For about 60 of you, it's AT40 renewal time again. Stations with agreements running out at the end of '73 will be getting one reminder around the first of November. Deadline time is November 15. We really want to keep your business, of course, so please let me know if there are any questions pertaining to the renewal forms, and please keep an eye out for them in the mail.

Several P.D.'s, including Don Hanslik in North Carolina have been pulling the Beatle production segment out of the last special...program #734-1 (it ran on the weekend of October 6-7). They've been using it for pieces of their own specials or just to play occasionally on the air. The bit runs about 13 minutes and takes you through just about every important piece of Beatle music from 1964 through the early '70's. We'd like to see you get some use from it. No permission is necessary.

Some early warning: We plan to mail three (3) shows in one package in December. Program #'s 734-11, 734-12 and 734-13 (scheduled for air on the weekends of December 15, 22 and 29 respectively) will all be shipped from Los Angeles on Friday, December 7. Show "12" will be the traditional "All-time Christmas Countdown" and show "13" "The 40 Top Hits of 1973". Your ideas for scheduling of these two-specials-in-a-row would be appreciated for circulation to all the stations.

Roy Morgan, V.P. at WILK, Wilkes-Barre, PA wrote us the thoughtful letter we enclose in its entirety.

The answer to Roy's question about the degree of difference between this year's Christmas special and the version produced in 1971: "We don't really know". The special is being written now and will be produced in mid-November. I can tell you that it will be much more comprehensive and will include several records that couldn't be located last time around.

Dear Tom:

First of all, I want to compliment you on the promotional spots that were prepared for the AT40 special "40 Top Artists of the Rock Era." We found them to be most helpful in promoting the show and also thought they were well done. This is an idea well worth repeating.

Secondly, I wondered if you could let us know if there would be much repitition between the forthcoming "AT40's All Time Christmas Countdown" and the one originally produced in 1971. We're curious because we wondered about the possibility of scheduling both these specials sometime during the Christmas period. Of course, we would not schedule them at the same time period. Since we run the AT40 show on Sunday afternoon, we might schedule a repeat broadcast of the 1971 show some week night.

Here is an idea that some other stations might find helpful. We have this Fall been using the theme "Thursday Night is Special on WILK". In this connection we have scheduled a number of Special 3-hour programs.

We have run a "Wolfman Jack Special", for example, since we used the syndicated program from 7 to 8 PM every night, Monday thru Saturday. We have given sneak previews of our special weekends, such as the "Motown Weekend" and "British Invasion Weekend."

Of particular interest to you might be the fact that we have also rescheduled as Thursday night specials some of the AT40 specials that you have released during the past year or so. For example, we are going to run the AT40 "40 Greatest Disappearing Acts of Rock Era" along with your older special "Top Rock Artists..1968-72". We have found that these AT40 specials work in quite well with this concept.
