1) THE BOSS' LUCKY SEVEN (:21)

This is Casey Kasem. This week on American Top 40, America's number one rocker, Bruce Springsteen has a chance to debut with his latest hit, "MY HOMETOWN". If he does, he'll have the seventh Top 40 hit single from one album. And that would tie an all-time record! We'll cover that story and all the Official Billboard chart action on American Top 40.

2) "RICHIE SAYS OR MURPHY PARTIES" (:22)

This is Casey Kasem. Last week on American Top 40, the number one song in the land was "BROKEN WINGS" by Mr. Mister. Threatening to push them out this week are two songs: "SAY YOU, SAY ME" by Lionel Richie...and "PARTY ALL THE TIME" by Eddie Murphy. Whatever act wins the top spot of the week, pop fans, never lose.
