's. Bruce's is a five LP set! The first hit single from Springsteen's record setting album, a remake of Edwin Starr's "WAR", has already debuted in the countdown. The Boss is back -- on American Top 40.

2) JERSEY RULES (:23)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, the proudest state among the fifty had to be the Garden State of New Jersey. New Jersey's own Bruce Springsteen & the E. Street Band were at Number One on the Billboard Album Chart with their hot new live album. And on the Pop Singles Chart, the New Jersey Band, Bon Jovi, were at Number One with their song "YOU GIVE LOVE A BAD NAME." New Jersey rules! On American Top 40.

3) BANGLES BOP WITH PYRAMID POWER (:20)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week the all-girl band, The Bangles, leaped six notches on the official Billboard chart and landed in the Top Ten. Their song "WALK LIKE AN EGYPTIAN" is parading some potent pyramid power. How close to Number One will it take them? We'll have a better idea when we decipher this week's Pop Chart hieroglyphics -- on American Top 40.

4) POINTER SISTERS BECOME SUPREME (:23)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. For ten years now, the legendary Supremes have reigned supreme as the female group who've hit the Top 40 over the longest span of time. But this week, another female group could take that crown. If the Pointer Sisters debut this week with their newest hit "GOLDMINE", they could get the gold--and the glory! We'll be watching for the Pointer Sisters this week on American Top 40!
