1) Number One Battle (:21)

But look: Pushing hard at Number Two is Jack Wagner, with his first hit "ALL I NEED." Who will be at Number One this week? Join me for that, and all the Official Billboard Chart Action on American Top 40. Right here.

2) Cyndi Lauper's Hot Streak (:20)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem on American Top 40. Last week, another song from the Cyndi Lauper album, "SHE'S SO UNUSUAL," debuted in the countdown, making it five in a row. The first four went all the way to the Top 10 on the Official Billboard Chart. Will Cyndi Lauper's "MONEY CHANGES EVERYTHING" climb as high? We'll find out right here on American Top 40.

3) The Return Of John Fogerty (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem on American Top 40. This week's countdown may see a debut song from a man who hasn't been in the Top 40 for Ten Years, not since his solo hit, "ROCKIN' ALL OVER THE WORLD." He's the former leader of the legendary Creedence Clearwater Revival John Fogerty. His new song, "OLD MAN DOWN THE ROAD," has a good chance of debuting this week. It will if the Official Billboard survey says so, and we'll find out right here on American Top 40.
