This shipment includes: Programs 764-12 and 764-13. "12" is for the weekend of December 18-19. "13" is four hours and is for the weekend of December 25-26; it's the Top 100 of 1976, #s 100 - 51. A chronological montage of all the number ones of 1976 is featured at the end of show "13", and at the end of show "1".

And, if included in your licensing agreement or specially ordered, the following programs are also enclosed:

- a) #734-13...the All-Time Christmas Countdown (to be aired no later than December 25.)
- b) #771-1...the Top 100 of 1976, #s 50 - 1. (for the weekend of January 1-2)

Please check your shipment thoroughly to be sure everything is there and in good condition. As advised in a memo two weeks ago, emergency shipments are a bit hazardous at this late date, but please call Watermark Operations right away if there is any problem. (800) 423-2502 or (213) 980-9490.

The next regular shipment will be program #771-2 on Saturday, January 1. This show is scheduled to air the weekend of January 8-9.

Promos: Casey has provided three voice-only promos for "The Top 100". They are indefinite enough to be useful for any of the variety of scheduling possibilities that have occurred to us and many stations. They are included as extra cuts on program #764-12. Check your cue sheet for actual location.
