1) DEBUTS (:21)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Among the biggest names debuting in American Top 40 last week were Prince and Bruce Springsteen. Joining them this week could be Diana Ross with her tribute song to Marvin Gaye and David Bowie sharing a record with superstar jazz guitarist Pat Metheny. We'll see where the official Billboard survey put them all...this week on American Top 40.

2) JOSTLING FOR #1 (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. For three weeks now, Wham's "CARELESS WHISPER" has been the number one song in America. Strong song. But last week three more strong songs made big moves into positions two, three and four: REO's "CAN'T FIGHT THIS FEELING"...David Lee Roth's "CALIFORNIA GIRLS"...and Glenn Frey's "THE HEAT IS ON." And that title paints the number one picture. We'll see what happens this week on American Top 40.

3) DAVID LEE ROTH CATCHES A WAVE (:21)

This is Casey Kasem. 20 years ago, the Beach Boys took their smash "CALIFORNIA GIRLS", to number three. And that's right where the hit remake by David Lee Roth was last week on American Top 40. Can David catch a wave that takes him higher than the Beach Boys...all the way to number one? We'll find out that and more, this week on American Top 40.
