Had an interesting call from Art Gibson at WAIR, Winston-Salem, N.C. this week that reminded me of one of those great notions we had a while back and for some reason forgot. Art asked if we knew about any one-time or ongoing special promotions that stations were doing occasionally or regularly to promote AT40. A dialogue began, and in the course of the conversation, we came up with two possibilities:

- (1) Having Casey record custom open end copy, e.g. "This is Casey Kasem getting ready for another American Top 40 here on W. A. I. R. . . . . and here's one of the records that we think has a good chance at being number one in the nation as we count down the hits Saturday morning from 9 till noon". In other words...you write custom copy, send it to us, Casey voices, we send back the tape, you cart it and run it infront of any likely record. (We usually name the possibilities in the prediction segment that runs right after #1 in the weekly shows.) (Note: If you do this...great, but don't use it the week going into a special.)
- (2) The next upcoming AT40 special will be "The 40 Top Artists of the Rock Era, 1955-1973". Do your own write in and tabulate your own local rock artist hall of fame and run it before or after that AT40 special. Postcards could be drawn and winners could be awarded prizes, such as your copy of the show itself. (If you want extra copies, you can have 'em, while they last, @ \$7.50 including postage... but order early.)

These are two off-the-top-of-the-head possibilities for special or regular AT40 on-air promotions. We're laying them out to get an exchange of ideas going. With 225 stations currently airing the show, some pretty interesting ideas must be getting on, and we'd like to help share them. Just write me a note detailing any special... or even not so special... AT40 promotion you've done, and we'll publish it in the next few weeks. We'll be looking forward to hearing from you with great anticipation.
